# Knowledge Exchange, Primary Health Care and Nursing: The role of the Primary Health Care

#### What is Knowledge Exchange?

Knowledge exchange is the process of making best use of research evidence and knowledge to inform policy and practice; to facilitate and nurture collaborative relationships between researchers and decision makers.




