

Illinois Immigrant Political Almanac

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Immigrants make up a growing part of our state’s population. As immigrants settle in our state, become citizens, and register to vote, we are also playing an increasingly key role in our state’s electorate. The following report documents the growth of Illinois immigrant voters, not just in size but also in our share of the total electorate. It also demonstrates how immigrant voters are settling in key areas of the state where they could swing elections and thus determine the balance of power on the state and federal level.

The Illinois electorate, especially in key areas of metro Chicago, is made up increasingly of new citizens born outside the US.

Foreign-born adult US citizens make up 8.6% of all adult citizens in Illinois. The number of foreign-born citizens in Illinois grew 30% since 2000, from 579,897 to 754,674. Of these, 61% (463,242) reside in the Chicago suburbs.

In the city of Chicago, a traditional immigrant-receiving area, 13.6% of all adult citizens are foreign-born. Of even greater significance is the growth of the immigrant citizen population in suburban Chicago:

The share of immigrant citizens among total adult citizens **nearly doubled in Will and Grundy Counties combined**, growing from 3.9% in 2000 to 6.9% now. Certain areas of Will County witnesses more than twofold growth in their numbers of foreign-born adult citizens:

- In DuPage, Plainfield, Wheatland Townships combined, the number of immigrant adult citizens grew an astounding 235%, and foreign-born adult citizens now make up one out of every nine (11.4%) of all adult citizens.
- In Lockport, New Lenox, Homer, Frankfort Townships combined, foreign-born adult citizens grew by 111%, and now comprise 6.4% of all adult citizens.

Similarly, the number of immigrant adult citizens grew 235% in Algonquin and Grafton Townships in McHenry County, and now make up nearly one in ten (9.6%) of all adult citizens.

In many areas throughout the Chicago region, **new naturalized citizens are making up for declines among native-born citizens**

In **suburban Cook County**, the growth in new naturalized adult citizens since 2000 (55,450) more than made up for the decline among native adult citizens (45,447). This demographic shift was most dramatic in townships in the northern part of the county, but occurred also in other areas throughout.

A similar trend occurred in **DuPage County**, which gained 26,685 new foreign-born adult citizens while losing 3,489 native-born adult citizens.

Latinos and Asians make up a large portion of registered voters, particularly in the collar counties.

Latino and Asian American citizens are largely, though not exclusively, immigrants themselves or children of immigrants. Out of more than 8 million registered voters in Illinois, 6.9% are Latino and 1.7% are Asian American. While Cook County has the highest percentage of Latino registered voters (12.2%), Kane County has almost the same share of voters who are Latino as Cook, 12.1%. In other words, **nearly one out of every eight registered voters in Kane County is Latino.**

While the share of Latino registered voters is high throughout the collar counties (Lake 7.9%, Will 7.2%, Kendall 7.6%), the county with the third highest proportion of Latino registered voters is Cass, in central Illinois. In Cass County, one of every eleven registered voters (9.1%) is Latino. In addition, in Boone County, Latinos make up 7.5% of all registered voters.

DuPage County has the highest share of Asian American voters (4.0%). The county with the next highest Asian American share is Champaign, with 3.1%, followed by Lake (2.5%) and Cook (2.4%).

Immigrant voters have the potential to swing key Illinois Congressional Districts.

Foreign-born citizens make up 34.3% of voting-age citizens in the 9th Congressional District (represented by Jan Schakowsky (D)) and 33.8% in the 4th District (Luis Gutierrez (D)). In six Congressional Districts, immigrants make up at least 10% of all adult citizens.

The 14th Congressional District (represented by Bill Foster (D)) has the highest share of Latino registered voters of any district outside Cook County (9.4%). This percentage is surpassed only by the 4th District (59.3%), the 5th (17.8%) and the 3rd (17.2%).

The 9th District has the highest percentage of Asian American registered voters (5.5%). The districts with the next highest Asian American share of registered voters are the 6th (3.9%), the 13th (3.8%), and the 10th (3.7%)

As the charts below demonstrate, the numbers of Latino and in some cases Asian American registered voters exceeded the margin of victory in several Illinois Congressional races in 2006, as well as in the 2008 special election in the 14th District. These voters could similarly provide the margin of victory in several closely contested Congressional races this year.

Latino and Asian American voters in key state legislative districts

Latinos make up 10% or more of all registered voters in 12 out of 59 Illinois Senate districts. This includes the following swing districts in the collar counties: the 22nd (held by Mike Noland (D), 17.9%), the 42nd (held by Linda Holmes (D), 14.9%), and 43 (Arthur Wilhemi (D), 10.9%). Latinos make up 5% of registered voters in 27 Senate districts.

Asian Americans make up 3% or more of all registered voters in 14 out of 59 Illinois Senate districts. The highest proportion is in the 8th District (held by Ira Silverstein (D)), where 8.4% of registered voters, or one in twelve, is Asian American. Asian Americans make up more than 5% of all registered voters also in the 28th (John Millner (R), 5.8%) and the 29th (Susan Garrett (D), 5.3%).

Latinos make up 10% or more of all registered voters in 25 out of 118 Illinois House districts, and at least 5% in 50 districts. Asian Americans make up 3% or more of all registered voters in 24 districts. As the following charts illustrate, these districts include several that had close races in 2006 or have hotly contested races this year in which Latino and Asian American voters could prove crucial.

The numbers of Latino registered voters exceeds the margin of victory in four close Senate races and at least eight close House races in 2006. In three of the Senate races and three of the House races, the number of Asian American registered voters in the district exceeded the winning margin.. All of these seats are up for election again this year, along with several other seats in districts with large shares of Latino and Asian registered voters.

In the two Senate races and ten of the hottest House races this year, Latinos and Asian Americans combined make up at least 8% of registered voters. In both Senate races and six of the House races, Latinos make up at least 5% of the electorate. In four of the House races, Asian Americans make up at least 5% of the electorate.

Conclusion: Immigrants as a Growing Electoral Force

This report documents the growth of immigrant voting power in Illinois. With the surge in citizenship applications during 2007, and as more immigrants realize the stake they have in federal and state policies that affect their lives and their families, the numbers of foreign-born citizens will surely continue to increase. As these immigrants naturalize and register to vote, they will increasingly become a force that candidates and elected officials of both parties must reckon with.
