Incontinence of urine and feces is common in frail elderly. Incontinence has major impact on the well-being of older persons and their caregivers and is related with the possibilities of self-toileting.

This book studies the skills of frail elderly in toileting and the relationship of these skills with incontinence and morbidity. Also an intervention is described to enhance toileting skills in order to influence urinary incontinence in nursing home residents.
