- **primary resources** (this is a huge category that can include newspapers, scanned digital manuscripts, images, and many other formats)
- **video** (such as streaming films)

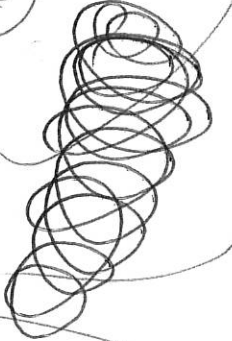

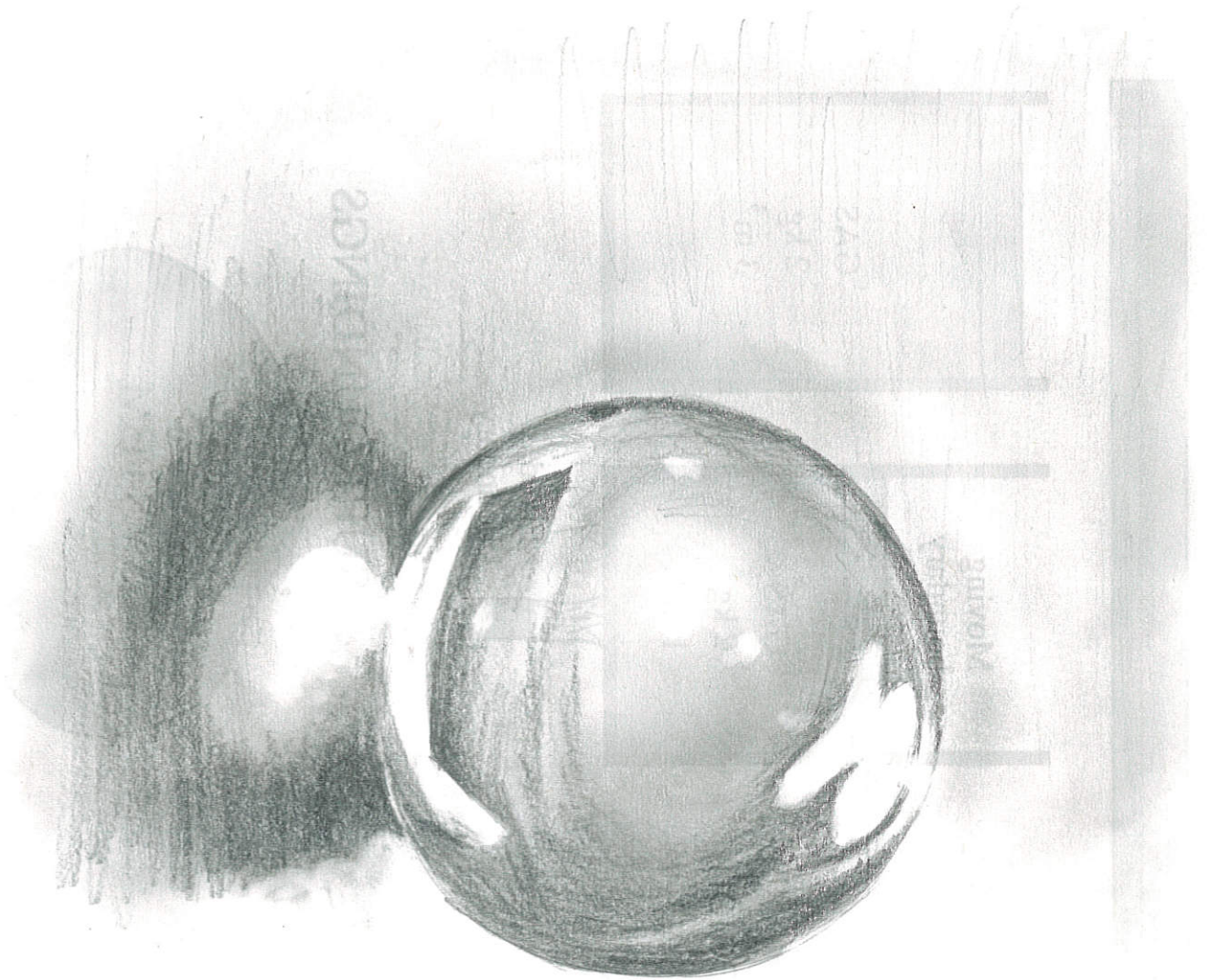

PRACTICAL GUIDE TO different kind of resources

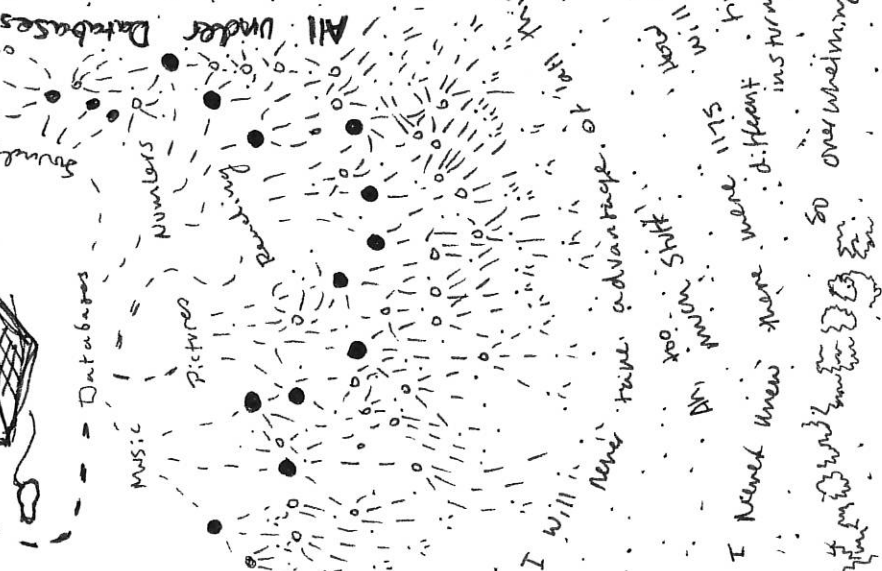
- Sounds → Music → Major Databases - Audio - Sounds!
