

Handle Eggs to Keep Quality When Laid and Prevent Breaking



Put all eggs in case little end down.




Market all eggs in 15 or 30 dozen cases using good cases, flats, and fillers,




Market eggs at least once each week.
Twice is more desirable.




Handle eggs carefully. Do not ship cracked eggs.



Be sure all flats are right side up.



Provide nests that hens do not enter from top.



Provide at least one nest for each 4 to 5 hens.
