## AN ADDITION TO OHIO BIRDS.

Mr. Irving A. Field, of Dennison University, Granville, announces the capture of a European Widgeon (Mareca penelope) on the Licking Reservoir, Saturday morning, March 29, 1902, by Mr. Peter Hayden of Columbus. This European species has been found in the eastern parts of the United States several times, but this is the first one on record for Ohio.
