

# Hospital Construction Plans Approved

## For \$21,500,000 Expansion

The Jewish Hospital of St. Louis moved into a bold new era which will meet the future challenges of medical advances and human needs with its recent announcement of a \$21,500,000 expansion program.

In making the announcement, Edward B. Greensfelder, president of the Hospital and president of the Washington University Medical Schools and Associated Hospitals said, "The expansion plans are based on a three year study of the facility and program potential of the Hospital and the requirements of the city and county for medical care."

A Long Range Planning Committee, headed by Stanley M. Richman, Hospital vice president, including representatives of the

Board, Medical Staff, and administration in consultation with medical and health care leaders recommended that "the expansion of the physical plant and other improvements were essential to maintain the present program at the same high level."

The Planning Committee specified only those needs, estimated to cost \$21,500,000, which must be satisfied immediately for the Hospital to meet demands of the community for excellent health care. The plans call for construction of a new nine story patient care facility along Forest Park Boulevard, adjacent to the Aaron Waldheim Clinic. This building along with the necessary equipment is estimated to cost

approximately \$12 million. It will provide urgently needed space for 100 new patient beds, radiology, surgery, pharmacy, central medical and surgical supply and patient and visitor conveniences. The building, which is being designed by the architectural firm of Schwarz and Henmi, can be expanded to 20 stories at a later date. A new main entrance to the Hospital will be constructed in the center of the block adjacent to the new building and the Yalem Research Building along Parkview Place.

A new six level parking garage with approximately 550 parking spaces will be constructed along Parkview Place adjacent to the Yalem Research Building and the Mark C. Steinberg Memorial

Hospital. Currently the Hospital provides parking space for only 260 vehicles. The lower level of the parking garage is designed to provide a new service loading dock and receiving entrance.

In addition to new construction, plans are included for major renovation and modernization of the present Hospital facilities. This will provide for the rapid changes in medical technology, new concepts of patient care, the future health and hospitalization requirements of the community, and the development of more efficient educational programs in conjunction with Washington University Medical School.

The expansion plan will alleviate overcrowding and improve the

effectiveness of the professional departments, ancillary and support facilities; and modernize nursing divisions for more effective patient care. For example, the present emergency room at the Hospital was designed for a fewer number of patients. However, the high incidence of accidents and other emergency situations has caused the facilities to be greatly overcrowded. The plans specify an expanded area for emergency room care which will include an overnight observation unit with monitoring equipment, larger examining rooms, cast room, an x-ray facility and a laboratory. The driveway entrance to the new emergency rooms will be enclosed from the elements for the safety and convenience of patients.

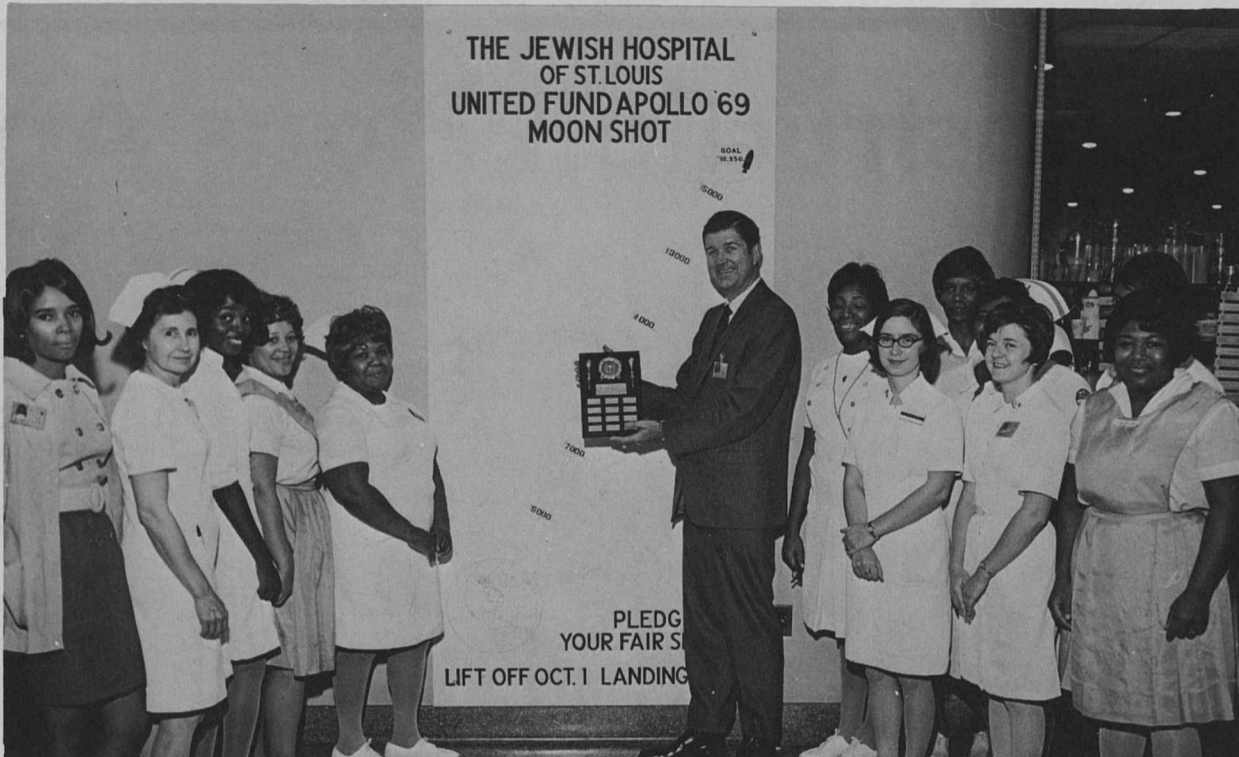
Nancy B. Rupprecht has been appointed Acting Assistant Director of In-Service Education.

## Hospital Employees Reach 1969-70 United Fund Goal

The Apollo '69 Moon Shot, the Jewish Hospital United Fund Campaign slogan, made a victorious landing as the Hospital campaign goal was attained with a grand "over the top," total of \$19,000.

Traditionally a leader among hospitals in "Above the Fair Share Giving," this year was no exception as employees contributed their share to the 1969-70 United Fund goal.

A poster of Shelly Austin, United Fund girl, was mounted near the cafeteria exit and a large moon poster programmed the

progress of the campaign. Samples of space food, donated by Pillsbury Baking Company, were given to each hospital employee at the October 1st kickoff rally.

Vernon Spradling, director of Systems and Procedures, served as chairman of the United Fund Steering Committee and Nancy B. Rupprecht, assistant director, In-Service Education was co-chairman. Both expressed thanks to their committee, the many coordinators who collected for the campaign, and the more than 1600 employees who gave.

A plaque was awarded to the 1-South nursing division for being the first nursing division to reach the 100 percent mark. This was the second year that 1-South received the plaque. Runners-up were the nurses on 5-center and 7-center.

### Hospital Construction Program continued

Major renovation will be accomplished in the Department of Radiology which is presently located in a 6000 square foot area constructed in 1926. The space will be tripled to 18,000 square feet in order to accommodate the greatly increased number of cases since the facility was opened. In 1968 more than 52,000 radiologic procedures were performed by the department as compared to 23,000 ten years ago.

Expansion of clinical laboratories is specified in the renovation program. In 1968, the laboratories performed more than 528,000 tests as compared to 224,000 in 1958. Additional space is needed for specialized laboratories in pathology, biochemistry, microbiology, serology, endocrine chemistry and autopsy facilities.

Major renovation is required in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology. An additional 4000 square feet of space will provide for new nurseries, three new delivery rooms, a seven bed labor room, badly needed office space and research facilities.

Major alterations will be made in the Department of Surgery with the addition of a new operating suite. The Hospital performed more than 8,500 surgical operations in 1968 compared with 5,700 in 1958.

"The expansion and modernization process which has been fully approved by the Alliance for Regional Community Health, Inc. (formerly the Metropolitan St. Louis Hospital Planning

Commission) is envisioned as a phased program of both new construction and renovation of present facilities carefully planned and timed to provide a maximum of new and improved facilities with a minimum disruption of patient care and services during construction," Mr. Greensfelder said.

The present timetable for phased expansion calls for construction of the new parking facility during 1970. The new nine story building and renovation of the present Hospital is scheduled for completion by 1974.

Paul M. Zoll, M.D., Clinical Professor of Medicine, Harvard Medical School, delivered the Eleventh Arthur E. Strauss Visiting Professor of Medicine Lecture November 10 and 11 in the Mark C. Steinberg Memorial Amphitheatre.

"An Explanation of Partial A-V Block" was Dr. Zoll's subject at the presentation on Monday, November 10. At the Grand Rounds on November 11, Dr. Zoll spoke on "Heart Block: Drug Treatment and Electrical Stimulation."

The Annual Lectures, in honor of Dr. Strauss, former Chief of Medicine and President of the Jewish Hospital Medical Staff, were established in 1959 by Dr. Strauss' colleagues and friends in recognition of his service to the community, the state and the nation. He was one of the founders of the American Heart Association established in 1926. The lecture was held in honor of Dr. Strauss' 80th birthday.

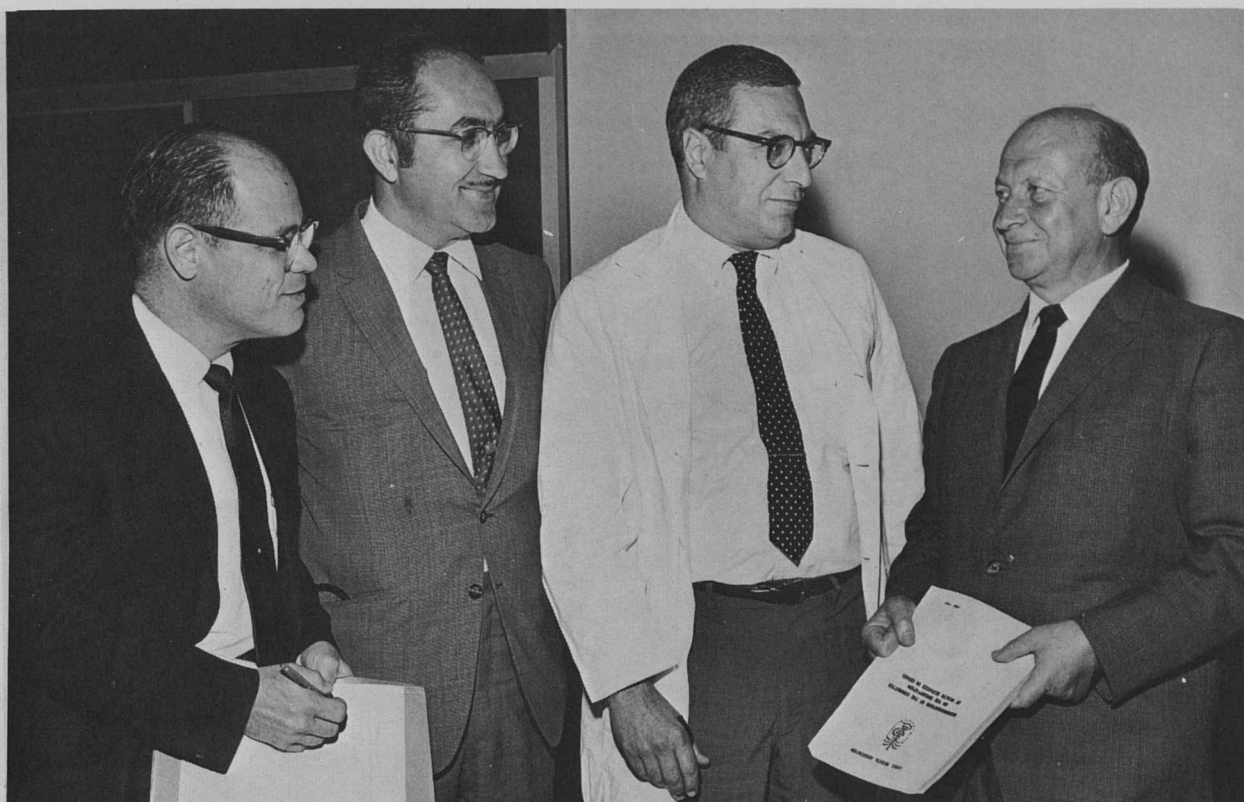

## Professor Mann Guest of Medical Staff

Professor Kalman Jacob Mann, director-general of the Hadassah Medical Organization in Israel and associate professor of organization and health care at Hebrew University in Jerusalem, was a guest speaker at the Jewish Hospital October 7. His lecture to the Medical Staff was titled "Delivery of Medical Care in Israel."

During the recent Middle East War, the Government of Israel placed Professor Mann in charge of health services for the entire Jerusalem area. This was in addition to his functions as the head of the Hadassah-Hebrew University Medical Center, where he personally supervised the treatment and care of war casualties, including captured Jordanian wounded.

Born in Jerusalem, Palestine, at a time when the country was still a Turkish Protectorate, of a family which had been settled in the land for decades, Professor Mann

received his early training in England. He was educated at University College and University College Hospital in London, where he qualified for medicine in 1937.

In 1942, he was assistant medical registrar at the University College Hospital, and between 1943 and 1946, he was consultant physician to the Ministry of Health to the Northwest Sector of London. From 1946-1949, he held the post of research physician with the Medical Research Council on the Pneumokomiosis Research Unit.

In 1949, he returned to his native land and served as assistant medical director of the Hadassah Medical Organization, specializing in check and TB service. He became the director-general of the Hadassah Medical Organization in 1951.

Professor Mann's contribution to tuberculosis and pneumokomiosis have now extended to the medical planning field with the creation of the Neighborhood Community and Family Health Center at Bet Mazmil (Kiryat Yovel). The principles on which this center is based have found their realization

in Israel where they are being emulated by the Sick Funds and Israel community health authorities.

The new Hadassah-Hebrew University Medical Center in the Judean Hills on the western outskirts of Jerusalem was opened under Professor Mann's administration in 1961. The Medical Center is the largest building complex in Israel and embodies the most modern facilities.

He was recently reappointed to a five-year term as a member of the Expert Advisory Panel on the organization of medical care of the World Health Organization, and serves on the 21-member Council of Management of the International Hospital Federation.

In a speech during his visit to St. Louis, Professor Mann said that although his beleaguered nation does not believe in turning the other cheek, it also does not believe in hate. "Hate is a paralyzing luxury which we cannot afford... We are too busy being constructive. We are trying to build a better nation and a better life for our people."

## Senior Named New Pulmonary Lab Director

The Jewish Hospital recently announced the opening of a Pulmonary Laboratory, one of the new enlarged laboratories recently developed within the Department of Medicine, to diagnose and treat diseases allied to the heart and lungs.

Dr. Robert M. Senior, a graduate of Oberlin College and the George Washington University School of Medicine, will head the Pulmonary Laboratory and serve as Chief of the Department of Medicine's Pulmonary Division, as well as Assistant Professor of Medicine at Washington University.

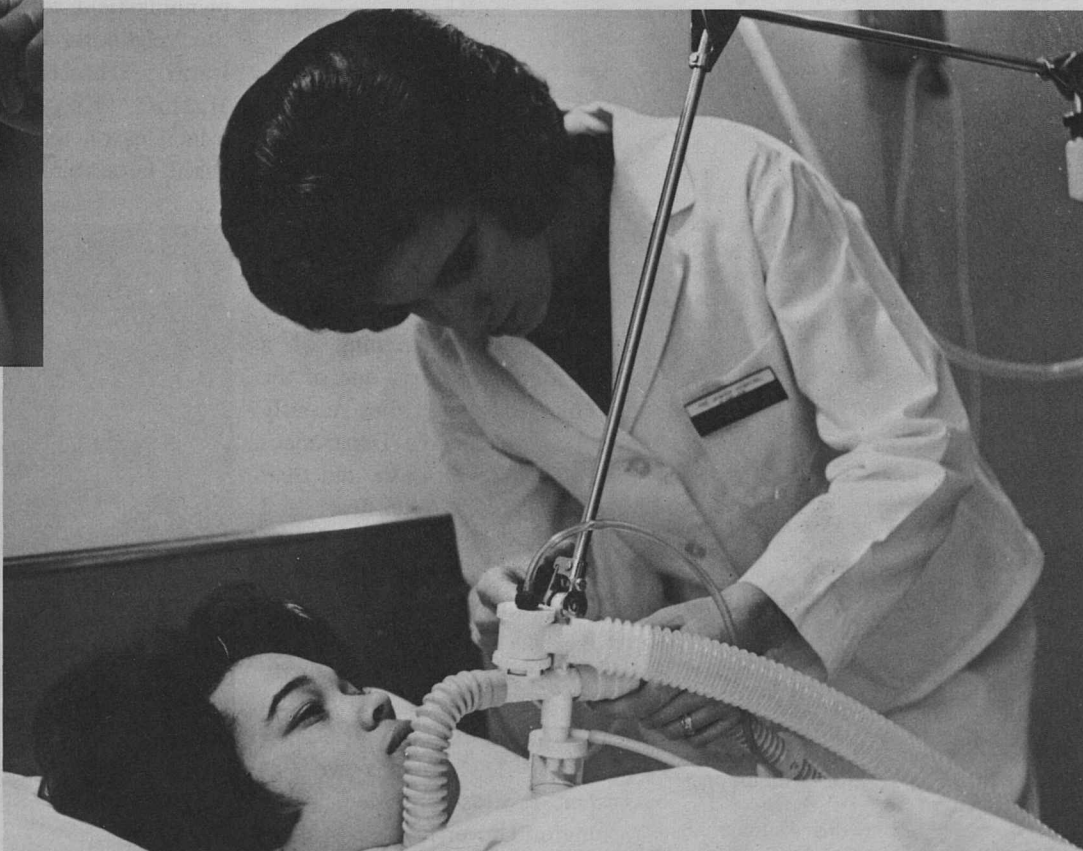
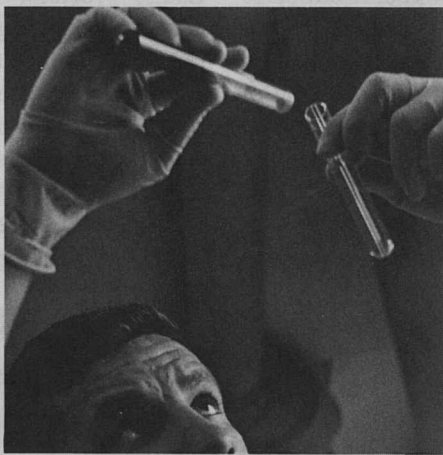
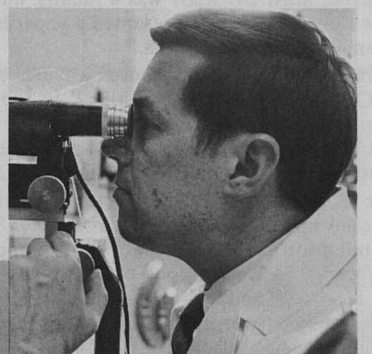
