NUMBER SB-99S-1161

- Whereas: The Student Government Association of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
- Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is one of four standing committees of the SGA Senate, which is responsible for the management of the A&S Budget, included in this the Student Conference Travel and Unallocated Reserve Accounts, and;
- Whereas: The Student Government Association feels it is necessary to sponsor a "Student Appreciation Day/Night" to help promote spirit, student awareness, political awareness, and to aid in the fight against student apathy, and;
- Whereas: This event will provide students with food, music, and appreciation gifts (i.e. T-shirts), and there will be a table designated for voter registration and information concerning upcoming referendums that will be on the ballot, and;
- Whereas: The breakdown of the monies is as follows:
