

## PREFACE

---

Because of limited funds it has been necessary drastically to cut many of the Road School papers in printing these Proceedings. An attempt has been made, however, to preserve the essential features of each paper. In this effort to conserve space, the program has also been eliminated.

On account of a severe blizzard in the middle of the Road School week with the resulting temperatures about 20 below zero, the total registration for this year's Road School was reduced to 726, as compared to last year's record attendance of 1,000.
