**Presidential Libraries give the chance to see, hear, and participate in the events that changed our lives and made us who we are as a nation.**

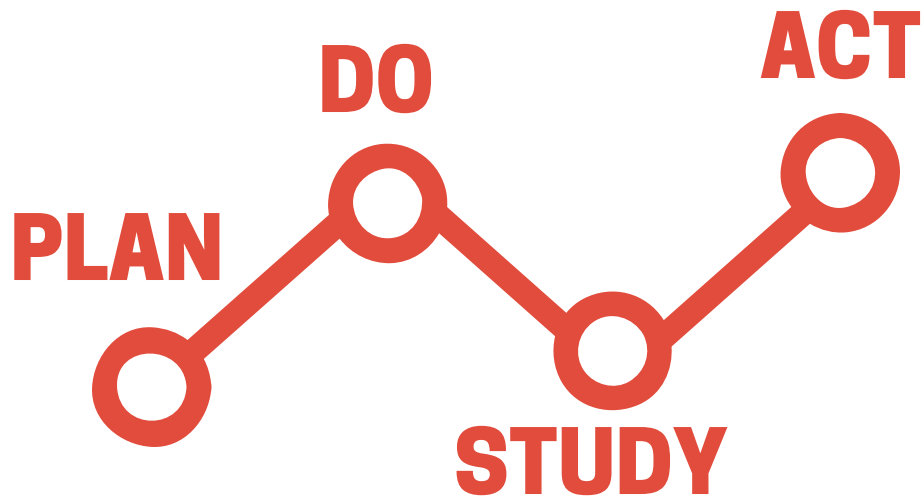




# CONCLUSIONS
