# Strategy vs. Tactics

• Strategy = a plan of action intended to achieve a specific goal

# Types of Questions:

#### Bibliographical:

- Requires a bit more questioning

- May involve searching locally or regionally

- May become another type of service in the process

- May require a little to a lot of interviewing
