## **BMus in Music History**

### **POPULAR MUSIC STUDIES**

This unique program places the various repertoires and styles of rock, jazz, and musical theatre in their historical and cultural contexts. In both Europe and North America, interest in the serious study of the musical styles which account for 94% of the music performed today has grown rapidly in recent years, and our BMus degree is the first undergraduate program in Canada to establish a concentration in popular music. The area consists of 4.0 courses (usually taken as 8 separate one-term courses) selected from introductory courses, devoted to rock, jazz, and musical theatre, and advanced courses which focus on various aspects of the field -- genres, composers, artists, performance, and style.

NOTE: In addition to studies in music history, students enrolled in Popular Music Studies receive training in all of the traditional areas of the BMus degree at Western (theory, sight singing and ear training, performance, and ensembles).
