On to Washington - 1982

Hon. M. Brent Oldham President-Elect

The successful 1981 annual meeting and seminar at the National Judicial College in Reno, Nevada was a stellar event in the history of the National Association of Administrative Law Judges. In the ensuing months significant developments have occurred on the Federal scene that impact heavily upon the varied fields of activities of the NAALJ members. The immediate future seems destined to bring further changes that will affect the entire governmental administrative law system. What better place than Washington to feel the pulse and obtain the sense and trend of these important changes.

The core of the program will be a series of addresses, lectures, discussions and panel sessions on the latest developments in administrative law, including the 1981 revision of the Model State Administrative Procedure Act. In addition, the program will review recent Federal budget reductions, proposed Federalism plans, and deregulation and their impact on state and local administrative law activities. Noted speakers and scholars in the field will participate. The program will be conducted Monday, September 20, through Thursday, September 23, with Friday, September 24, set aside for visits to elements of the court system.

The annual meeting will be held at the Quality Inn - Capitol Hill 415 New Jersey Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001, (202) 638-1616. Registrants are requested to make their own hotel reservations by August 30. Rates for single persons are approximately \$65.00 and \$77.00 for doubles. The Inn is located in the heart of the judicial district, near Congress and the U.S. Capitol. It is in walking distance of most of the historic sites, and the famous Watergate and Potomac River front are ten minutes by cab. The National Airport is fifteen minutes away and the Metro System (subway) is within three blocks. The Inn has a roof-top pool with a breath-taking view of the city. Special meal prices are available for children and parking is free for residents of the Inn.

The annual meeting registration fee is \$75.00. The luncheons (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday) and the banquet Thursday night are formal parts of the program. The registrants are requested to include in their registration \$16.00 for each luncheon and \$35.00 for the banquet. These meal prices include the gratuity and tax. Other meals are not part of the formal program.

The Inn has a sight-seeing service and suggested trips and night activities will be included in the registration package.

Washington is beautiful in September. The heavy tourist trade is over and Congress will be in session. The Capitol offers an unlimited number of attractions and many fine restaurants and clubs.
