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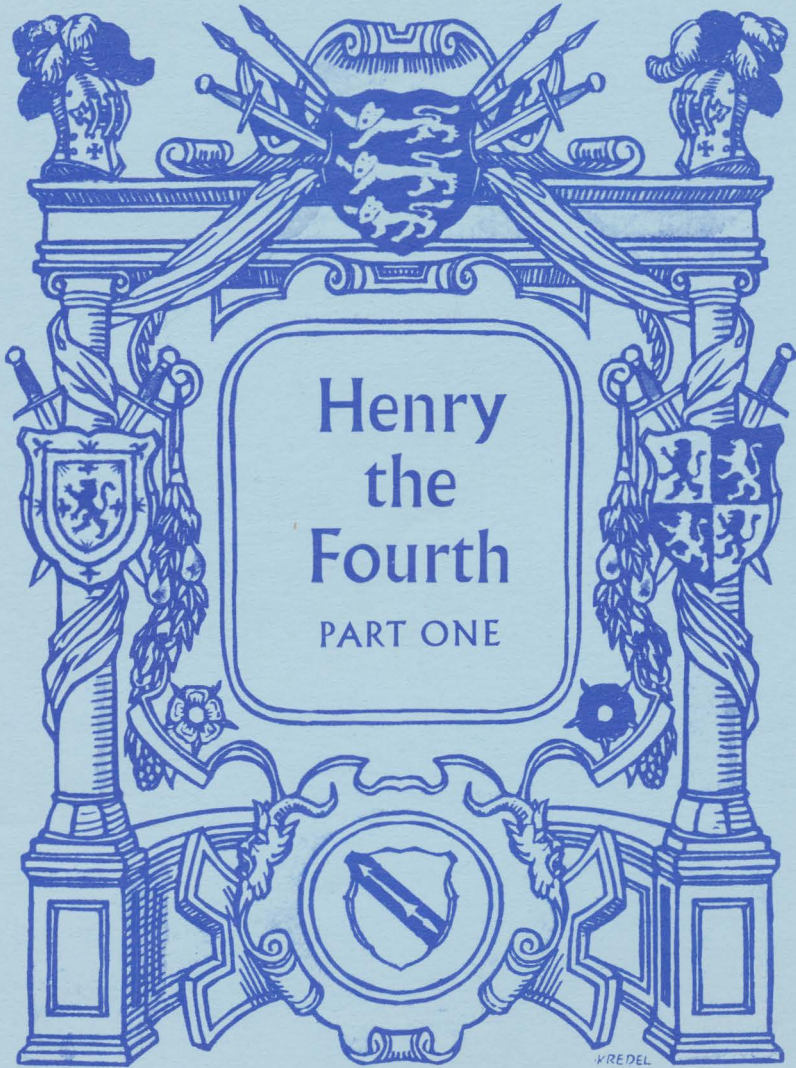

Henry Bolingbrooke led the effort to depose the vacillating Richard II and succeeded to the English crown in 1400. In Henry IV some of his dissatisfied former allies rebel, led by the brilliant Henry Percy (Hotspur). At the heart of the play is the depiction of the wayward heir apparent, Prince Hal, and his roguish companion Falstaff- Shakespeare's supreme comic creation. Hal renounces the dissolute life he has led to champion the cause of his father, culminating in hand-to-hand combat with Hotspur.
