

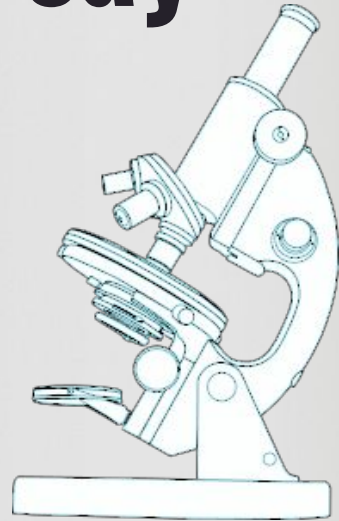

Why link to the VoR?

Using a DOI to link to the VoR on Taylor & Francis Online means that downloads, Altmetric data, and citations can be tracked and collated - data you can use to assess the impact of your work.

Share your VoR using your 50 free eprints link

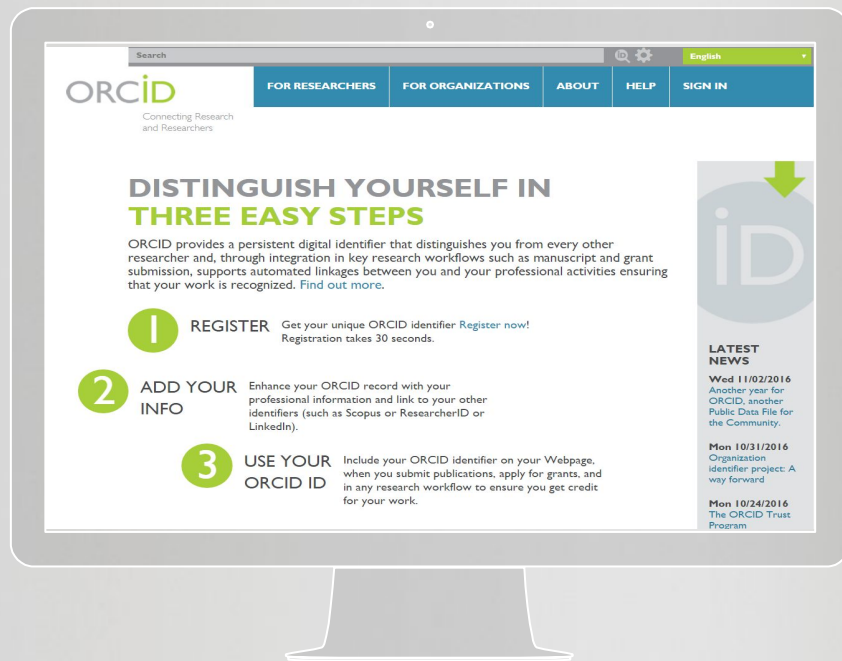

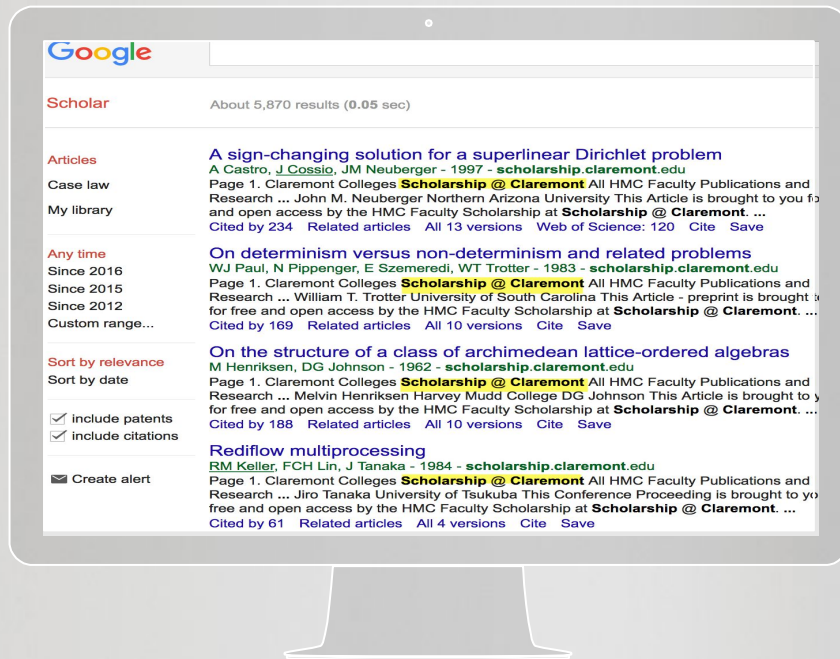
