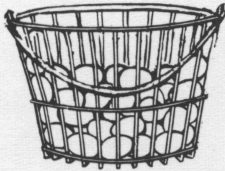
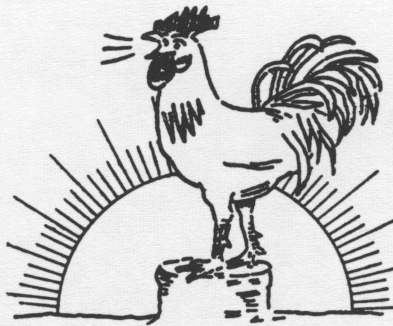


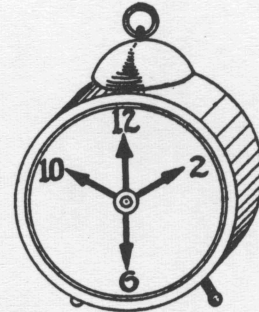
KEEP EGG QUALITY WHEN LAID BY DOING THESE THINGS



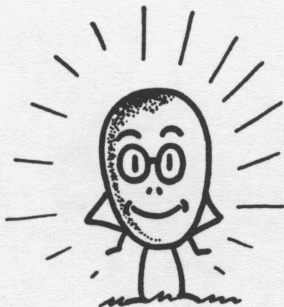
Wire baskets allow rapid cooling. Do not fill basket over two-thirds full. Keep eggs level in basket.



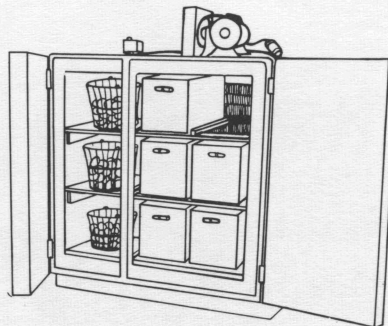
Cash eggs early in the morning after cooling to 55 degrees or below.



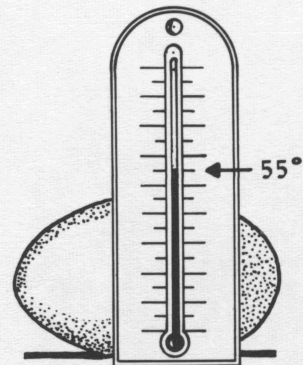
Gather eggs 3 to 5 times daily.



Keep eggs clean. If they become dirty or stained, clean them before cooling.



Mechanical homemade cooler affords opportunity for efficient and economical egg cooling.



Keep eggs cool—below 55° F. and above freezing.
