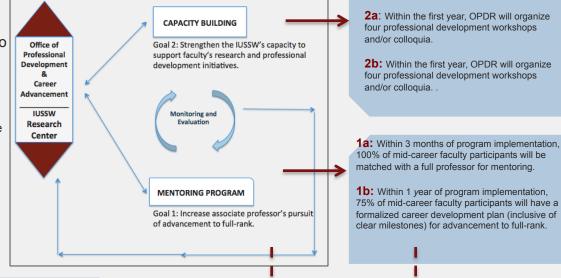

CENTRAL GOAL of the MENTORING INITIATIVE: To increase Associate Professor rank faculty's advancement to full-rank and strengthen the school's capacity to support faculty professional development and research.

- At its launch in September 2015, 7 Associate Professors and 7 full Professors volunteered to participate.
- One hundred percent (100%) of Associate Professors have been matched with a full Professor.
- Six of the Associate Professors (87%) have submitted a Career Advancement Plan.



SUSTAINABILITY / CHALLENGES:

- High program recognition among IUSSW community.
- Beginning with fall 2016, the mentoring program has been expanded to assistant professors with recognizing interest for non-tenured and adjunct faculty mentoring program.
- Challenges of engaging faculty from regional campuses.
- OPDA has yet to become operational as an office.

- √ 100% of program mentees matched;
- √ 87% of mentees submitted career development plans;
- ✓ IUSSW Research Center was enacted and is operational*
