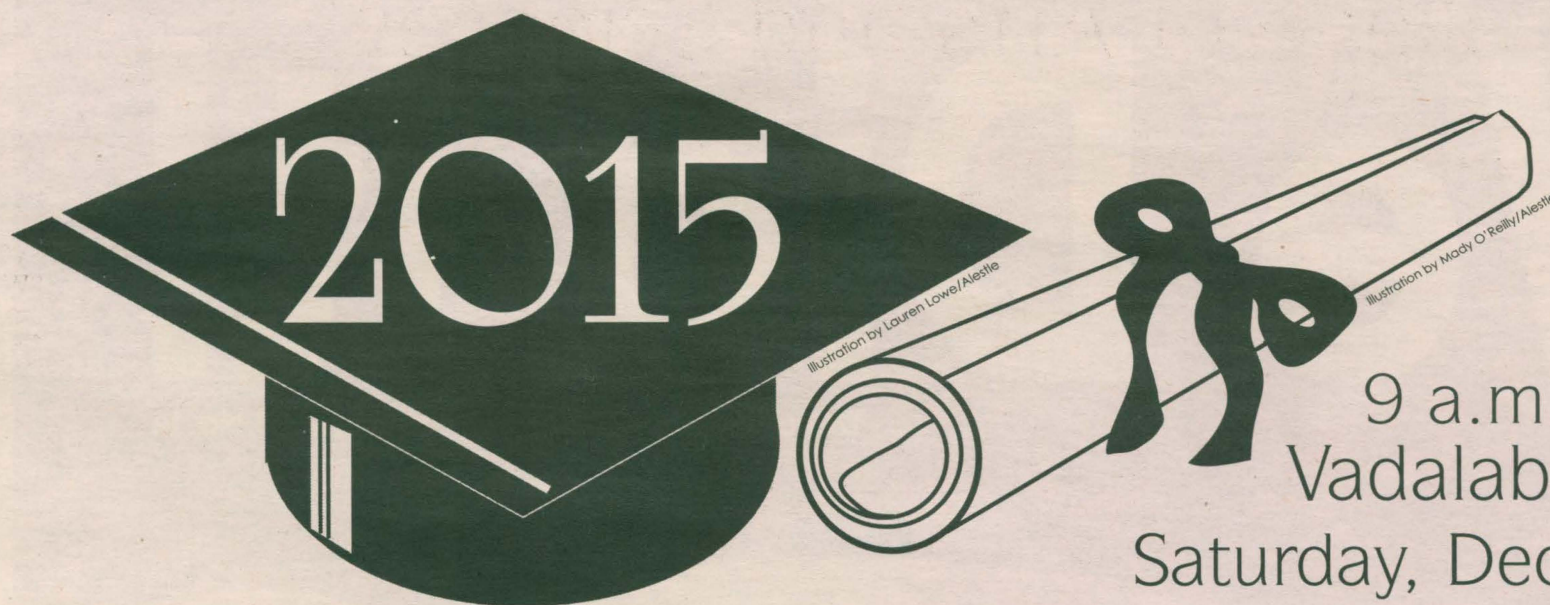

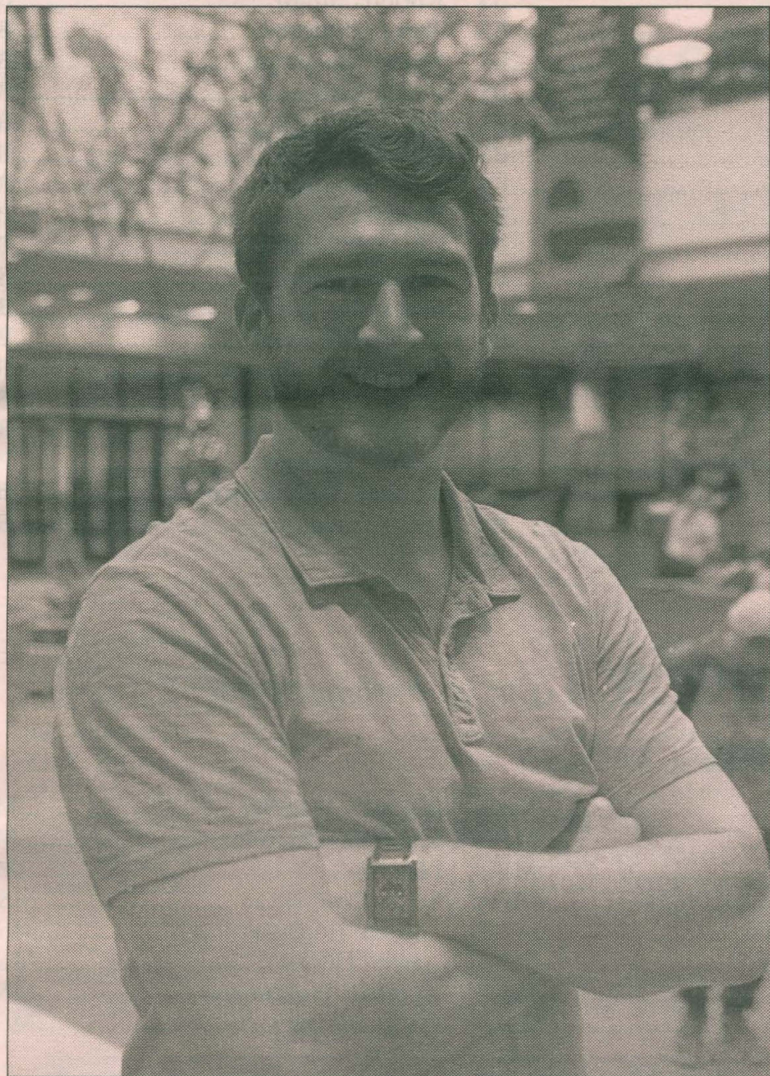

"She's going to have a great

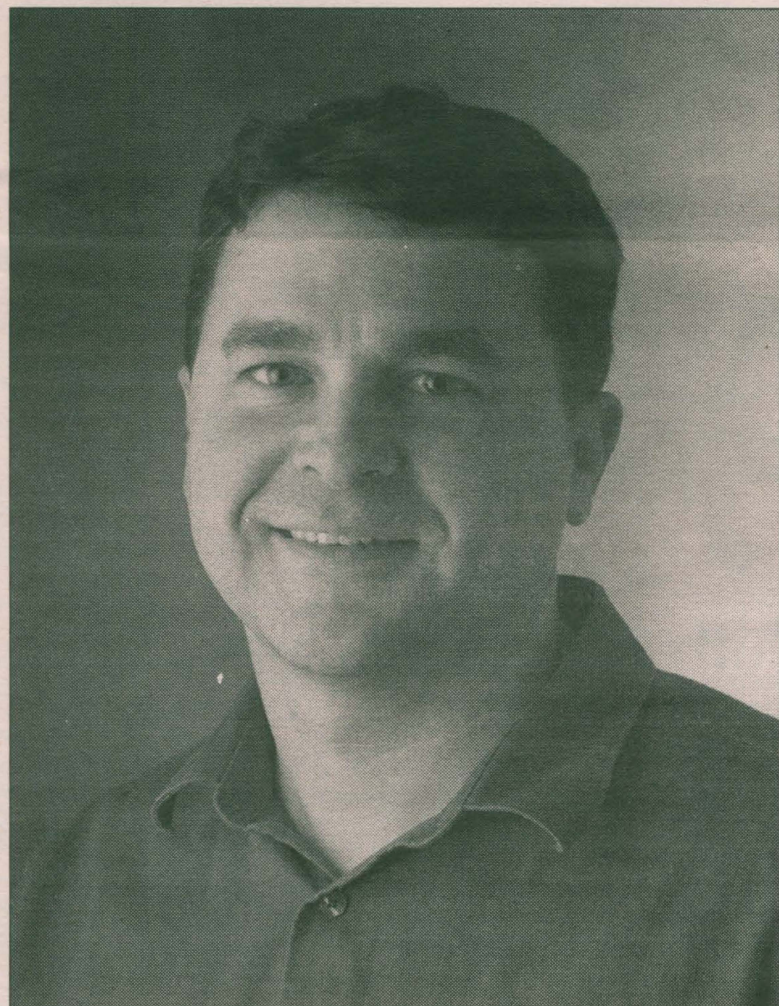
career within anything she decides to specialize in," Sierra said. "She is that person who is not only wants herself to be successful, but she wants to help other people be successful too."

SIUE psychology professor Stephen Hupp, of St. Louis, Mo., has received the SIUE Alumni Association's Great Teacher Award for the 2015-16 school year.

Hupp said he was pleased to receive news of the award.

"I'm super excited. It's a high honor. This might be the largest crowd I've ever spoken to. I guess it means that all the work my department does to support our teaching has paid off," Hupp said.

Hupp said he regularly participates in research with students. He defines the science of psychology as "using research to help

guide decisions about the world" and said that particular aspect of his job is what makes him happy.

"I feel like I do my best to contribute to the science of psychology. I think the science of psychology does a lot of great things for the world," Hupp said. "I have a lot of research that I do with colleagues, but I also do a lot of research with our graduate students and sometimes with our undergrad students. Working with students on research is a really valued part of our department."

Hupp began his university years as an architect major at the University of Kansas. Hupp said he changed his major after he re-

alized he liked his psychology classes better.

"I did my undergraduate psychology degree [at the University of Kansas], and I also went to graduate school at Louisiana State University. I started off as an architect major and felt like I could do more good for the world in psychology. I enjoyed my psychology classes more," Hupp said.

Hupp said he credits his Midwestern upbringing for cultivating his urge to improve society.

"I loved growing up in St. Louis. I particularly liked the Midwestern attitude towards community; neighbors looked out for each other and cared about one another," Hupp said.

Hupp said one of the things that stood out the most about this year's graduating class were the world events that they witnessed during their college years. From the Aurora, Colo. shooting in 2012 where a shooter opened fire inside a movie theatre, to the more recent Paris attacks where about 130 people were killed in a terrorist attack, graduates have witnessed the world in a state of outrage and confusion. Hupp said fear is going to be the main topic of his speech at commencement.

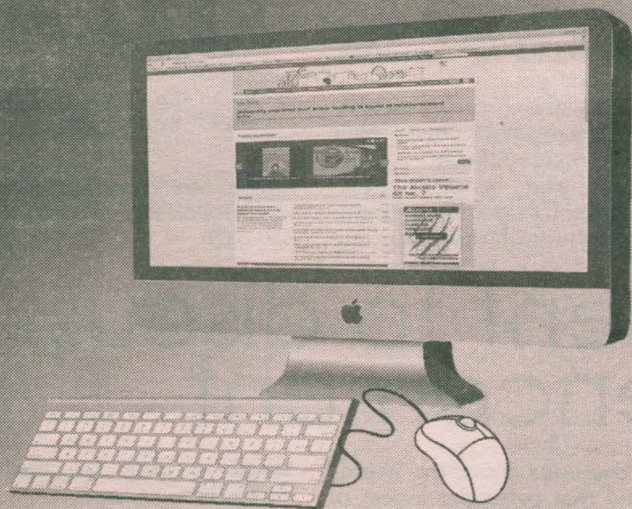

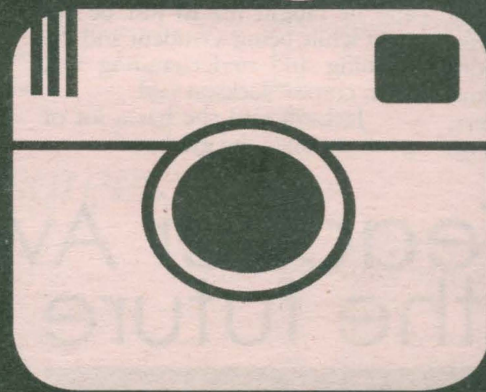

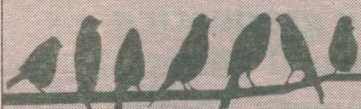
