DOCTORS OF LAWS

Charles Aubrey LeMaistreAustin, Tex.

Charles A. LeMaistre became Chancellor of the University of Texas System on January 1, 1971. Earlier, he had been deputy chancellor and executive vice chancellor for health affairs in the University of Texas System with general responsibility for the University's medical and dental units in Galveston, Houston, Dallas and San Antonio, and for the Nursing School (system-wide). Dr. LeMaistre became a University of Texas vice chancellor in 1966, having previously been a professor of internal medicine (1959-66) and associate dean (1965-66) of The University of Texas (Southwestern) Medical School at Dallas. A native of Lockhart, Alabama, he earned the Bachelor of Arts degree from The University of Alabama, and the Doctor of Medicine degree from Cornell University Medical College. Dr. LeMaistre was formerly an instructor and assistant professor of medicine at Cornell Medical College. Before coming to Texas he was professor and chairman of the Department of Preventive Medicine and Community Health at the Emory University School of Medicine.

Ernest StoneJacksonville

Ernest Stone has served as President of Jacksonville State University since January, 1971. He holds a B. S. degree from that institution and B.A. and M.A. degrees from The University of Alabama. Prior to his present appointment, he served a four-year term as Alabama Superintendent of Education. A past president of the Alabama Education Association and the Alabama Association of Secondary School Principals, he has been a principal of schools in his native Crossville, superintendent of DeKalb County Schools, Director of Laboratory Schools and Superintendent of Jacksonville City Schools. He was the recipient of Alabama's Most Promising Young Educator's Award in 1948, and received Kappa Phi Kappa's Most Prominent Educator's Award in 1969. He was appointed by the U. S. Government to study education in Marshall Aid Countries in 1950, and to make an Assessment Study of Education in Japan, India, and Israel in 1969. He received the first citation for outstanding services to youth by the Alabama Congress of Parents and Teachers in 1970.

DOCTOR OF SCIENCE

Eric RodgersTuscaloosa

Eric Rodgers joined the physics faculty of his alma mater, The University of Alabama, in 1932, and in a span of almost four decades served successively as instructor, assistant, associate and full professor of physics; head of the physics department, and for the past 13 years has served as Dean of the Graduate School. A native of Goshen in Pike County, he holds a doctorate in physics from the University of Chicago (1937), and has an honorary diploma from Ramer High School (1957), from which he received his two months' high school education. One of the original organizers of the Oak Ridge Institute of Nuclear Studies in 1945, Dean Rodgers was a long-time member of the Board of Directors and served as vice president of the Institute (1965-70) which was renamed Oak Ridge Associated Universities, Inc. Having taught elementary physics classes since 1932, he has done research in X-rays, statistics and theoretical physics, and is the state's most popular lecturer on the nuclear developments of the post World War II era. He has been chosen to have his records placed in the Archives of the American Institute of Physics as one of the leaders of the 20th Century.
