Title:Fragmented Whole: A Theory of Narrative and Identity

The purpose of this research project was to look at how identity may be formed through the use of narrative. In this undertaking, a grounded theory method of analysis was used to interpret the stories found in public documents created for the StoryCorp project. Through this analysis, a model of identity formation through narrative was concieved through three stages: separation, theoretical sense-making and reassimilation. The results show a strong correlation between self-narrative and identity construction.
