



### How to Identify Potential Data Literacy Needs on Your Curriculum Maps

#### Step 1: Please think of data literacy needs from the perspective of this definition:

"is the ability to read, create and communicate data as information" Wikipedia


This definition encompasses both literacy related to data management and curation of data produced by students and faculty AND literacy related to data produced by others.

### Step 2: Annotate course branch with potential data literacy needs

Use the information icon



to identify courses that have potential data literacy




### Step 3: Annotate faculty branch with grant information

Use the money bag icon to identify faculty that have grants within the current year.

Use these lists of current faculty grants divided by campus to find out if your faculty has grants this year.
