





The Ponte Vedra Golt Course, designed by Herbert Strong, the designer of courses at Murray Bay, Canada, and at the Engineer's Club on Long Island, is one of the finest in the Southeastern States. It is always kept in first rate shape, and golfers can spend many pleasant and interesting days there. The Ponte Vedra Course is a seaside course, so the Scotch name "Golf Links" may be used.

The course is a full championship one; 18 holes; with a length of 6,427 yards and Par of 71.

This course is the choice for the 1935 Annual Tournament of the Florida State Golf Association.





BATHING is one of the favorite Ponte Vedra sports. A spacious Bath Club has been built, but Club Guests are permitted to use their own bathrooms for changing into bathing suits should they so desire.

All guest cottages are within easy walking distance of the Beach.

FISHING is another sport that provides much interest. Visitors may fish in the surf as illustrated here; in the salt water creeks in the immediate vicinity; or may procure boats and guides at Mayport for expeditions out to sea.

The St. Johns River Entrance Jetties at Mayport and the Snapper Banks several miles offshore are two of the best fishing locations on the South Atlantic Coast.





The Club has three spacious Guest Cottages, one illustrated on the left, fronting the lagoon and surrounded by the Golf Course; and two, one of which is illustrated below, fronting on the ocean.

Guests in these cottages go to the main Club House for their meals, and, of course, have the use of the Club Lobbies for sitting rooms. Complete hotel room service is given and each guest bedroom is equipped with a telephone through which long distance calls may be made.

All rooms in Guest Cottages have private baths and twin beds. All Guest Cottages have some type of central heating, either steam or hot water, and several bedrooms have open fireplaces. The bedrooms can be connected ensuite if desired. In the ocean front houses each room has an outside door so that surf bathers can reach their bedrooms without having to walk through halls.





Guests desiring to make extended stays can have extra rooms furnished as sitting rooms. Such sitting rooms are particularly desirable on the ocean front where a number of such rooms with fireplaces can be so furnished.
