THIS work, in 350 pages, contains a critical digest of all the publications on British Geology during the year 1890, arranged according to subjects, with a list of all the papers read and not published during the same time. It includes also a digest of the papers on Foreign Geology published in Great Britain. Also a list of Presidents, Professors, and Medallists, New Fellows of the Geological Society, Geologists deceased, and Degrees taken in Geology. It is thus intended to give a complete account of the progress of the science in this country, and, if found useful, it is hoped it may be continued from year to year.
