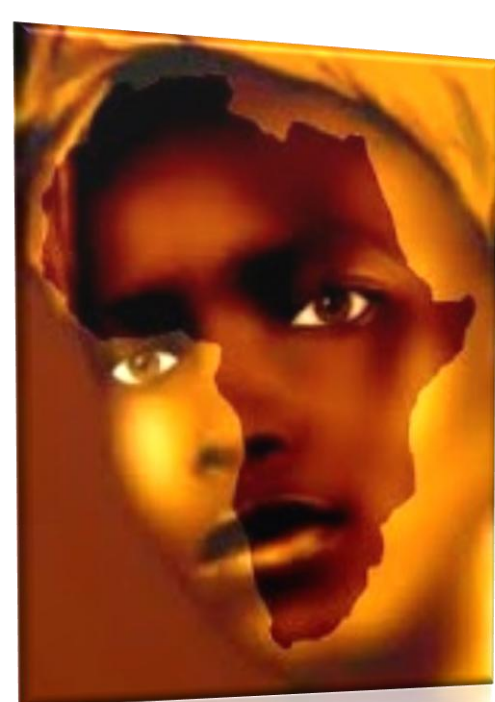
THE PICTURE PAINTED OF AFRICA

 - Extreme poverty

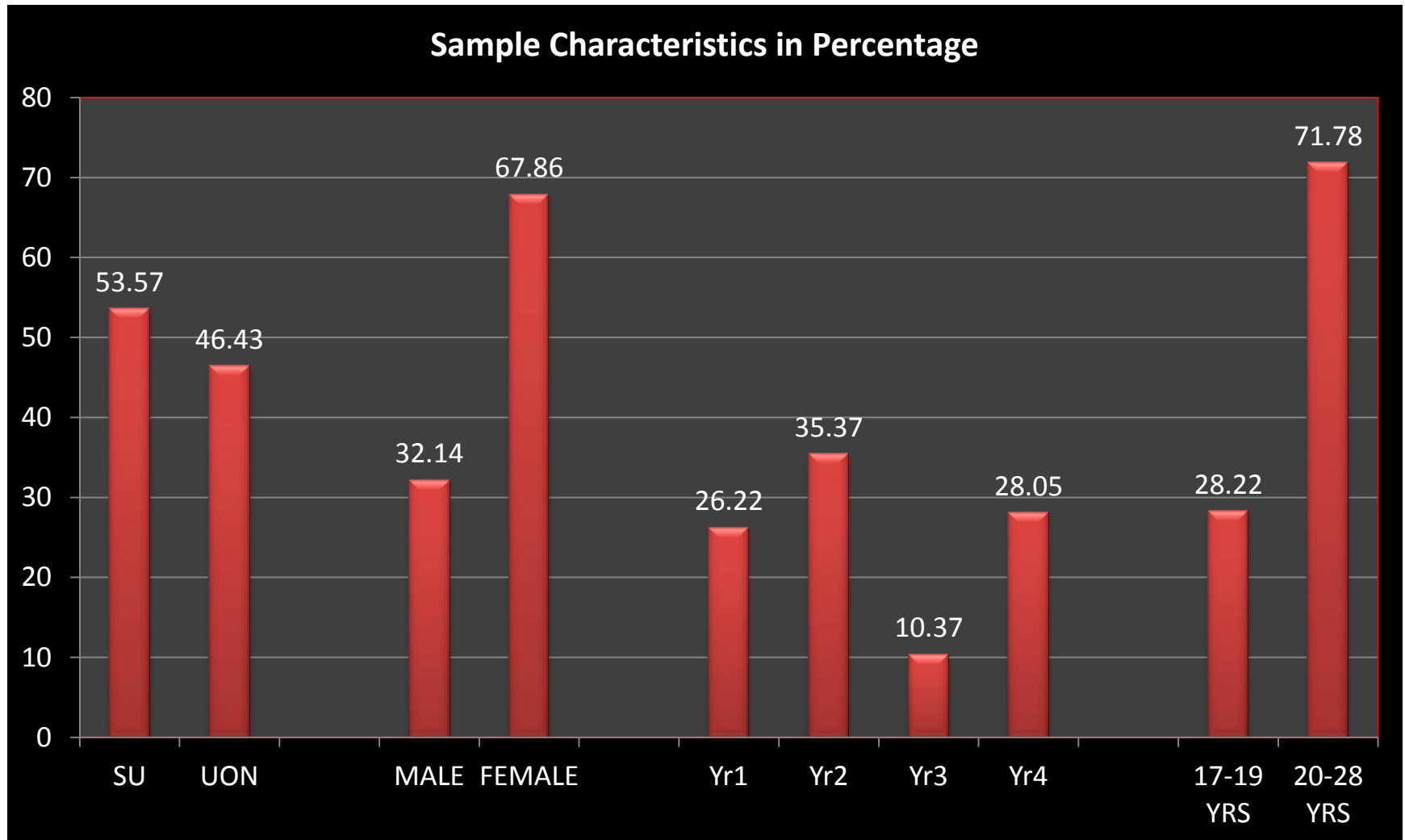
Other factors:

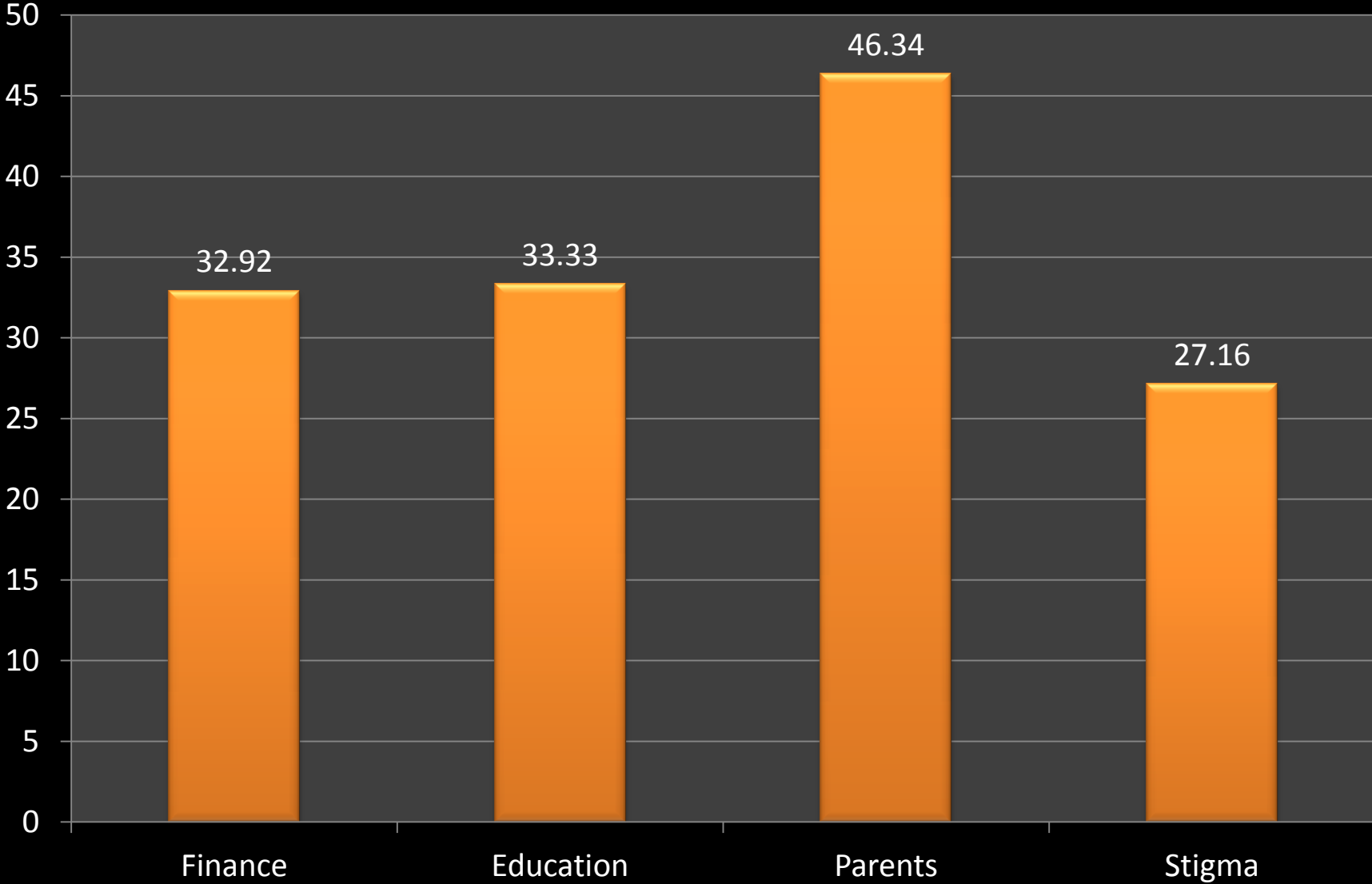
