Preliminary results:

	Earthquake	Volcanoes
Descriptions	Diverse sensorial, emotional, physical, cognitive,	Simplistic spectacular events
Emotions associated	Fear	
Evidence (warnings):	weather (quet, multed, warm, dear); animal behaviour
