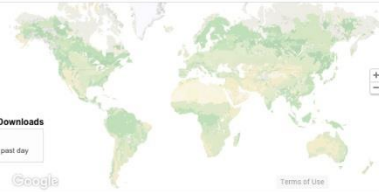

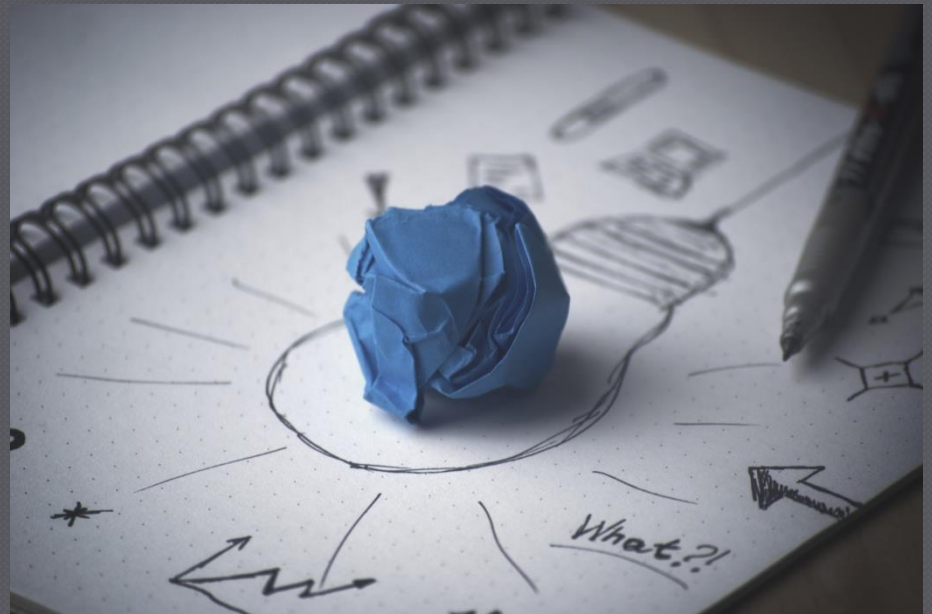
- ◉ Define your terms
