

#### Mrs. Milton Stresses **Need for Nurses**

An article adapted from a paper presented at the American Hospital Association Meeting by Mrs. Harry Milton, a member of the Board of Trustees of the Hospital, appeared in the May issue of Trustee: Journal for Hospital Governing Boards.

In the paper presented at the AHA meeting in Chicago, Mrs. Milton emphasized the wants and needs for more nurses - nurses who are prepared, well taught, and well motivated. She feels that finding the means for meeting this overwhelming need is the responsibility of hospital leaders. "To plan wisely, trustees will need to face the realities of social change that underlie the present crisis. They must deal with the fact that, in this area, hospitals face a decade of crisis. Predictions are that the present severe shortage of nurses will continue for 10 years, despite concentrated effort to recruit from all population

In further stressing the present day need for nurses, Mrs. Milton pointed out that it is imperative hospital trustees face present realities and consider the implications - both immediate and long-range.

According to Mrs. Milton, former chairman of the Hospital's Nursing Committee, "Although the cost of maintaining hospital schools is rising steadily, it is imperative that trustees find the funds to keep their schools operative and productive."



# Survey Evaluating Educational Needs

The Training Center in the Department of Long Term Care conducted a survey to assess the educational needs of medical and paramedical personnel in caring for long term care patients.

Mail questionnaires geared to individual professions were developed and select site visits are planned. Results served as a basis for planning training activities and provided a picture of today's health professionals.

An initial pre-survey was made of physicians, occupational therapists, physical therapists, social workers, long term care administrators and Home Health Agencies in Missouri and Illinois: Results of the pre-survey confirm that the ever increasing number of long term care patients with physical disability and chronic disease has created a need for additional training in this specialized field.

Findings will serve as a basis for planning training activities and provide a picture of health professionals of today.

The endeavor is sponsored by the Bi-State Regional Medical Program for Heart Disease, Cancer and Stroke.



# Hospital Pathologists Testify in Washington
