 LONDON (UPI) - The United States today received overWheeming support for its viet Nam policies from its allies in thethe Southeast Asia Treaty Organization SEATO. Only France sounded a discordant note.
etropean press critictzes johnson LONDON (UPI) - President Johnson's administration drew U.S. Marines into the Dominican Republic. The West German Sueddeutsche Zeitung of Munich said, "Presi dent Johnson has endangered his reputation in his own hemisphere . . ." It said responsible politicians in many Latin American republics "suspect the United States wants to help a governing military junta, which is closely cooperating with New York banking houses, against a democratic president who was illegally driven from his country."
There was no official French comment. But the French newspaper, Combat, said, "Those who heaved a sigh of relief last Nov. 3 are admitting today they rejoiced too soon. Barry Goldwater, if he
