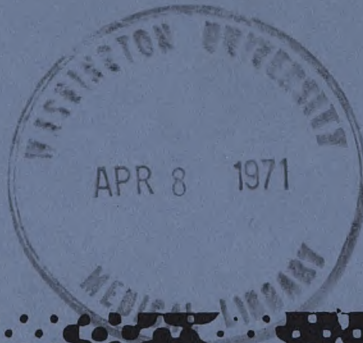

# Hospital Graduates 72 Nurses

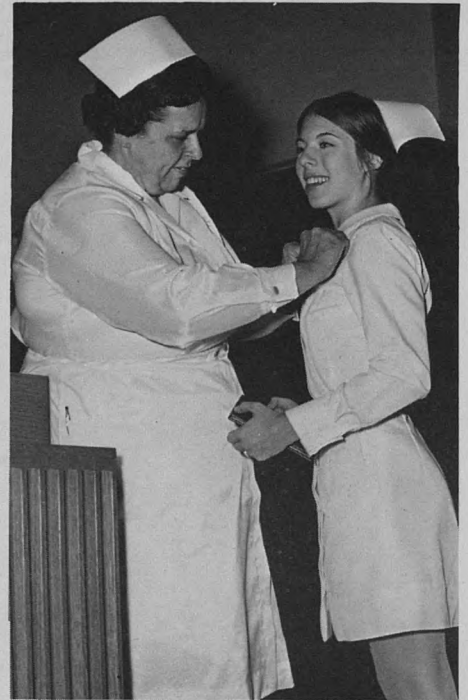

## Joseph Ruwitch Presented 1971 Brotherhood Citation

In recognition of "his commitment to the community and his charitable works," Joseph F. Ruwitch, a member of the Hospital's Board of Directors and former president of the Hospital, was one of three St. Louisans awarded the 1971 Brotherhood Citation of the National Conference of Christians and Jews.

The presentations were made March 23 at the 43rd Anniversary Brotherhood Banquet, where Mr. Ruwitch was cited for his leadership and influence in the work of the National Conference of Christians and Jews and for aiding the "Brotherhood of Man under the Fatherhood of God."

Mr. Ruwitch's commitment to the community is evidenced by the role he has played through his membership and leadership participation in community organizations and endeavors, illustrating his interest in St. Louis life.

A native of Chicago, Joseph Ruwitch was graduated from the University of Michigan in 1932 with an A.B. degree, and received an LLB degree from that university in 1934.

Currently president of the Renard Linoleum and Rug Company, Mr. Ruwitch holds membership on the Board of Directors of the Bank of St. Louis; he serves as Chairman of the Board of Directors of Alvey Conveyer, Co.; and is a member of the boards of Warren Realty Co., Winloe Realty Co.

Mr. Ruwitch is a trustee of St. Louis University and serves as a member of the Board of Directors of the Jewish Federation of St. Louis, an organization he served as president; he is a member of the board of Washington University Medical School and Associated Hospitals Medical Center; serves on the Executive Committee and the Board of

In addition to the organizations he presently serves, Mr. Ruwitch has also held memberships on the boards of directors of various other community organizations including the St. Louis Symphony and the Jewish Community Relations Council.

At The Jewish Hospital, Mr. Ruwitch has served in various capacities. A member of the Hospital Board of Directors since 1955, he served as vice president, then president of the Hospital in 1961.

Mr. Ruwitch is married to the former Elizabeth Renard, who is also active in community organizations and has served as president of the Jewish Hospital Auxiliary.

## Dr. Avioli Named to Occupy Shoenberg Chair in Medicine

Louis V. Avioli, M.D., chief of the Division of Endocrinology and Metabolism, Department of Medicine, at The Jewish Hospital and Professor of Medicine at the Washington University School of Medicine, has been named the Sydney M. and Stella H. Shoenberg Professor of Medicine, it was announced jointly by Edward B. Greensfelder, President of the Hospital, and Dr. William H. Danforth, Vice-Chancellor of the Washington University School of Medicine.

Dr. Avioli will occupy the chair which was recently endowed at Jewish Hospital and Washington University through a gift to Jewish Hospital of \$500,000 from Sydney M. Shoenberg, Sr., and his three sons, Sydney M., Jr., John M. and Robert H. Shoenberg.

The income from this endowment will support Dr. Avioli's research in metabolic and malignant diseases with emphasis on disorders of bone.

Dr. Avioli, who was named in 1970 as chairman of the Arthritis and Metabolic Diseases Program-Project Committee, Division of Research Grants of the National Institutes of Health, was graduated magna cum laude from Princeton College and received his M.D. degree from the Yale Medical College.

He joined the faculty of Washington University School of Medicine in 1966 as Assistant Professor of Medicine and director of the Division of Endocrinology and Metabolism at The Jewish Hospital. In 1968, he was promoted to Associate Professor and in July, 1970, he was appointed Professor of Medicine at Washington University.

In keeping with his interest in experimental science, Dr. Avioli is a member of numerous societies, including the Society for Experimental Biology and Medicine, the Orthopedic Research Society, the American Nuclear Society, the Endocrine Society, the American Physiological Society, the American Society of Nephrology, the Society of Molecular Biology and the American Society for Clinical Investigation. He presently is also on the editorial boards of *The Journal of Clinical Endocrinology and Metabolism* and the *Journal of Laboratory and Clinical Investigation*.

Dr. Avioli has published more than 40 papers on various aspects of calcium and bone metabolism in man and animals and has also researched problems of bone disease with emphasis on the skeleton changes of patients with longstanding kidney failure.

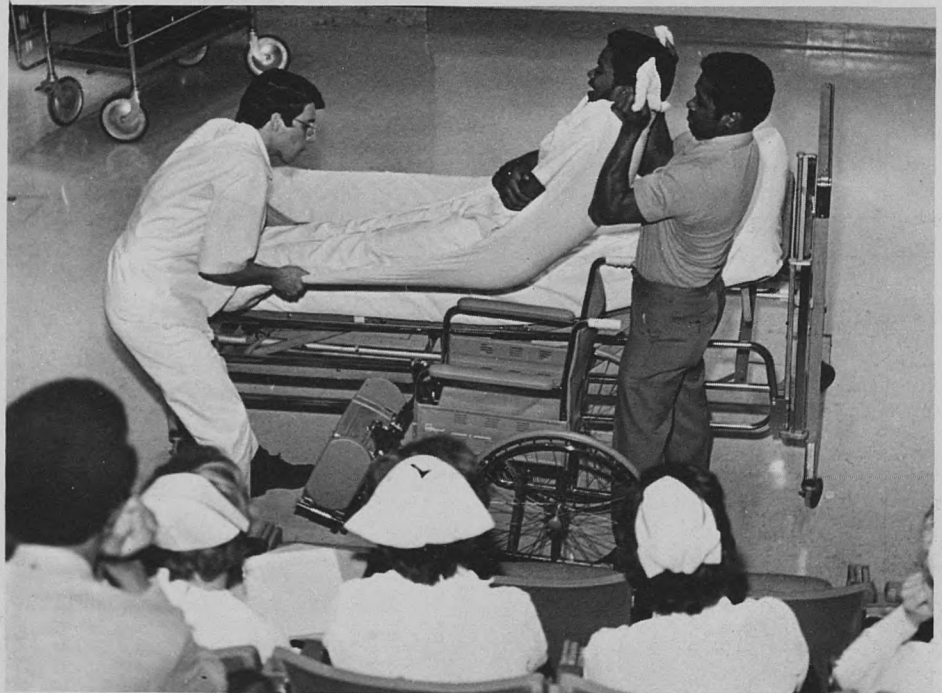
