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### **Short Course T7: Lateral Rotordynamics of Petrochemical Equipment – Review, Examples, and Problems**



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This course is aimed at machinery and project engineers and technicians who need a basic understanding of critical speeds, response to unbalance, and stability of rotating machinery. The course is intended for the layman's approach to rotordynamics and its application to Turbomachinery.
