## University Celebrates Civic Engagement

BLOOMINGTON, III.— Student groups, athletic teams and individuals were honored along with faculty, staff and community partners at the fifth annual Civic Engagement Banquet.

Sponsored by Illinois Wesleyan University's <u>Student Senate</u> in collaboration with the <u>Action Research Center</u> (ARC), the annual event celebrates those who have made significant contributions to community service.
