# **New Feature - Financial Transaction Services**

A new feature has been added to the FTS Travel Component. The history of all activity associated with a Travel Authorization/Reimbursement is now available. FTS users now have access to a detailed record of action taken on their travel requests, including the date, action and any added comments at each level of approval. Now, reviewers and approvers can add comments when taking any type of action. Comments are also captured and included in email notifications to the traveler or requester. We hope you find the new feature beneficial in monitoring the activity of travel requests submitted through FTS.

# **Student Email**

As previously communicated, we are migrating the SJSU Student Email accounts from Microsoft Hotmail to utilize the same Google Mail platform used by SJSU faculty and staff, allowing for enhanced interaction within the available Google Apps platform. As part of the transition, the student email accounts will change from <u>student.name@students.sjsu.edu</u> to <u>student.name@sjsu.edu</u>.

The new student email accounts will be available on Tuesday, November 13, 2012. Login to the new @sjsu.edu account will use the SJSUOne ID which is used for access to MySJSU today. We are not able to automatically migrate previous student email to the new Google account. However, instructions on how students can individually migrate the previous email are available at <u>Student Email</u>.

We will enable temporary routing of the email addressed to old accounts to the new @sjsu.edu account through December 31, 2012. After that date, email sent to @students.sjsu.edu will not be delivered.

Bicycle theft has been on the increase. By registering your bicycle, you increase the chance of having a lost or stolen bicycle returned to you. Members of the University Police Department (UPD) are able to verify the ownership status of a bicycle if it is registered with the National Bike Registry.

On October 18, 2012, UPD detectives and cadets set up a bicycle registration booth in the Campus Village Quad for residents of Housing. Over 30 bicycles were registered during this successful event.

UPD is now offering free bicycle registration with the <u>National Bike Registry</u> to members of the campus community. If you are interested, visit UPD with your Tower Card to receive free registration materials.

Each member of the campus community may register one bicycle for free. Tower Card holders may purchase additional registration packets for \$3.50. Non Tower Card holders may purchase registration packets for \$7.00.
