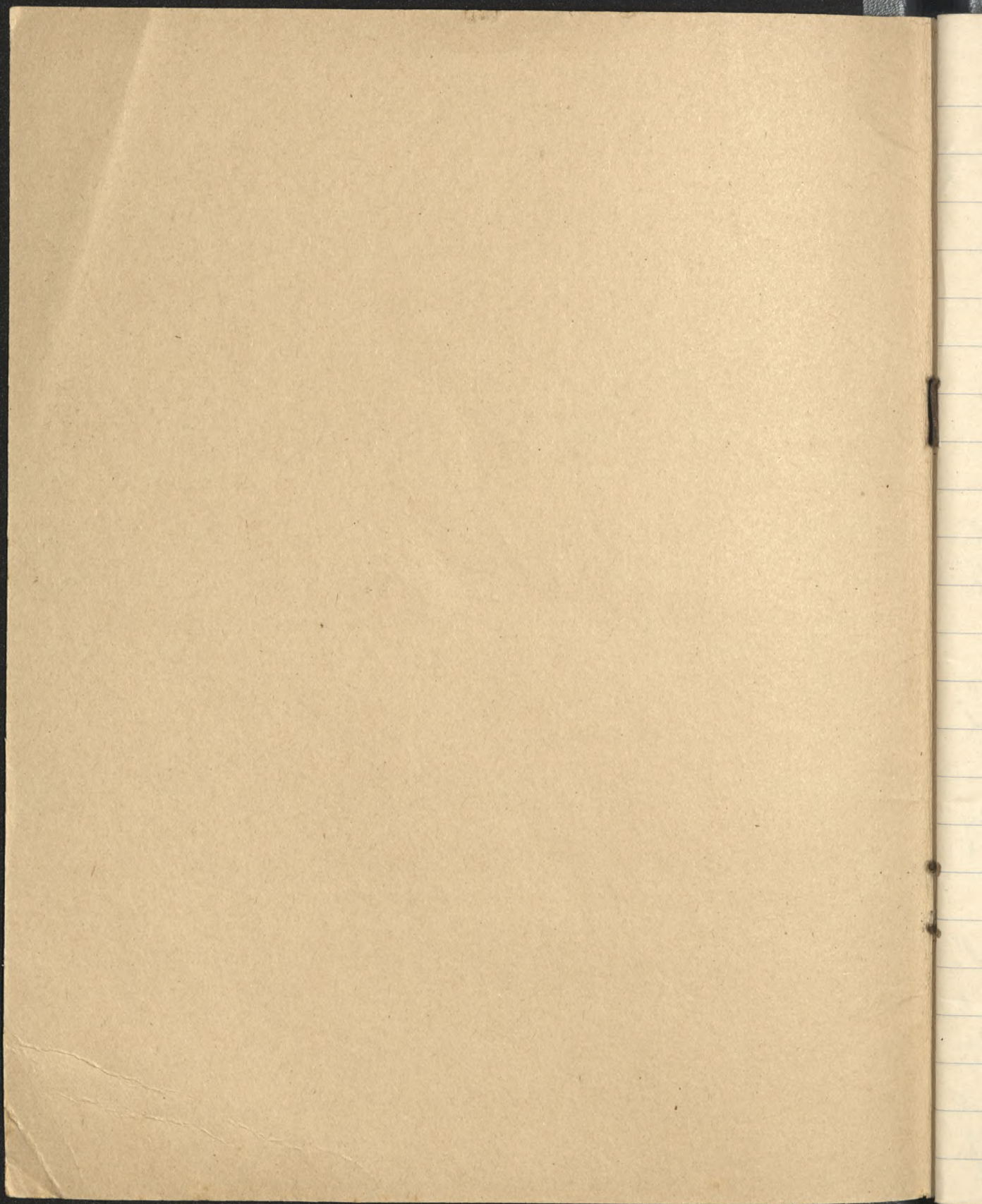

Begin Feb 8<sup>th</sup> 1964

8.2.64 Saturday Day off. Breakfast in bed after a sleep in pain. Spent the day writing letters, mostly re trip. Dorothy went to Pop, peeved because things didn't go as planned. When away all day re boat re Michael clearing the land P.M. Veronica T 10.3.1 saw her before dinner. Wrote to Turf re absences after dinner. David had a party. + D came on St George's rang up. Altered the sailing of St G. MK. Maryjane & Jimmy upset & went to bed for dinner.

9.2.64 Sunday. Was dreary & raining thin. Asked Ricky to lend us a medical. Home got David off on boat & job for MK for before. Wrote a day at my desk. At 6 Ricky rang to say MK, going only to Tarak, Logans, & had 76 people on board. Sent David down to bring back job for kid. Thank heaven we have been tonight in my room, writing to Elvira & sewing, listening to My Word - a real refreshment. Numerous phone calls re new world. by medicals from the Wamba.

10.2.64 Monday. Was driving today but asked G.D. help. Newton missed plans. Had to be spoken to. Nicholas was in a mood & had to be spoken to P.M. Inspection late but finished 10.20. Got X-ray order's new list done. Have started clearing chest of drawers for

John. packing away my unwanted things. John & his mother arrived, & saw them tonight. Bless up John was for having job in his house. Got her at 8.30. finished Chris's letter. Master ?? coming on Beer.

11.2.64 An easier day still is hot. Inspection St. Mary's wet & did not do the plaster. Warden washed & got the things dry. I did letters, saw people. P.M. had some time to write letters. Very good to have some leisure. Dorothy ran a meditation group after breakfast. I went but not my kind of country. Russell hanging about.

12.2.64 Ash Wednesday. My bike & we went in on a crowded tractor - quite a no of medicals, Bob's luggage & motor-scooter. D is late, but church late. Renequin much better. G.K. helped so the service was shorter than I thought. Out 10 to 9. Beby fell & sprained her ankle yesterday in the wet gutter. Kate & I feet, got a ray done not making but check-ups. Dr. Kingston brought films & went to S.M.H. & back here to lunch. Jimmy also to lunch. P.M. odd jobs. Farewell to Annie. Write to Warden.

13.2.64 Thursday. Mass on time. G. interpreted his own sermon. Saw John & a school leaving blessing. Half way through to fast & the plane came. Annie shot off & farewells. Laura Lewis came in new job. Missing mail

still missing. Muddled morning & little done, waiting for George who didn't come. M.K. due 4, got on discharged job off again at 3. At 5 Evans rang to say M.K. not sailing yet today (Friday) so they all came back again, arriving at 6: new job, 2 very sick. Perry got a bit & fract. neck, 52 old, she & Betty came out for jeep, while Ken took care people to Evans after dinner pers. & raying & cuffs. pd 4 to 10, read mail etc. 3 new Wamnia nurses. Laura teaching the room. Very adaptable & charming.

Friday 14.2.64 Muddled day & susp., did mail Newton maintained new job & staff. Rode in to Mission at 10 & talked to + D. In Samarai. Haste still stranded there. Came on to pass & rain but Ken turned up, drove in here. Dick went to Pop for spare part. Fixing Med. C<sup>et</sup> machine & him. Saw some new job. Very job - 1 - pieces. Got job off to M.K. yet again, then Dick came, got lunch 1.30. G.K. & Ladies all 3 & arrived 20 to 5. Meanwhile D. & I fixed new nurses' uniforms, neither sister thinks of doing it! Things badly neglected. A kidney sick sitting in a ward chef for 7 1/2. Since I took out tubercula & talk! No one to give machines in W.I. + no one woke up to it

15/9 did at 1 AM. G.K. Leila had a cuff at 5, & stayed to  
dinner. I got in a bath & ray. phone, examined Frank  
Murray, all Hepatops. Got all in a rush too, poor kid.  
Got returned at 7:30, took G.K. & L. home, little Rosemary  
is sweet. They think village people wd. approve of  
Hospital on Chiraman's ridge! They went, saw new mine,  
some X-R's, saw Frank M. who is feeding something.  
Too tired for more.

Saturday 15.2.64 Rainy morning running  
round. Electoral men (Chertham in charge) arrived  
after 10, wet. They came to the bridge, returned to Pop  
for heavier vehicle & crossed the Linn at the ford. I  
settled to letters after morning tea. Fred & I went to  
take delivery of the cylinder off the Elizabeth Helen. Miss  
Fah came out, had much talk. Bob here for lunch, called  
at 2:30 to a crocodile man wanting to park belonging  
here. I said he could bring them from the Bay on the  
tractor that took off Kenzie. Matthew S. Heavy rain  
through the day, men went off at 6 in a storm. Flying  
about & saw X-ray at night. Bed soon after 9, read  
an article by Baumel.

Sunday 16.2.64 Church began late but ended early  
Laura came, she is plucky. Carway came back in, &

to start tomorrow I got Newton packing extra sheep  
for Zoe. Dorothy, Laura went to Wainstoa & stayed for  
lunch. I washed out pinnaces, wrote letters. Tonight  
did a fall & replaced the brim on & hemmed up  
a dress, listened to a play, & My word. Got told  
me Herbert & H.P. rebelling agst. no pay - all  
Herbert, I imagine.

Monday 17.2.64 Teacher taught, but got  
had long wearying interviews with them. Did  
big inspection, & got through a good bit of desk  
work. Kept evening family free & wrote to D.H.  
Saw Edna glad to vanishing of pregnancy. Saw  
new medicals, & took on Conway at after tea  
M. offered to give the 6 new ones section course.  
I thought at first D. would refuse but found  
as she took it on & mutual compliments & concern.

Tuesday 18.2.64 Laura's birthday. We got a  
bundle of things together. M. doing P.T.S. & D. did  
inspection. And getting things in order for Perry  
& working up the book of instructions, etc. Bob went  
to Liria to meet Rod & took on mail. I hope it  
get posted. Bob is pretty browned off: Mission life  
esp. in Lent. Giff. Michael here for dinner, and



non-Lent on. Meditation after which I missed doing  
job. Wrote to Laura who is trying to bang on to John B.  
Little Ennis: a pneumonia at 10 P.M. Edith many abs.

Wednesday 19.2.64 Feel vaguely unwell. T99.  
? Cholera injection. M. is making very heavy weather of  
her PTS. Change after her years of experience. Not really  
which does not help. Did quite a lot of X-rays for  
old Bartholomew had to sit for his. Found out why people  
resent all the visitors in part. Think I'll have to ask D.O.  
to root them out. Found Russell still here, ordered him off  
a day. Gordon is the one causing trouble. Lots of interruptions  
with Dr. W. & sent films. Pop League comes tomorrow.

Jeremy back, says stack of cargo on wharf for Watkins

Thursday 20.2.64 Church as usual. Fully  
expected George, but the blighter didn't come. J.  
brought the jeep & took Laura in to Erro. Then Bob &  
Jeff hurried up at 4.10 & picked up mail. I tried  
sorted & generally cleared things up all the  
morning. M. like a volcano - I know what it is to  
be hot up, but I don't know how she lives in that  
state. Suppose she finds the whole show plus the  
heat hard to take. She thinks the Hospital primitive!  
What would she think of SMH! Russell went but not  
Gordon. John was still off. got him to the flat at 8.

- urinary infection. Bot arrived at 5.30, quite a big mail but not the missing bag. He brought back an outward bag! Ken & Douglas due for dinner. I suppose forgot. Read mail, saw films. J.M. Tried & heard Sabata Apassinata in bed. Sybil offering to lend me her camera. She is generous.

Friday 21.2.64 Quap. M. Agnesi D. Bot dismissed the adolescent school boys who have been a nuisance & leading the little ones. Betty beat up Gilbert!! I feeling tired & headachy? P.M.T. Answered & dealt with mail. John Stafford returned in a stew about teaching & doesn't want to do by his father. Back on treatment. Betty upset over losing him. Trying to decide about tomorrow at 6. M. came in nearly in tears. Decided she can't "take it" & will go home when Jill arrives. Not surprised as she has been grumpy about. Hard to get across that. She has'nt quite decided. Bot brought Laura back as <sup>miss</sup> travel. Old job in Prof. P. b. had Zetrachlorethylene. Kiss. Eric round the bend. Washed clothes. Fiddled & travel set bed time.

Saturday 22.2.64 Day off!!! M. called me at 4.15 to Gamota, unconscious, spasming. She died

at 8, as I was finishing my breakfast. Did a P.M. L.P. couldn't get in before, & found bloodstained c.s.f. Back after a long discussion over the body, finally tractor took it to the Griva. That weeked Herbert went in it. Settled to plans & letters, wrote home. Not much done P.M., did a spot of mending. At 2 to 6 called to Thias unconscious, he died at 6:10! ?? because of Tetrachloroethylene. M. is upset. Muddled evening. Newton: pain in humming.

Sunday 23.2.64 Heavy storm in the night & river up. Tractor & battery flat, had to push it & late to church, went in in drizzle. Bob paid it after church. Told that water was high in the cemetery, & they had to postpone the funeral till 4 P.M. Did a lot of mending up. New shoes for lunch. He got up his courage to tell Bob Bunting to keep out of his private affairs, & was elated. Very good for both. He took M. Dot & Laura to Burma P.M., I was tempted to go but decided not. Read Anglicans, wrote letters. Had the after. almost off. Betty. Betty to dinner, all is bright & relaxed - good for M. Betty talked Greece & Turkey is helpful. She gets to London early July. J.B. on 17<sup>th</sup>. Another storm after bed time.

Monday 24.2.64 Snow up. I went to Green, took  
mail. D. & I did 9 resp. just finished. George appeared.  
Stayed to lunch & cleared up a lot of problems. I found  
the new domestic gas. Take only one inhabitant, & water.  
Finally worked out a combination of 2 hoses to put in  
3 qts. Talked gutter, drains etc. I have to show plans  
for painting 2 houses. Hoop up. I went at 2:30. Odd jobs  
till 5, & got a couple of letters written & 2 more brought.  
Saw some pt. : check on Lana teaching the other two  
to me the soon. I have actually read a Journal!

Tuesday 25.2.64 Inspection, & got a lot of cover  
for some days. Death certificate etc. Left nearly  
till 3. Had my cholera injection before which my  
refrain it. Odd job PM & began to feel a bit  
lousy by dinner time. Dodged the meditation -  
came to bed, wrote letters & read Journals. Hunt  
reported missing after dinner. Staff & Embryo  
people out searching & brought him in just after  
10. Moaning & not speaking but conscious. It  
looked like a psychical thing had been sitting  
in the creek. The whole would gazing of course.  
Sedated him, gave him Nitroglycerin. Could not  
sleep after it. Sarah & Leila washed but it rained  
nearly all day.

Wednesday 26.2.64. Went to see Hunt before 6' past,  
lots of people hovering all day. He slept bet 2.30,  
then struggled a bit, but later was quite rational &  
refused sedatives at night, I couldn't see malaria in  
his film. There is a story of a bad dream the night  
before. Apart from that, a lousy day - no X-ray.  
Saw pt & got writing done. All Hosp. work till dinner.  
Ken came, took Georg's notebook. W. spent the day  
sending a radio to him. At night muddled, late  
to writing, got some letters done & to bed after 10. Took  
pictures, sent the film. Edith Mary still: bad  
stools, thought about SMH but they have none.

Thursday. Up at 6. Mass on time, Michael for  
6' past, he Laura & an SMH nurse went on the plane.  
Small mail. Everyone seeking it, making it difficult.  
Saw E.M. admitted for difficult feeder, 5 P.M. put down  
a tube. M. & D. ant. tube, pulled it out, undid her  
splint. After Compline: a prayer for help told them  
they must co-operate or take the child elsewhere, & they  
gave in. M. & I tube-feeding her, & Michael tonight.  
Henry came out: a bad ear, quiet, worried, but cheered  
up a bit. I hope the sinus fixes it. Letter from Vane  
is unhappy, surprised, inclined not to come back. 26.9

is disappointed esp. Lot, as she has to face the next few months alone. Jean wrote of her troubles etc. I think she may be pregnant, I hope she is, bless her. Ted is putting the house in an agent's hands. I feel better, thank God. Very hot here.

Friday Feb. 25<sup>th</sup> Worried about Edith Mary, didn't sleep well. Woke at 4:30, got up to give the kid some fluid. Tired all day. The kid looks better but stool still awful. Nearly feeds quite a bit. Catherine's check due I resp., wrote some letters etc., fed the babe at 5:06. Wrote to Mance before 6:00, finished after 6:00. Went to bed at 9:00, read a Journal.

Saturday Feb. 29<sup>th</sup> On duty: Dorothy. I saw pt. while she saw to E.M., I got over to the house, did job. Found the - filing letters etc. Fed E.M. at psycholog- ical moment. D. woke me to report P.M. temp. asked me to do the 3 o'r. I wasn't in grace or she hadn't planned it in the A.G. Had P.M. one, decided the child was improving Andrew & Ann to dinner. They arrived just after Jimmy & Betty returned from Nap - the Cooks gave them a shower tea, meant Betty to pass on the invitation to us & she didn't know, & we scarcely knew it was on! I was relieved!

Anyway we got our mail out. Also we got word the  
Kabili had left pt. 3 Portagas cylinders, so David went  
down at 6.30. At 8 Namboor coming on L side only  
took a long time to settle. The pt arrived at 1/2 to 6, 9,  
old Lami. I then got them fixed. H quiet by 9.30.  
D. not so pleased at the usual ruddle. Late than  
off duty. M's eye painful in A.M. getting worse,  
I ran round after her. Think it must be like  
Penny's. She had dinner in bed. She will push it  
Sunday March 1st. A muddly day. Up at 6.5 it was  
clear that M's eye would keep her at home, so we ran  
round the Neep Hill 10, fixed M's eye, treatment, saw E.M.  
Frank made milk, endured 2 hypnoses at Mathew's. Lunch  
in at 10. got on re-broadcast of the Conservator, recalled  
+ D's sermon was splendid - ought to be printed. Truly to  
bear + P in action again. 'John's' on the 3 other lectures  
I cleared: children's drawers + tried to work out  
B.M.A. plans. May H went on Lairs fund for her holidays.  
Wrote home + brought to Elsie. Little else. Fed E.M. at 4  
+ hopped to + fro for this + that, inc. M's eye, which looks  
like Penny's. Put her on Prednisolone tonight. Got word to  
Mama, persuasive too. Penny rang up Health about the gash  
in Managala, got Seragg who sent a plane at 2 P.M. Penny  
Donald. Edith gave gift Dorothy giving in merrily to

have fill in her room so I am going on preparing  
mine. Milt developing in our family w. s. p.  
and I haven't been particularly co-operative. Dorthy  
Monday March 2<sup>d</sup>. Quite a day, but not as busy  
as I expected. Called at 4:30 to Loretta with an X-ray  
of hips. Could not sleep again. Things all out of gear  
in edg at b'fast, Watkins late, staff later. Haven't  
heard Milt yet. I suspected 2 wards. George didn't  
come or saw some new patient. Had a long talk  
Stephenson over Dorthy's rebuking him. Robert  
came & the truck broke and bridge over the drain.  
A radio for Mr. who had the day off: of her eyes.  
Both parents in Hosp. after a car accident but not  
much hurt. I had to break the news. He decided to  
go straight home & goes tomorrow if a vehicle comes  
her eye much better on Prednisolone John moved in  
after 4. I kept busy, finished before 9 & writing in  
bed. Edith Mr. has gained 1 lb.

Tuesday March 3<sup>d</sup>. A somewhat, weary day.  
Dot went to church, is fixed up & feathered. Both teeth  
though the tooth looks perfect. B'fast late, everything late.  
Mr. said good-bye & took photos. I suspected w. l. George came  
& election who got things going so that Jerry could go



ahead. They went at 12:10 with Maryam I think she wd.  
have settled down here, been happy. but she is tense.  
On feet stronger all the time because she is. At 1:30 the jeep  
came: Gill, more sophisticated than I expected but attractive,  
in a way of begging (M had a max). I had tried Ni-  
rovan but she! P swept, dusted, washed shelves while Phil  
Bill, Gill had lunch. That food up, Mr. Sebris brought  
Bender's Co. Phil brought the fungus & larvae both LUZ, RUZ.  
Got list of specimens, sample of Tetraaclothylen for  
Johnston, & Sebris stayed talking through E's song. Then he  
& John, talked abt ph's finishing his picnic. Newton set  
up the bar & forgot about Medatabin wh. he was to lead. I  
upset. I saw S.P. paper dining, M. x ranged check-ups. After  
Compline I. I got new sheets & soaked them, etc. etc. Fr.  
Leoffey arrived back today.

Wednesday March 4<sup>th</sup>. Feeling lousy after a broken night  
& 3<sup>rd</sup> Cholera injection. Called at H.N. Newton in a fugue,  
not violent praise to. Tramped over to his house. Couldn't get  
to sleep but I took them back to rest on duty. 1 P. I did x rays.  
I saw ph beforehand. Stupid & slow at thinking. Did cards,  
saw people long talk & Kiliar. Clarence & I for to Wrenby, got  
no further. Off my out. Weekend at 2:15. Mr. Borley here, Clerk  
to the Governor of St. Thauri's Hospital, a friend of P, who sent

him of these very abruptly, never on one subject more than 10 secs. Wish we had better of recommendation to the successor at Thomas'. Dr. David went - 13. Newton on July 1-30-3 but did little, that little badly. Wrote after war talk: Lilius got a mental blotch, phone scheds, letters & had dinner. Skipped E's song, looked at Terquis' x-r. Spunking, both + ve, poor lad. Wrote to F. Geoffrey. Bob, Michael, Don & Andrews all out here "have got" but poor old Dot is kept from her letters. Sent a radio to Ok today.

Thursday Mar 5<sup>th</sup> Quite a day. Felt better but dull, weary, no appetite. Dot worn out, her toothache dreadful. I think she has an infection of the upper jaw - on Penicillin. Mass alright but S's car not come. Betty rang at 9 to say M.K. in - was done 1:30. Tractor went off. Dot ran round like a mad thing preparing Mackie's house. I tried to get scheds, saw ph. or. Told Terquis he had T.B. & he took it well. Gil hopping in to work, responsibility. Hoop up interrupted phone, tractor. M.K. went back to before empty for more people! - no no Mackie yet. New ph. came in drink & did a lot from Dogwood, funny cases & look like skeletons. Tractor brought a great load of Mackie's stuff after 7. Fin.

Dorcas here for dinner because did milk run. Bought  
our freezer, MMS tractor brought mail. Some good letters,  
Dol. J. expects to return in June. Max ft. tonight, admitting  
w. bill q. Still haven't seen x-rays. Newton O.K. & on duty

Friday March 6<sup>th</sup>. What a day! David took tractor to  
Bay soon after 6, & arrived at 8:30. The Masters all smile  
in spite of weariness. They spent the day unpacking &  
settling in, & we all took turns off to help advise at. The  
3 beds are full of life but seem to be getting good training  
just, seeing people &. Saw the Laguna ft., some in poor  
shape. Odd jobs all the after. & little to show. & at night  
kept on the run & writing letters to go today, & didn't  
even get to x-rays. Flopped into bed at 10 & read stuff  
Woke up 11:30

Saturday March 7<sup>th</sup>. Another would-be day off. Work  
rather early. Got some phototyping & bit of packing done  
mailed parcels. Wrote a few letters. Perry brought news  
that Norma was done at 1 & will call on Monday  
P.M. to take ft. back. Asked for I.P. & Newton working to  
x-ray tomorrow. ft. arrived at 3 - 14 of them. Admitted  
examined them. Senior lab. Went to track, washed head  
wrote 2 more letters, & the evening is gone. Bob<sup>M</sup> arrived  
6:15 to do piggy & shaming. Bob H. Pump piggy bear this  
AM but sick turned up to help. Wendell was stuck

+ Lee meeting. must talk to + D. Noa Dot still  
hard at it but her booth is less painful thank heaven  
fell on duty. managed well.

Sunday March 8<sup>th</sup>. Fighting fatigue all day. Very  
loopy through Mass. Bob drove in, one can see he is  
learning his way: the tractor, but he backle things  
systematically, intelligently a bit of a brains putting  
the frame on the tractor. After lb. saw several people. Vis  
K there, came back to us for 6 pack. lunch. Dot, D. G.  
went for a picnic, got off about 12. Vis John. 7 per  
lunch. Examined plane people, wrote to + D. & Egghid.  
Vis goes on leave in '52, may not return - needs lesson.  
left cell 3, no one got busy on x-ray till 4 to 4 but got  
them done by 4 to 5. Long. Pedions talk: Austin, full  
of self-pity, self justification. Had a few minutes to read  
before dinner. Talked to Bob for 7, he looked at plane  
till 9:30. Newton, 5' saw going slow being argumentative.

Monday March 9<sup>th</sup>. Work a day. Just got 2 lots of kids  
inspected & along came the D.C. & Colonel Engel P.W.D. Talked  
to them of Hoop set-up, introduced Bob H. They shall have  
George. Bob Clark arrived. Bob M. here for the day too  
constant calling away. Una stable with, worried. Saw  
some of the couldn't finish 9 resp. saw Patricia. Had her show

prob T.B. - a putum tonight confirmed in D.C. said was  
W. G. L. P. coming but Saturday, but not going, probably  
left Wednesday. George went 2.10. I did get a bit of sleep.  
5 absconders returned. Just coping: then, Edna, F. Goffey  
, F. Clement came to see Serpin - I got F.C. x rays. Talked  
about Serpin's future, checking others. Lovely to see F.S.  
again. He has put on a stone. Got in a bath. saw E.S.'s own  
Miss Haste, Rosemary, Fred, & drainboer & R. flat out. Bob  
copying. Went back after dinner too. Then in garage. Tractor came  
7.20 - M. B. not in. Looked at x-Rs till 20 to 10. Then  
Douglas here for dinner, the 3 men in ship.

Tuesday March 10<sup>th</sup>. Not such a rush. Prof. M. Wang,  
saw various people, did some writing up. At night long talk  
with Louis, his son. No one came to talk about his marriage.  
I wrote M.K. mail. Missed Meditation wh. acc. to  
Dot was large dream. Haste still unscathed.

Wednesday March 11<sup>th</sup> x-raying done on knee but Ray  
Cook came at 10.30 & Eraser of Repas at 11. Interviewing P.  
, guardians etc. Arranged for Bartholomew to go home on  
M.K. poor old man. P.M. slept till 3, hard to drag myself  
awake. Found kittens in darkroom, despatched them:  
ether. Raney on pipes all day. Saw film after U. song. Talked  
to John Man about adopting a boy. G. Perry here for lunch.  
wrote talk about M.K. etc.

Thursday Mar 12<sup>th</sup> Bob's birthday and O yay!  
Name returns at the end of next week! Was kinda  
bored but the flush of joy put new heart into me  
Dot was a different person. Med. very pleased.  
Mass was early. Got luggage labelled for Marjorie  
Name as mine, new pt. another CHN girl: I want sh,  
Wrighty can't come till April. Dot read M's letter. I  
may see people for boat, writing mail, etc. Got  
some off on tractor. They went down. Fr. came 2:20.  
Lans not on board. No room on M.K. for pt except  
Barth. his return. No news of Marna. Lots of  
disappointed passengers. Dot having to cook was  
food. Muddled after. Tried to visit to Marnie.  
At dinner too tired to talk. Wynne here. Tried to  
get to bed, but jeep came. Betty. Jeff. took Barth.  
Most of people standing round jeep & he too early  
I got to bed, beyond seasoned thinking. Up to  
think in a pain. A spot of reading has restored me.

Friday March 13<sup>th</sup>. Mother would have been 101  
today. A quieter steady day. I don't feel exhausted.  
Wrote to Binky before I fast. Ken. Bob left at 8:30. Ken  
brought back X-ray film. Inspected St. Agnes. did a  
lot of entering up. getting order out of the chaos. The Gonas

came for check-up - on M.K. yesterday. Got them examined  
+ X-rayd. called from hosp. of Legata was having  
another haemophysis - small one but he was apprehensive  
Tonight saw rest of X-ray. wrote to Ele. + Mance

Saturday March 14<sup>th</sup> On duty but had to rest in  
bed. Must have a sleep in. Worked all day on drug  
order - no few interruptions. Didn't finish till 10  
too tired to think. Bob + Jill went to Warriston for dinner,  
so D. + I alone for dinner.

Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> Glad of a day off. Went to Ch. dead slow  
in a drizzle, rain steady throughout church. got home wet  
through. Mannington celebrated, but his voice too quiet even

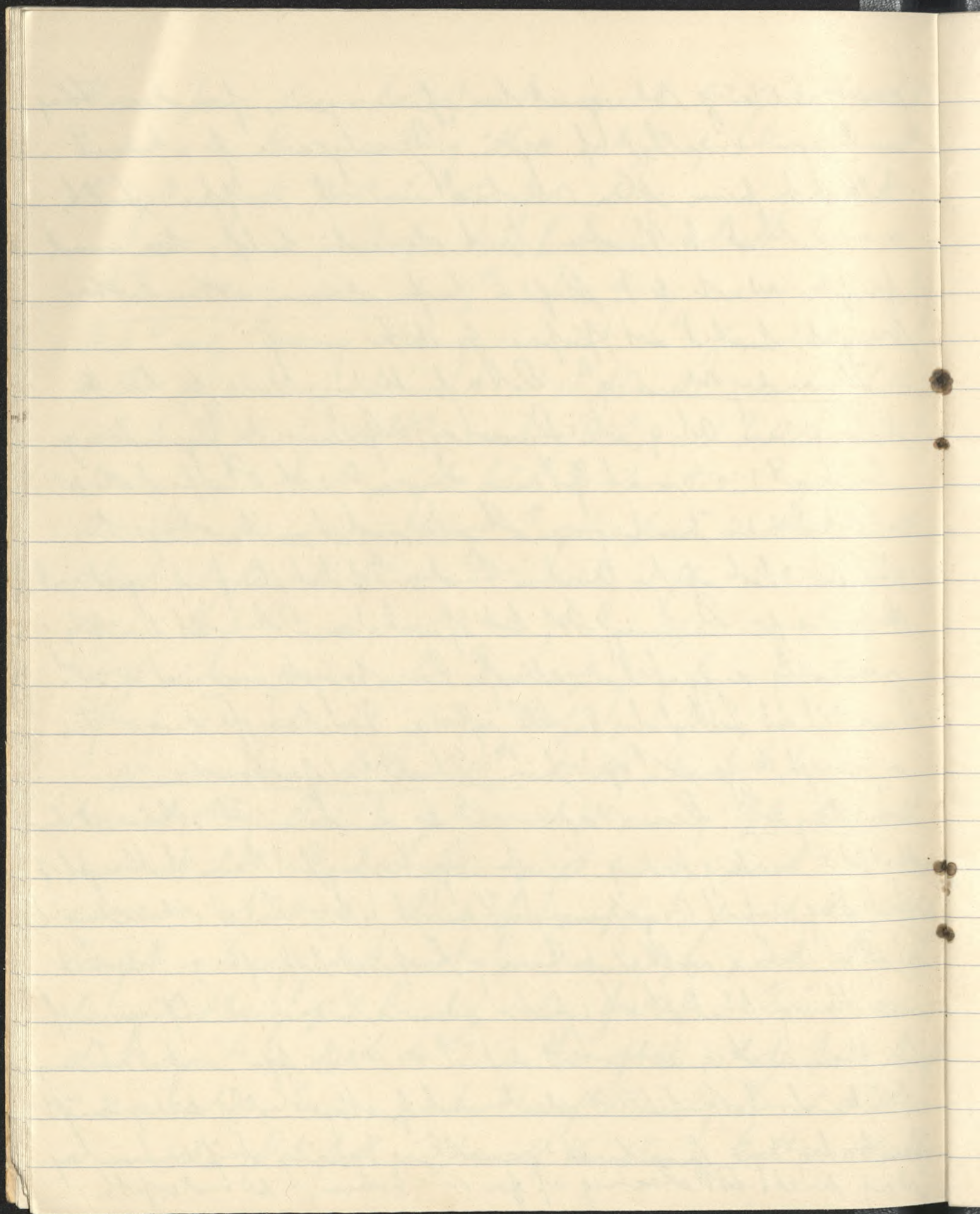

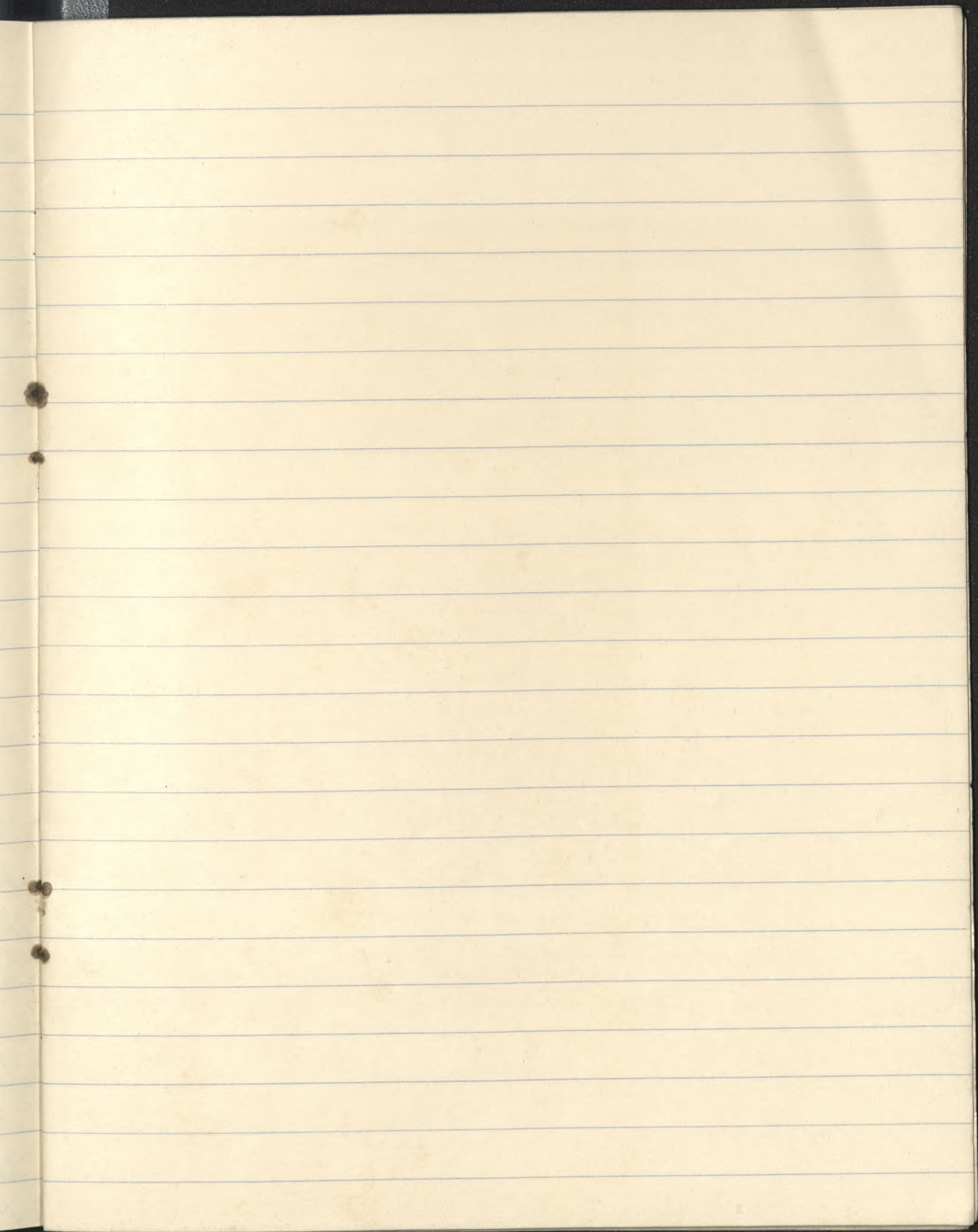

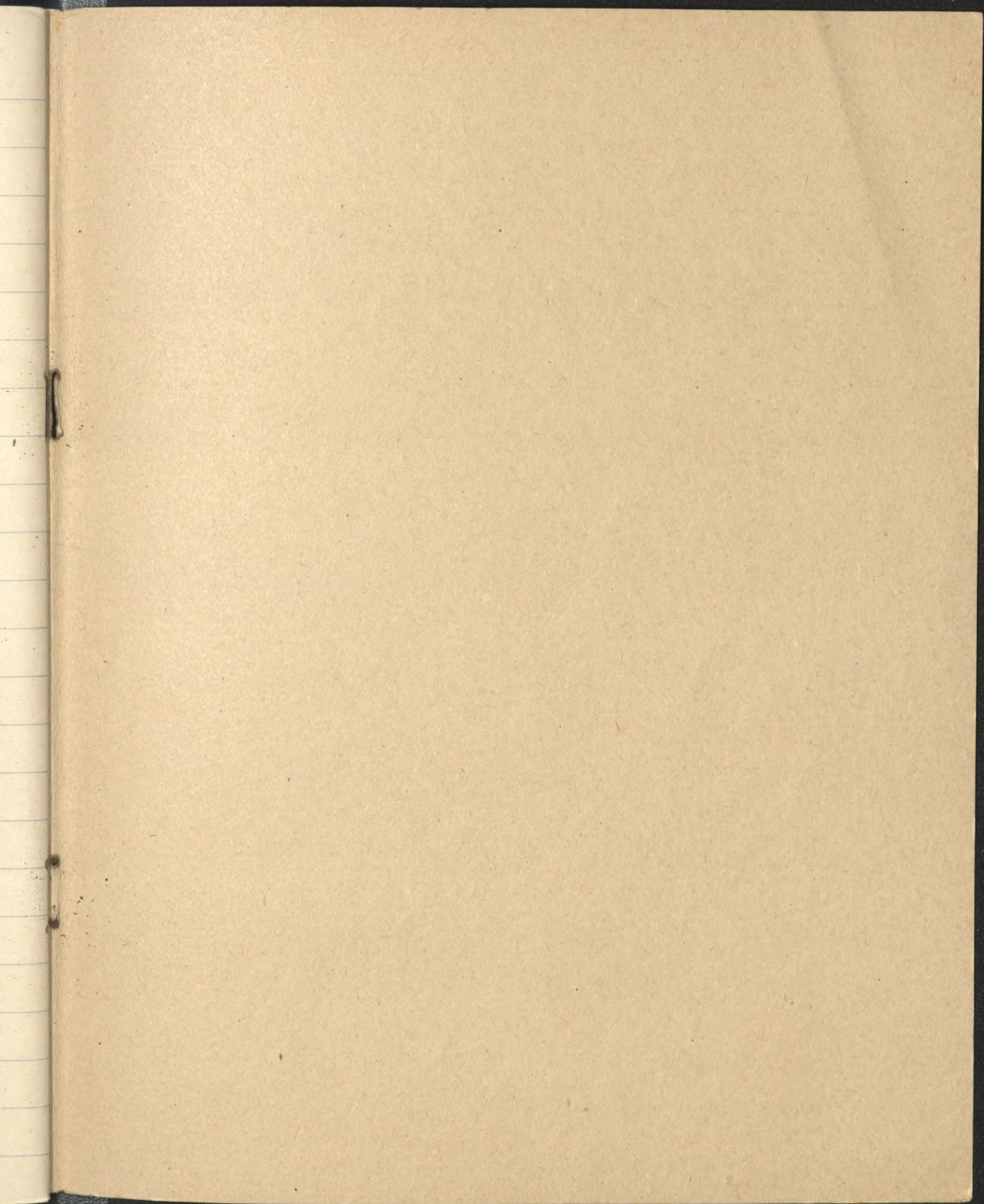
