Board Elects Charles Baron

The election of Charles B. Baron to the Jewish Hospital Board of Directors has been announced by Edward B. Greensfelder, president. Mr. Baron served previously on the board from 1961 to 1964.

Mr. Baron is a partner in the law firm of Baron, Stern and Liberman. He received his undergraduate degree from Amherst College, and his LL.B. from Yale University. He is a member of the Missouri Bar Association and the St. Louis Bar Association.

He is chairman of the St. Louis County Welfare Commission, chairman of the Board of Examiners of the Juvenile Court of the City of St. Louis and a member of the Board of Directors of the Sherwood Forest Camping Service.

Mr. Baron and his wife have four children.

The building was made possible by the gift of \$1 million from Charles H. Yalem, other gifts from throughout the community and a grant from the National Institutes of Health.

The dedication ceremonies will be held in the Mark C. Steinberg Memorial Amphitheater on the ground floor of the new building. David A. Gee, executive director, will be master of ceremonies.

Dr. Stanford Wessler, physician-in-chief, and Dr. Arthur E. Baue, surgeon-in-chief, will discuss research activities in their respective fields which will be carried out in the new building. Edward B. Greensfelder, president, will formally dedicate the building with the unveiling of a portrait of Mr. Yalem. City and state officials are expected to be special guests at the dedication ceremonies.

Guests will later tour the \$2,600,000 facility and division chiefs will be stationed in the laboratories to explain and demonstrate equipment. Floors 1-4 will be devoted to medical research; surgical research will be conducted on floors 5-8. The ninth floor will house experimental animals.

Topical Preview Program Conducted by Associates

The first in a series of special events sponsored by the Associates of the Jewish Hospital of St. Louis was held Sunday, April 21, from 3 to 5 p.m., in the Mark C. Steinberg Memorial Amphitheater located in the new Yalem Research Building.

Donald P. Gallop, secretary, was moderator of the meeting. Julian L. Meyer, president, delivered greetings to the group. Platform guests included Edward B. Greensfelder, president of the Hospital, and David A. Gee, executive director.

Abraham J. Garland, treasurer, outlined aims and purposes of the Associates.

The afternoon's program featured as speakers three members of the Medical Staff: Dr. Melvin M. Schwartz who spoke on "Therapeutic Abortion and Its Legalization"; Dr. Gene W. Spector, who addressed the group on "Coronary Angiography" and Dr. Alex H. Kaplan whose topic was "Psychedellic Drugs."

Dr. Schwartz spoke of his participation in the drafting of a bill on therapeutic abortion which was proposed in the state legislature. The bill failed to pass during the last session of the legislature but Dr. Schwartz is hopeful that a similar bill will soon become law. In pointing out the inadequacies of the present law, Dr. Schwartz said that the law states that abortion is legal only when required to save the life of the mother or that of the unborn child. He commented that abortion can never be performed without terminating the development of the fetus.

The increasing use of drugs by young people was viewed by Dr. Alex H. Kaplan as an outgrowth of the widening generational gap. "People who take drugs do so because of certain alienations," said Dr. Kaplan. He urged adults to learn the facts concerning drug usage so that they can better counsel young people as to the risks involved. "One result of this may lead to a lessened use of drugs as a way of solving problems related to the present emotional conflicts of the young people," Dr. Kaplan said.

Dr. Spector's slide presentation included a brief review of the anatomy and physiology of the heart. He explained special radiological procedures for locating diseased coronary arteries, so that corrective surgical measures can be taken. Dr. Spector commented that research has firmly established the practicality and efficacy of repairing one part of the heart before the still impractical necessity occurs of replacing the entire organ. He added that the departments of Radiology, Medicine and Surgery will soon begin a combined program of coronary angiography and corrective surgery for coronary artery disease.

The program concluded with tours of the Hospital and refreshments. At the time of this first meeting, 197 people were enrolled as charter members of the Associates. 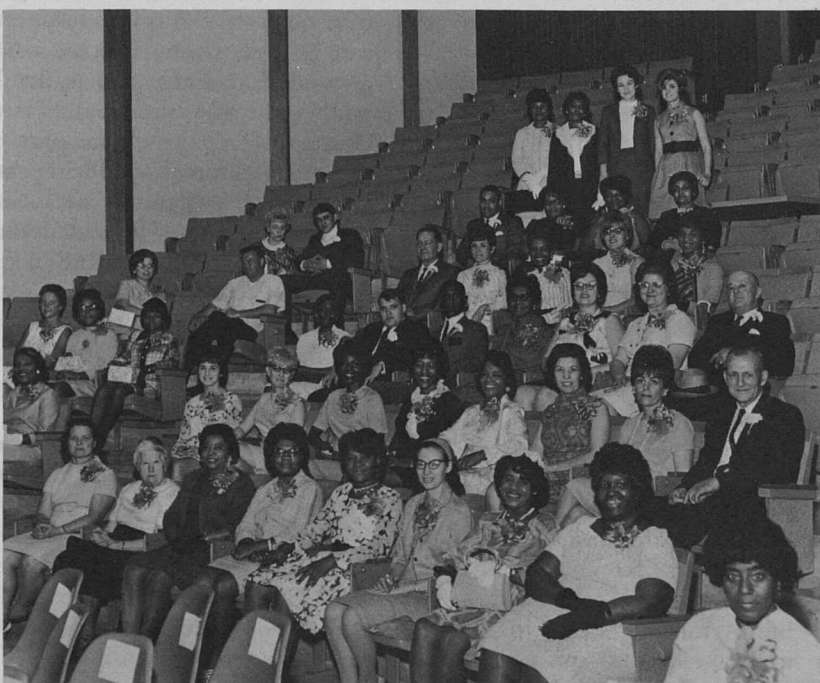

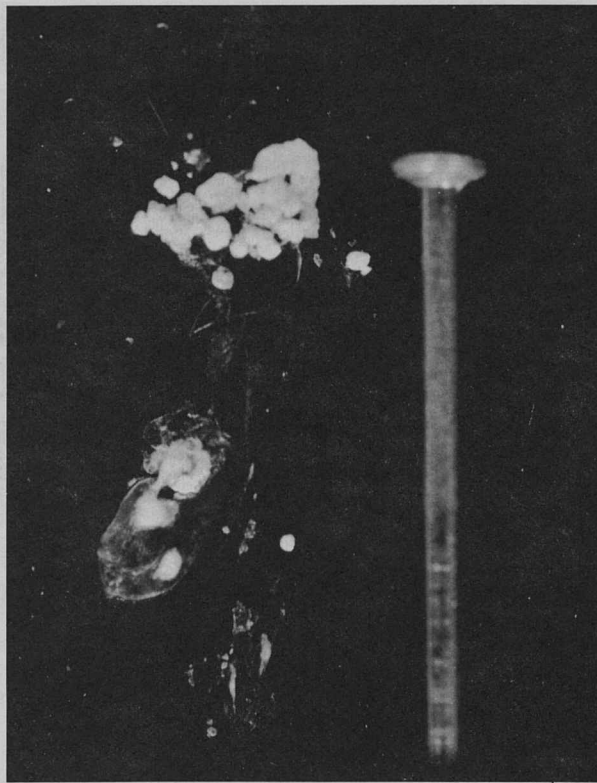

Our Voluntary Staff

Morton A. Binder, M.D.; Spare Time Researcher

Morton A. Binder, M.D., an associate attending physician in the Department of Medicine at Jewish Hospital, has a rather important side-interest . . . research.

This research involves the experimental production of gall stones in mice. He has a small corner and several cages in an animal laboratory where his mice are fed a daily diet high in fats and cholesterol with a cholic acid supplement.

The special diet used in Dr. Binder's investigative efforts was originated by Dr. Stanley Hartroft, former Professor of Pathology at Washington University Medical School, to produce arteriosclerosis (hardening of the arteries) in rats. Since rats do not have gall bladders, effects of this diet on this organ could not have been recognized by Dr. Hartroft.

Subsequent to Dr. Hartroft's research, Dr. Fred Caldwell and Dr. Jay Tepperman, of the University of Syracuse Medical School, used mice instead of rats in similar experiments. Since mice do have gall bladders, they accidentally discovered the formation of gall stones.

Dr. Binder's research is a continuation of the Syracuse University efforts.

"Now don't mislead anyone," he told the "216" reporter, "This 'research' is only a spare-time endeavor and doesn't compare at all to the highly organized full-time research efforts being conducted throughout the Hospital."

He continued, "One of my aims is to stimulate more interest in this under-investigated field. The human applications are enormous since more than 500,000 gall bladders are removed annually.

"Perhaps we might gain some insight into the occurrence of gall stones in humans if this research is pursued. If we can unravel the complex physical-chemical relationships, this information might

be applied to the prevention or dissolution of gall stones."

Dr. Binder attended Yale for his pre-medical studies, and received his M.D. degree from the Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons.

He serves on the staffs of Jewish, Barnes, St. Luke's and City Hospitals, and is active in local civic and professional groups.

He is president of the Internist Club; has served on the bulletin committee of the St. Louis Medical Society, and is on the Private Service Committee in the Departments of Medicine at both Jewish

and Barnes Hospitals.

He is vice-president of the Glenridge School PTA, and also assists with that school's Scout Troop 21.

Dr. Binder is a co-chairman of the Physicians Cabinet of the Jewish Federation and has helped in both the United Fund and Jewish Federation drives.

Storage capacity in the library has been greatly increased by the use of hinged shelving units. Back issues of periodicals are stored behind the panel displaying the current publication.

An electronic listening table has been installed so that students may listen to taped lectures of class discussions, as well as additional taped material beyond that covered in the class.

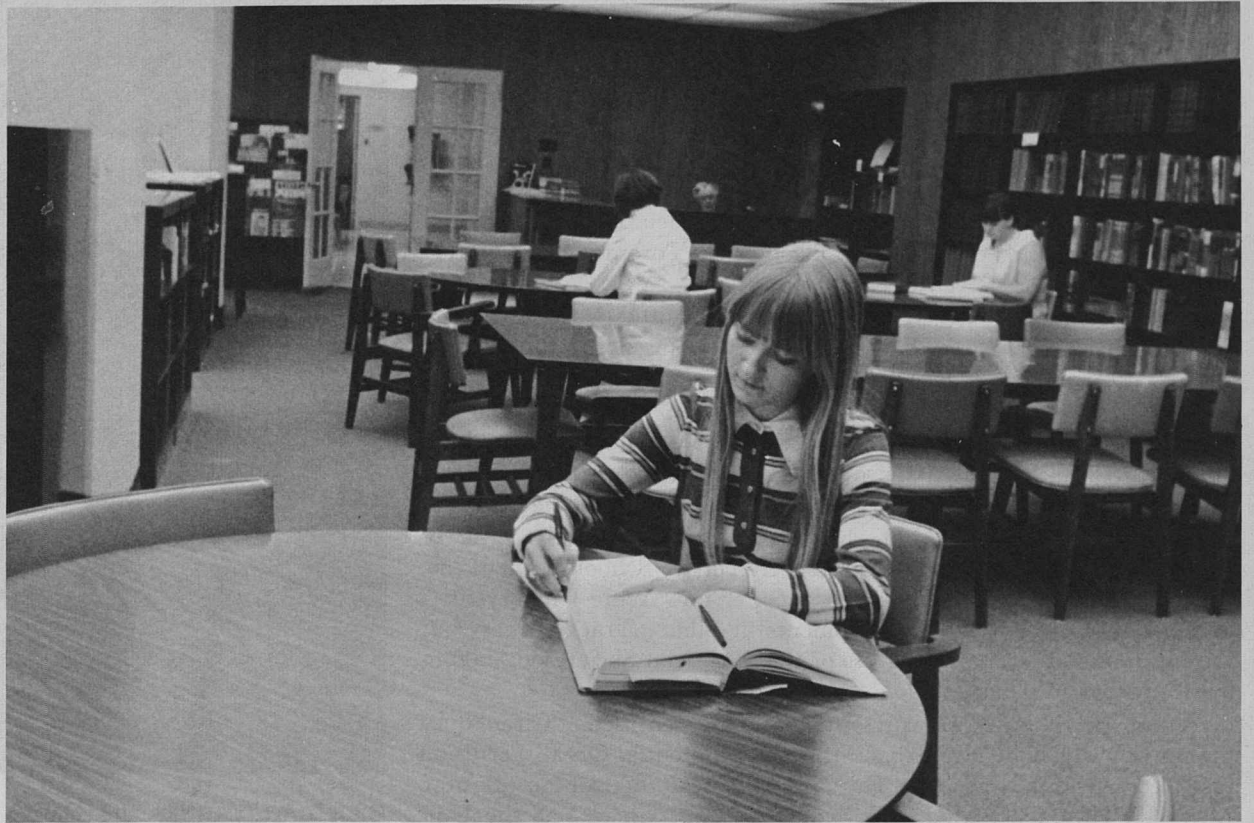
Other improvements include private study carrels and washable vinyl wall panels.

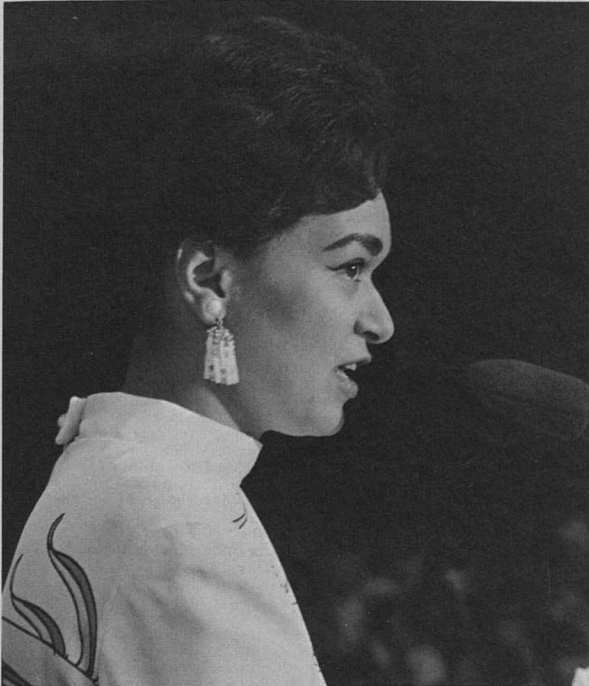

Scharffs' Donate Echoencephalograph

The equipment may also be used by the departments of Ophthalmology, Obstetrics-Gynecology, and Medicine to detect abnormalities. Use of the device in conjunction with X-rays gives more accurate diagnostic information as to the necessity and scope of surgery.

Opening of Yalem Building Highlights 33 Years of Research

The opening of the Yalem Research Building highlights the role which Jewish Hospital has played in basic scientific research for the past 33 years. From modest beginnings in 1935 Jewish Hospital has become the fourth largest purveyor of research in the state of Missouri—the first being Washington University, second is St. Louis University and third is University of Missouri.

Formal research at the Hospital was begun with a grant of \$1500 from Mrs. Florence G. May, wife of Morton J. May. The Florence G. and David May Research Fund was established in her honor and in memory of Morton J.'s father, David May, who was one of the original benefactors of Jewish Hospital.

Dr. Jacob G. Probststein was a key figure in setting up this fund and he, along with Dr. Samuel Grey, inaugurated research at the Hospital. Shortly after the fund was established, Dr. Michael Somogyi joined the staff as head of the Division of Biochemistry.

Dr. Somogyi had developed a laboratory test for the diagnosis of pancreatitis and his work — coupled with that of Dr. Probststein and Dr. Grey—resulted in studies of pancreatitis which have gained national and international recognition.

More than 100 publications, including two books, have been produced from this initial research activity.

In addition to the support received from the Florence G. and David May Research Fund another research fund was established by Louis M. Monheimer, which helped support the investigations for pancreatitis.

Dr. Somogyi also developed a test for determining diabetes and produced a medication for treatment — which was named insulin.

Following these early activities, the Hospital developed other programs of research and in 1956 the Board of Directors embraced the policy that basic research was not only a responsibility but a necessary adjunct to better pa-

tient care. At the present time the annual research budget is \$900,000 of which \$750,000 is provided through endowment income and other private sources. There are more than 60 research investigations currently under way in virtually every department.

With the completion of the nine story Yalem Research Building, research space now occupies 15% of the total building volume in the medical center. The new building provides four floors for medical research. These activities are under the direction of Dr. Stanford Wessler, Physician-in-Chief. Three floors are assigned to surgical research, under the direction of Dr. Arthur E. Baue, Surgeon-in-Chief. The top floor of the building houses large animals which are being used for the experimental pursuits.

Other active research programs at the Hospital are conducted by the Departments of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Pathology and Laboratory Medicine, Otolaryngology, Long Term Care, Psychiatry and Dentistry.

Probstein-Koplar Brace Fund Now Endowed

The Elsie Probstein-Harry Koplar Brace Fund, established in 1950 by Elsie Probstein in memory of her brother, Harry Koplar, has been transferred from a non-endowed patient care fund to a \$10,000 perpetual endowment fund. This change was made with a gift of \$7,200 from the estate of Nat Koplar. Dr. Jacob G. Probststein, one of the trustees for the estate, announced the gift recently.

This restricted endowment fund will continue to provide braces for indigent patients through the income gained annually. The principle of the fund remains intact.

In recognition of the fund, a bronze plaque, bearing the inscription "Elsie Probstein-Harry Koplar Brace Fund" has been installed in the waiting room in the Department of Rehabilitation.

Medical Staff Erects Plaque

The Medical Staff Council has voted to establish a memorial plaque outside the Jewish Hospital Chapel, memorializing those doctors who have served on the staff of the Hospital.

The Council began this project in January, 1968. The Council will place the name of any physician who serves on the staff and dies after January, 1968, on the plaque. Families and friends of those physicians who have died prior to January, 1968, and who wish the name of the physician placed on this plaque can do so by writing to the Hospital Chaplain, Rabbi Lawrence Siegel.

The first name to be placed on this memorial plaque is that of Dr. Milton Smith who died in January, 1698.
