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Fertilizer Inspection and Analysis; Spring, 1951

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The purpose of this bulletin is to report the results of work carried on by the Missouri Agricultural Experiment Station in administering the Missouri Fertilizer Law during the period January 1 to June 30, 1951.

In order to provide protection against fraud in the sale of commercial fertilizers, the Missouri Fertilizer Law establishes certain requirements which must be met by the company or individual prior to the sale of fertilizers in this state. These requirements are:

1. Annual registration with the Missouri Agricultural Experiment Station of each brand and analysis to be offered for sale.
2. Proper labeling of the containers stating the same facts set forth in the registration.
3. Affixing to containers registration tags purchased from the Experiment Station giving proof of registry in the current year.

The law further provides that the Experiment Station shall inspect the stocks of fertilizer sold throughout the state and draw samples to be analyzed at the laboratory of the Experiment Station. The detailed results of this work are set forth in the following sections.

INSPECTION

The inspection work covered by this bulletin began the latter part of February and was carried on throughout the 1951 spring fertilizer season. Inspectors traveled a total of 10,949 miles calling on 543 dealers located in 295 Missouri cities, towns, and communities. Each county in the state is represented by two or more of the 1,131 official samples collected. An effort was made to obtain samples of every brand and analysis of fertilizer offered for sale in Missouri. The number of samples collected of a particular brand

does not necessarily indicate the proportion of that fertilizer sold in the state. However, an attempt was made to secure a larger number of samples of those brands and grades which were sold more extensively. This resulted in the collection of one sample for approximately every 358 tons of commercial fertilizer sold during the spring season.

VIOLATIONS

Table 1 summarizes the violations found during the spring of 1951. The companies are listed in the approximate order of number of bags of fertilizers reported as being offered for sale in violation of the Missouri Fertilizer Law. The omission of the dealers at whose place of business these violations were found is not intended to absolve them of joint responsibility of the violation. These dealers are indicated by footnotes in Table 4.

ANALYSIS OF SAMPLES

Each official sample collected was analyzed by the Experiment Station laboratories located at the University of Missouri, Columbia. These results are set forth in this bulletin by the use of three tables. Tables 2 and 3 summarize the analyses in order that the reader may tell at a glance the relative manner in which manufacturers have met guarantees. Table 4 presents in greater detail a description of each sample.

Table 2 compares, by the use of an index number, the amount of plant food present in the sample with that of the guarantee of the manufacturer. If the found value and the guarantee are the same the number 100 is used; should the guarantee be exceeded by the found value the number used is greater than 100; and in the event the guarantee is not equalled by the found value the number used is less than 100.

Table 3 summarizes and expresses as a percentage the deficient nutrients to total analyzed. In this table each of the three primary elements is considered as a sample so that the grand total in this table is greater than the actual number of fertilizer samples collected.

Table 4 includes the brand name, place of collection, analytical results, and guarantee of each official sample. Where there are two or more like samples of any brand the average analysis is given. If the guarantee is not equalled by an element that figure is underlined and such a sample is classed as deficient.

Table 5 is a list of companies, brand names, and guaranteed analyses of those fertilizers registered for sale in Missouri for 1951 as this bulletin goes to press.

ANALYTICAL TOLERANCES

The following tolerances have been set up for reporting deficient samples; one per cent (1%) of the guaranteed percentage of total nitrogen, one and one-half per cent (1 1/2%) of the guaranteed percentage of available phosphorus pentoxide (P_2O_5), and one and one-half per cent (1 1/2%) of the guaranteed percentage of water soluble potash (K_2O).

For example, in reporting the results of a 4-12-4 grade fertilizer, we would accept 3.96-11.82-3.94 as meeting the manufacturer's guarantee and would not underline these figures as being deficient.

The tolerances given here represent only the unavoidable analytical error in determinations made by the Experiment Station laboratory.
