Time was when we were 4—
4, and the world was totally alive.
Everything that was big enough or
warm, that moved or
made a noise was a person, a
separate, living thing, an
entity apart. A clock. A
refrigerator; electric mixer,
vacuum cleaner, radio. Puppy.
Even grownups. Each with a name, each
with its own awareness.
Earlier—there was an earlier
time, but we don't remember
that—there was only texture,
temperature, color, taste, noise,
scent; and we were
fascinated by the shape of our own
hands, the taste of cardboard.
But we don't remember that.
We forgot, when we were 4, in
the excitement of asking questions
of a world so entirely,
so immediately alive.
And the next year we were 5, and
started school. Formal education:
wherein we were expected to
answer questions.









And that's the way we spent the next twelve years: answering questions. Reading books, magazines, encyclopedia articles, newspapers so we could rattle off the responses.

—For tomorrow read chapter thirteen. There will be a quiz Friday.

—Book report. Just tell me what the author said.

—Mark + for true, O for false.

—Choose whichever answer you believe to be correct, a, b, c, or d.

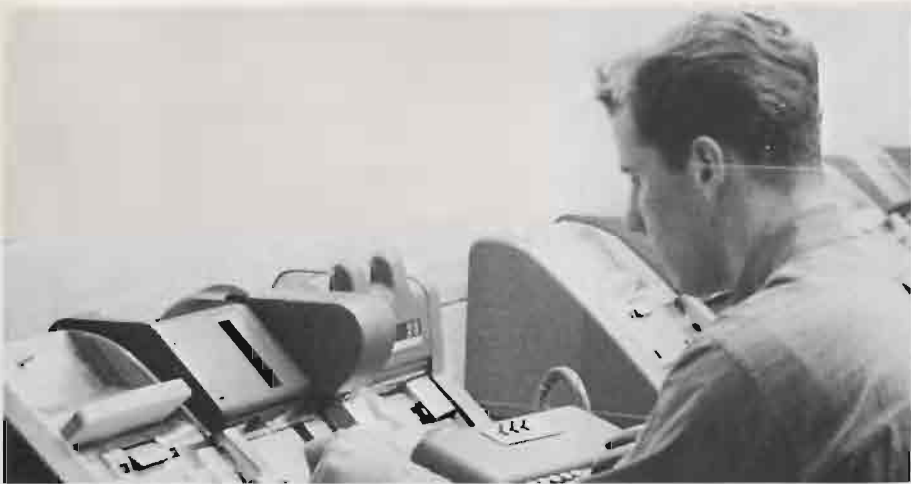
—Grade right minus wrong.

—Outside reading. You may choose three of the five listed.

By the time we get here, we've got lots of answers, and they give us another forty-odd books with still more.

We spend so much time with the answers, we could forget all about the questions.





And it is the questions, after all, that are important. What use are all these facts if we can't do anything with them? And what can we do with them if we don't even know which data we have, if there is no order to this collection? Eventually we come to making an ordering, for we must, and then we begin to ask questions. Especially, we question the value of all the facts we've been embalming in notebooks. All the data we've gathered, all the expert opinions and critical reviews, are someone else's; all the scientific observations are someone else's; and how do we know the reported results are really so? We have to try ourselves. So we come back to the senses: textures, color, sound. We do the titration; we measure the power curve of a thirty-horse motor, the growth rate of a crystal; and we know these things are so.

And slowly we come to some organization of the data, to some appreciation for the relationships different fields of knowledge bear to one another, to some awareness of the relevance of the contents of our personal mental filing cabinets to the way we act, the things we do. For we each see with our own eyes, we each perceive our own worlds; and the value of our observations increases with their relevance to those of other people. And we communicate. The teacher is doing more than reciting; personal relationships mean more than having a Coke together or being in the same classroom. The questions mean more: the same questions, but now there's time for our own answers.





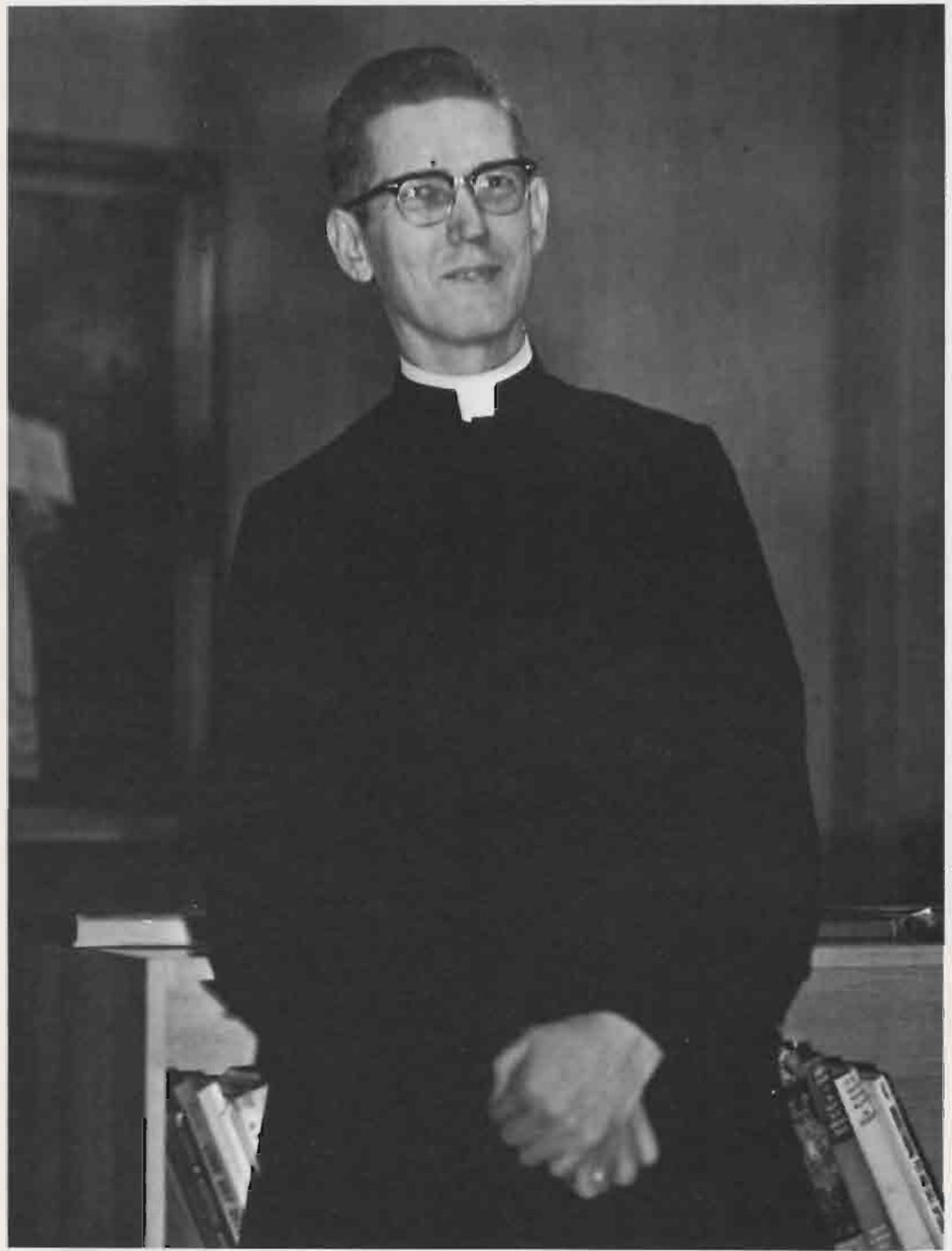


Academics


My dear Graduates of 1966,

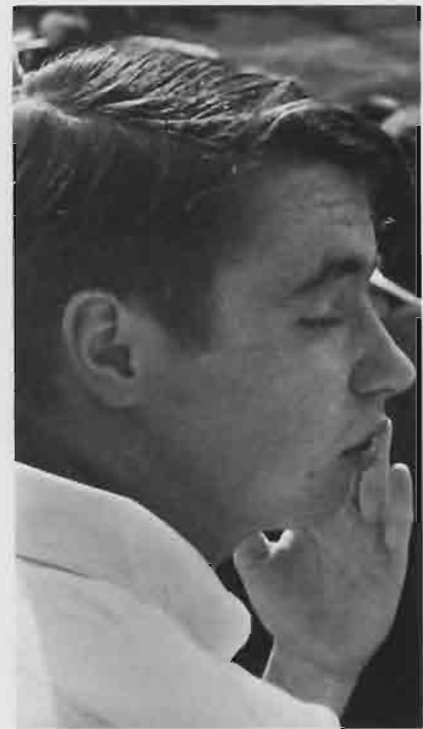
substantiated in the final count. Campus politicians began plotting how to alternately harness or squash this new bloc.

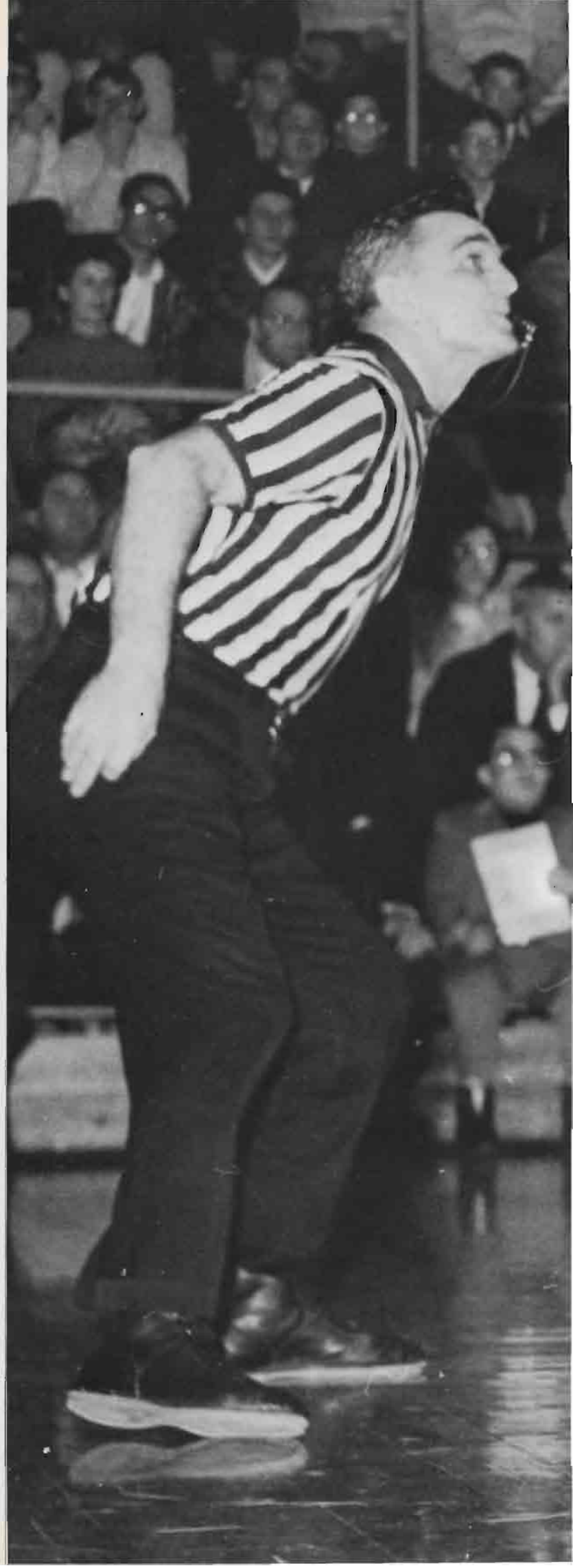
THE DAYTON CIVIC BALLET returned, bringing to the campus a local troupe which has gained wide recognition and admiration for its artistic interpretation of the dance.

THE ROMEROS created a new audience for the glories of the classic guitar.

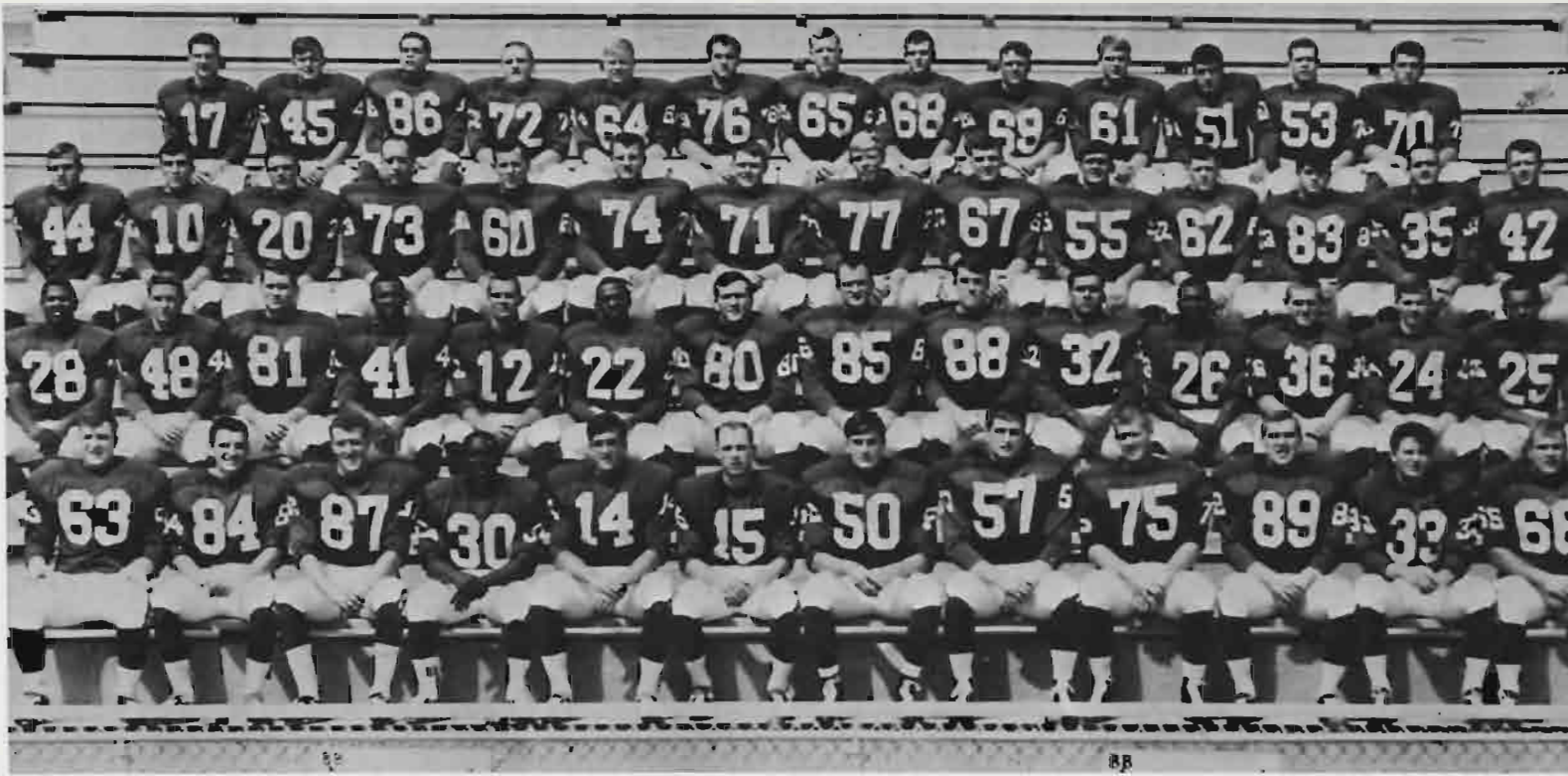
THE UNIVERSITY CONCERT BAND AND CHOIR offered their seventh annual tribute to the president of the University.

It was a remarkably frustrating season, for the fans, for the team, and especially for new coach John McVay and his staff.

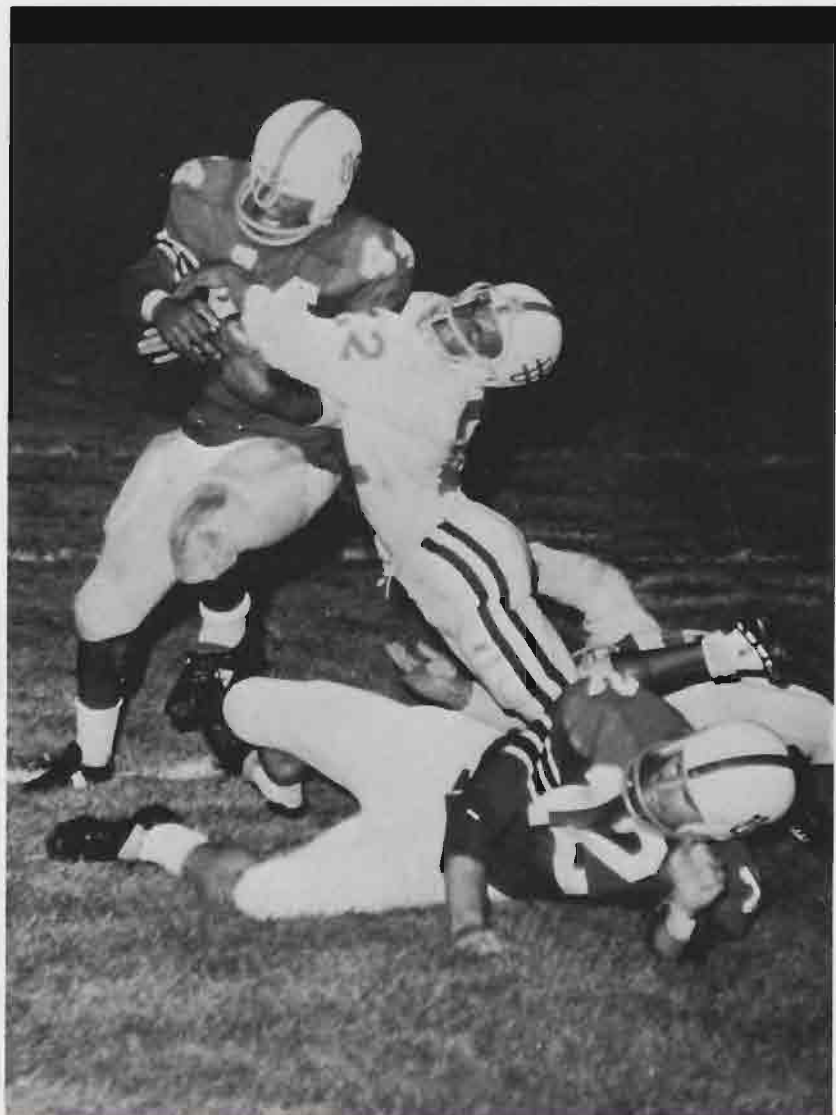
McVay came to UD from Michigan State, which last year was 2-8, to take the head spot at a school which had compiled a 3-7 record the year before. With 21 returning lettermen and the sophomores from a frosh team which had seen 4-1, McVay hoped to at least break even in his first year.

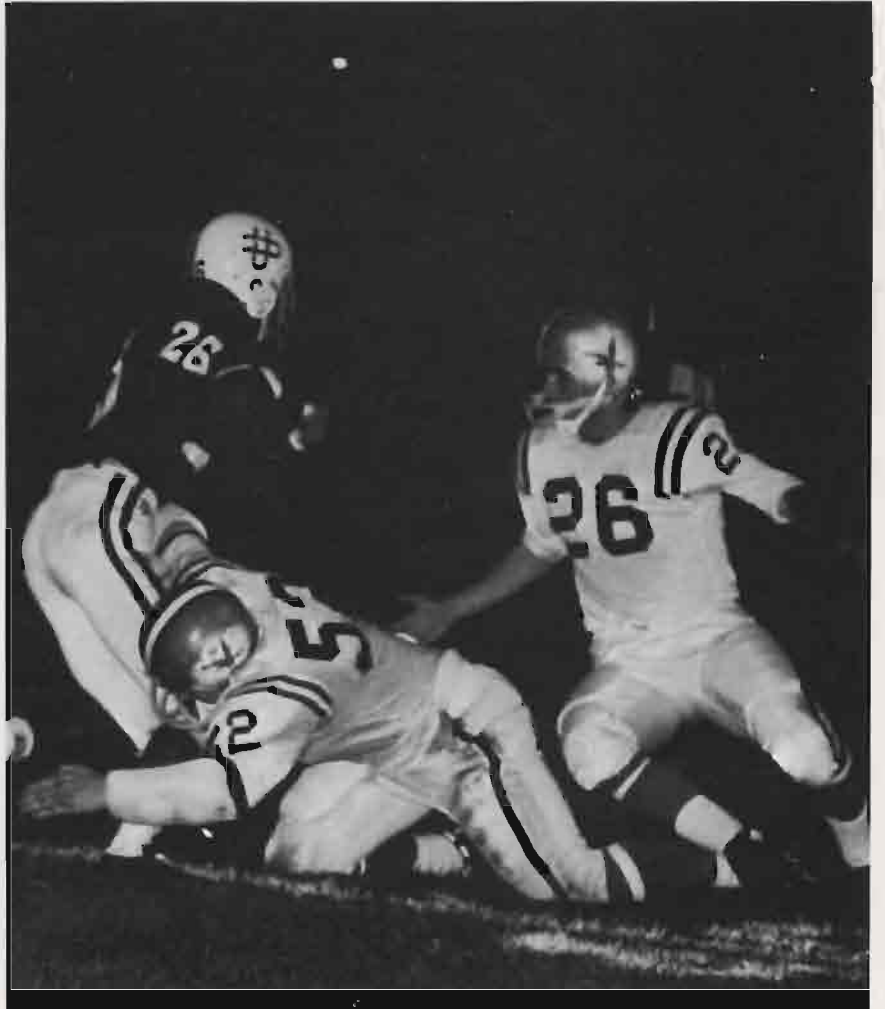
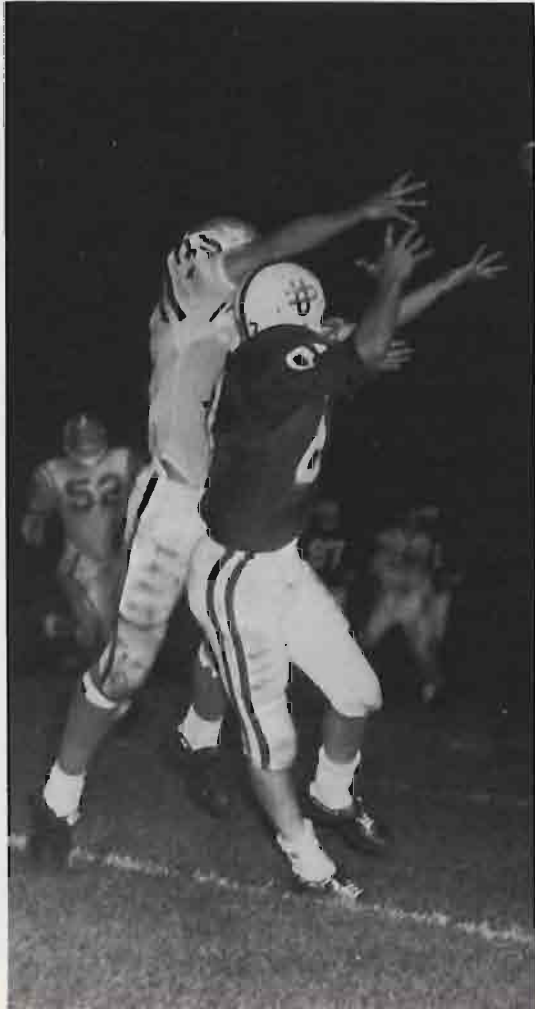




The Flyers journeyed to Cincinnati for the season's first game. The Bearcats, preseason favorite in the Missouri Valley Conference, managed only 7 points in the first half, primarily because of a staunch Dayton defense that featured a last-minute goal line stand. UD twice moved deep into Bearcat turf in the second half, but fumbled. Two other fumbles, in Flyer territory, set up scores that boosted UC to a 28-0 tally.

Dayton controlled the first 30 minutes of the Kent State game to win the half, 6-0; but UD's offensive mistakes and poor field position helped the Flashes to the two second-stanza touchdowns and a 14-6 revenge of last year's loss. A bright spot of the afternoon was the defensive play of Gary Hussion, who intercepted 3 passes, tying a UD record.







The Flyers came home to face Bowling Green, and only Tom Prinz's punting kept the Falcons from climbing into the Dayton helmets. BG took the match, 9-0.

The Louisville Cardinals whipped the Flyers, 34-0, and Dayton began hanging a lot of hope on the Homecoming game. The Quantico Marines were 0-3 when they visited Baujan Field. Marine quarterback Mike Cotton threw the ball everywhere except where people were (especially receivers), but the Flyers played their usual quota of fumbles and first-and-goals that got nowhere, and the Gyrenes left 1-3 on a 10-0 effort.

The single friendly score of the season, that first half touchdown against Kent State, looked awful lonely on the statistics sheets Joe McLaughlin was mailing out. But Buffalo and Dayton traded goal line stands, and the game ended in a scoreless tie.

Ohio University had an even worse record than UD: 0-6 to 0-5-1. But they'd averaged over two touchdowns a game, and Bill Hess, Bobcat coach, was determined to take this one home. It even looked as if he might when the first Flyer drive stalled three feet from paydirt. But the Daytonians scored the next two times they had the ball and hung on for a 13-7 victory. There was much jubilation and noise in the locker room; it was the first time in weeks that reporters hadn't found McVay with head in hands after the game.

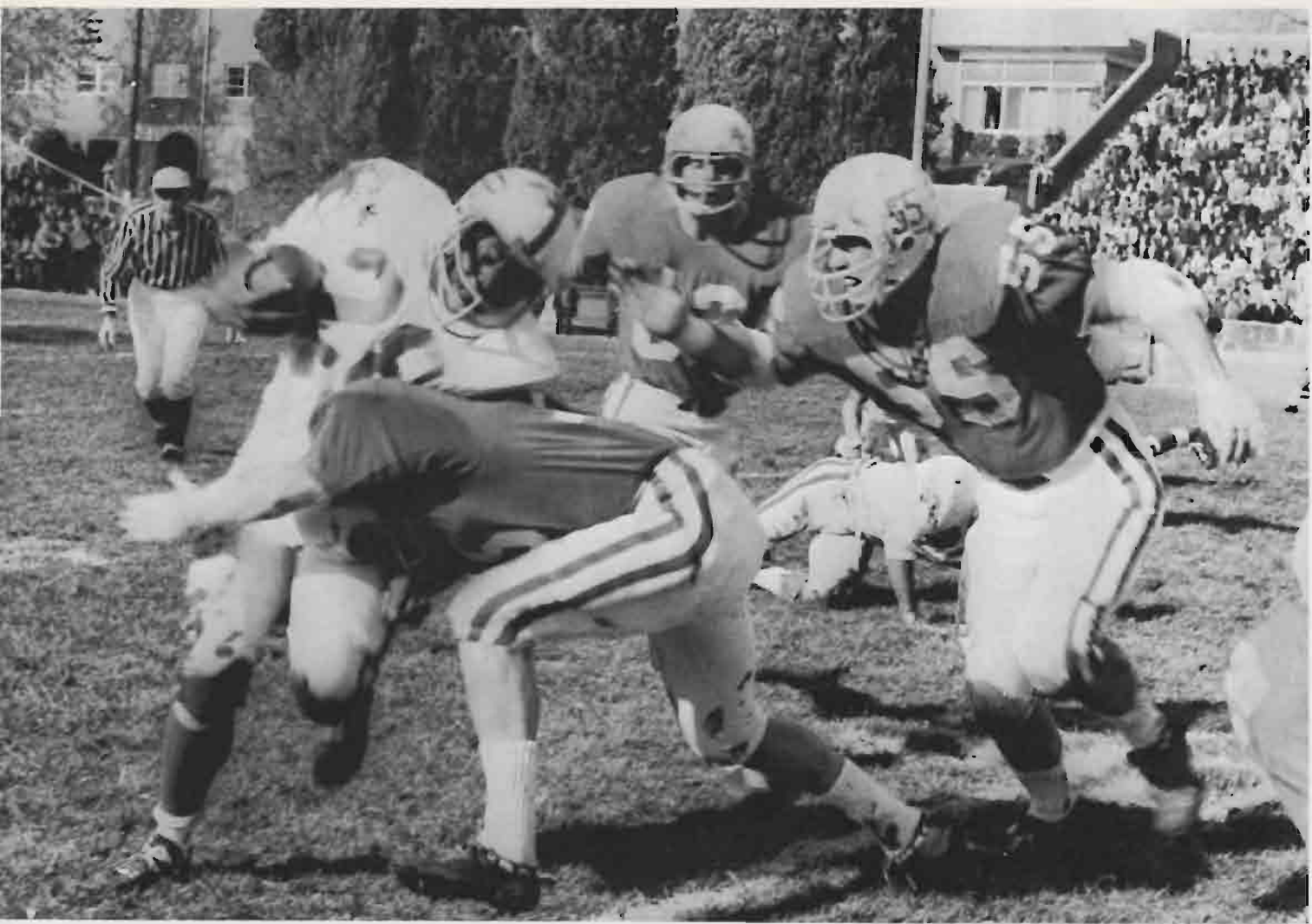

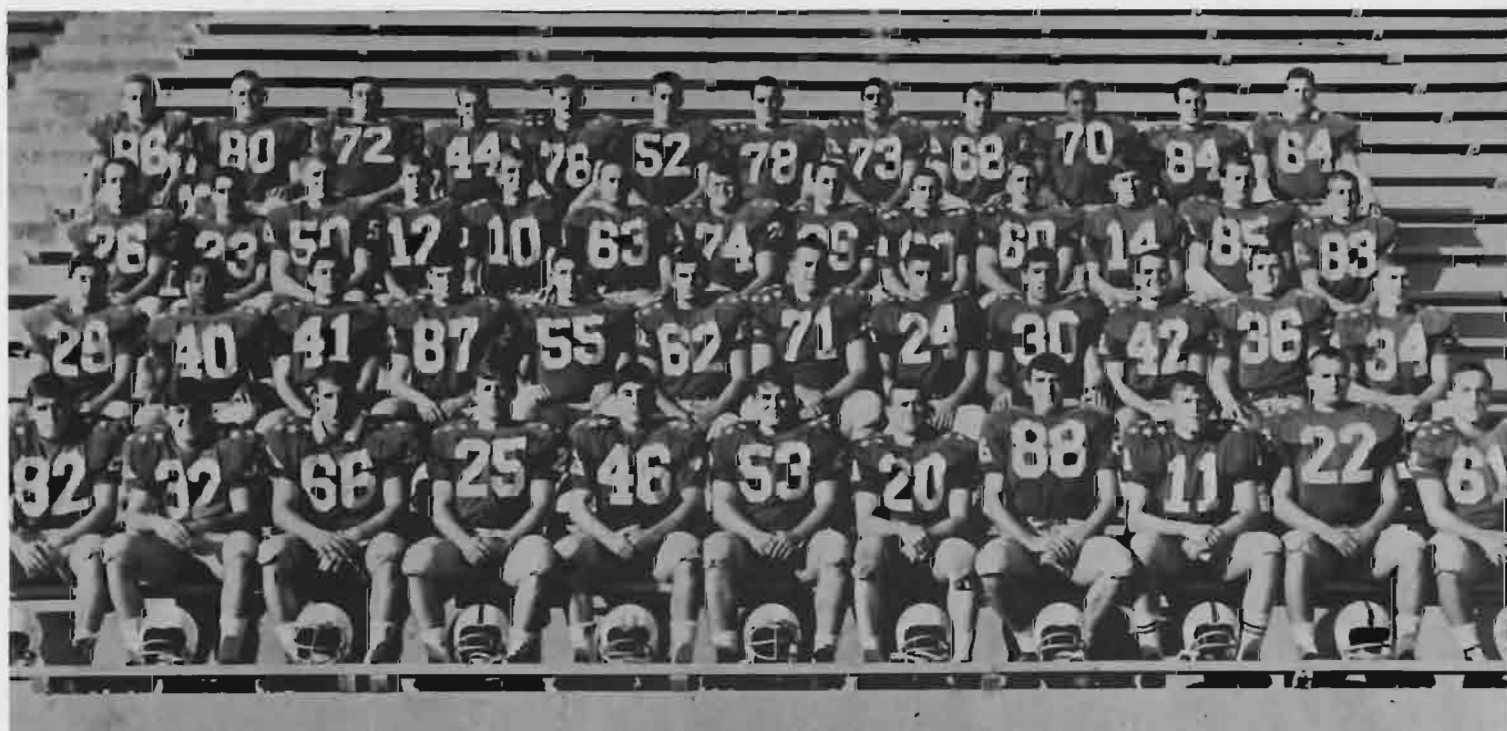


Victory is inebriating. The Flyers visited Xavier expecting an upset; for 58 minutes (excepting a field goal) they had it. But UD quarterback Joe Rudolph suffered a shoulder separation and Xavier tallied a final-minute 7-pointer to win.

Miami showed Dayton a strong running attack intermixed with some long bomb passing in beating Dayton 28-0 on rain-soaked Baujan Field, and Toledo parlayed a strong defense into a 21-7 whupping of UD to close the season.

Mike Ciccolella won the Flyer of the Year award and the Lt. Stanley Kurdziel trophy as the outstanding lineman. Bob Shortal received the White-Allen Most Valuable Player award, and Tom Gorius and Gary Hussion were co-winners of the John L. MacBeth Scholar-Athlete award.

The Flyers' curious and strangely marvelous inability to score was only partially offset by the grim defense the team was forced to play; however determined the defense, you must score points to win. Michigan State went 10-0, but lost to UCLA in the Rose Bowl. Wait till next year, McVay said. He meant Dayton.

Despite a longer and rougher schedule, coach John Schleppe, along with thirteen returning lettermen and some promising newcomers, set out to better last year's record of 4-4.

After two weeks of practice, Dayton opened its season at Cedarville. Dayton could not manage a score; but neither could Cedarville, and the first game ended in a 0-0 tie.

The Flyers next played Ohio University. The Bobcats easily handled Dayton, 6-1. Festus Muundjau scored the only Dayton goal, a third-period direct kick from twenty-five yards.

Dayton bounced back to win the following week over Bowling Green, 4-1, as Festus Muundjua scored two goals and Dave Loftus and George Schoen added one each.

The next game saw Muundjau marking three goals but getting no support from his teammates. Ohio State tallied early and defeated the Flyers 6-3. George Schoen, Eli Saleeby, and Luciano Cruisi all netted goals as UD evened the season record with a 3-2 defeat of Wilmington.

Notre Dame and Miami both beat the booters, 2-1 and 4-2. Following the Miami loss, the Flyers played their best short passing game of the year and beat Toledo 2-1.

The Flyer kickers needed both of the remaining games for their first winning season since 1958, but could only manage a split. They bowed to the University of Chicago 3-2, but overwhelmed Wilberforce 7-3 in the final game of the season.







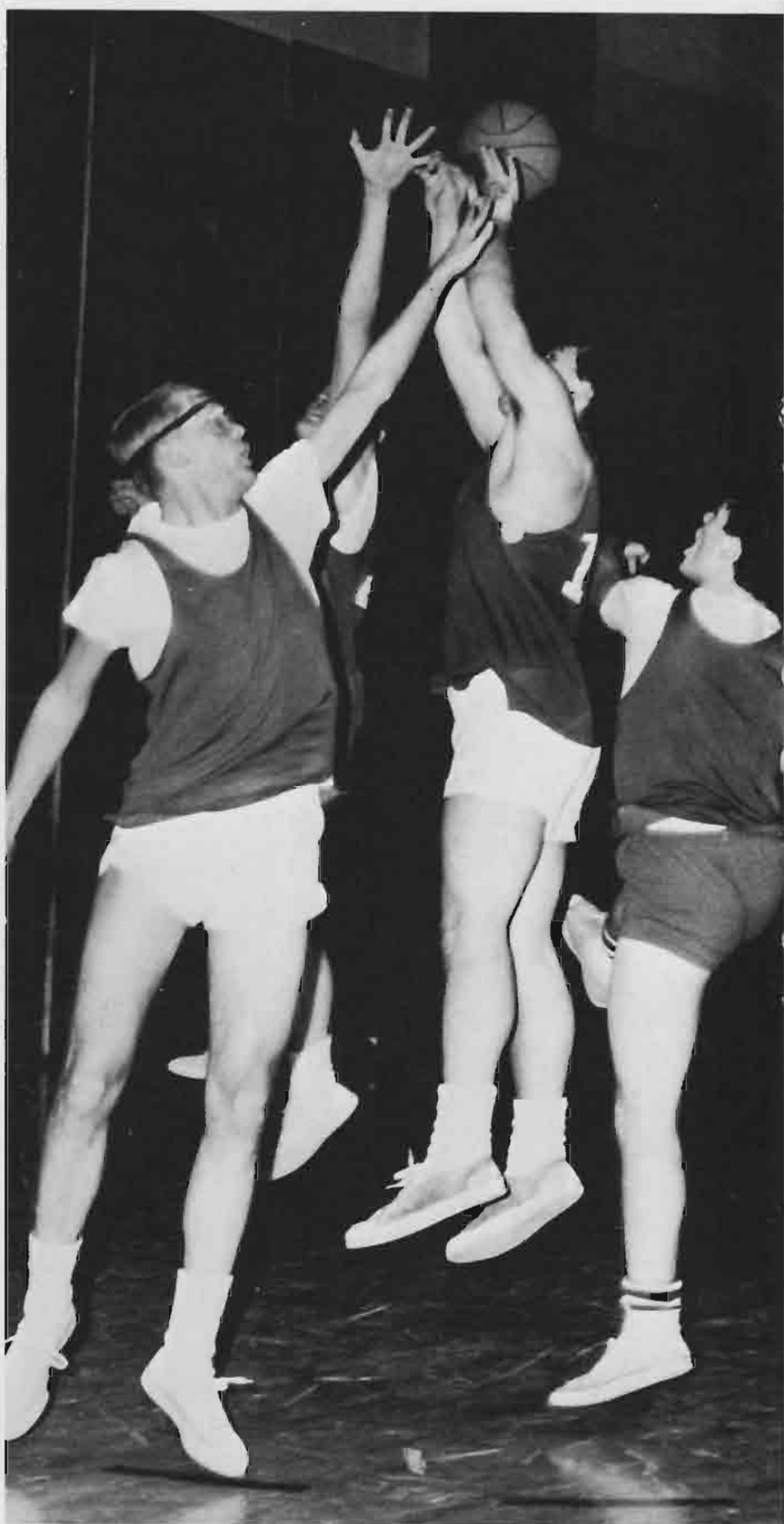
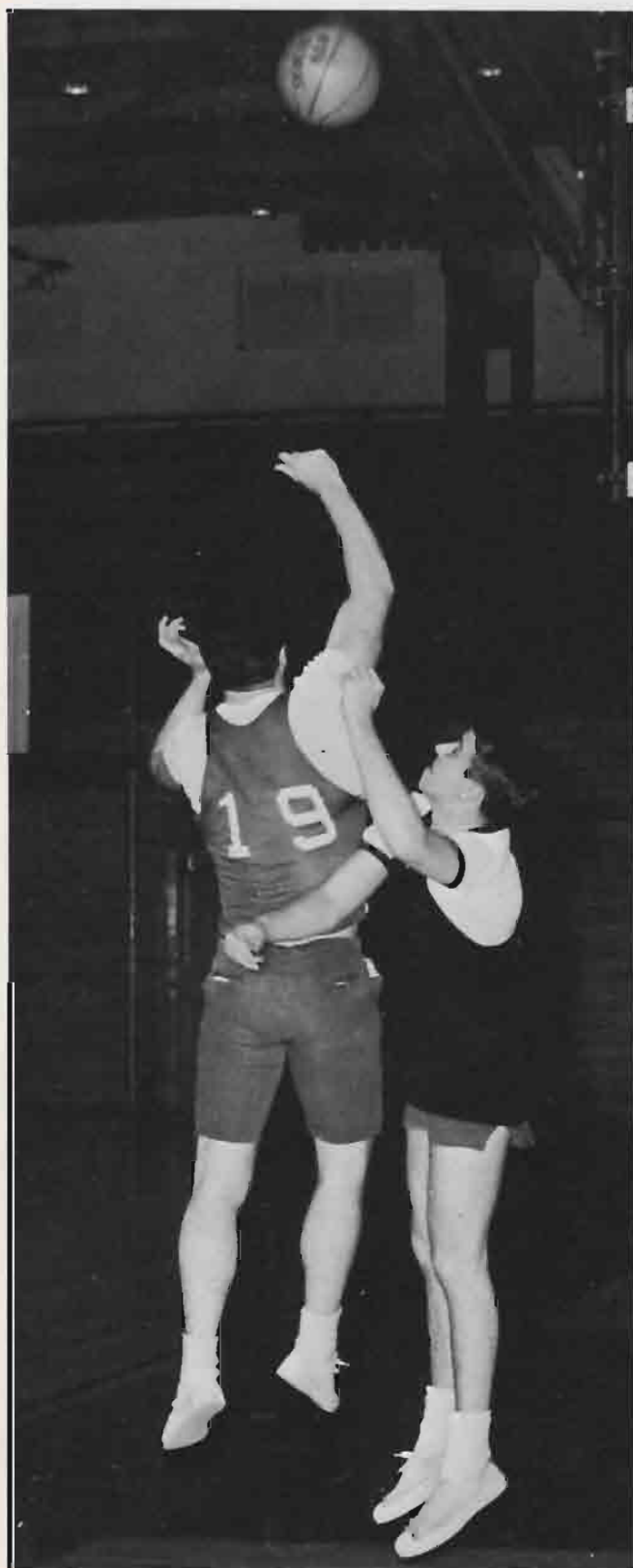

Bigtime Basketball



People who watch basketball games have come to expect a certain type of game from the University of Dayton team: there's one big man—very big; at least 6-10 or so—and four little guys. The way the game is played, the big man stands under the basket and the little guys throw the ball to him. Half the passes he doesn't drop he converts into field goals, and the other guys score whenever three or more of the enemy are attempting to smother the big guy right there on the open court before 6000 witnesses.

Because he is so much the object of the opposition's defensive efforts, the big man is called the center. He is easily recognizable—even among other near-7-footers—because of his bruises.



The tender ministrations of the opposition are usually directed at the short ribs, the throat, the nose, the belly, and other spots scientifically selected for their susceptibility to stray elbows. No one prays for the appearance of a UD flashy guard more than the center. A flashy guard is defined as a short guy who scores readily from more than 20 feet out. If someone has to watch the flashy guard the center gets a chance to breathe.

It used to be that you could count on this sort of game. If you had a center like Hank Finkel, you didn't have to worry too much about the dropped passes. He didn't drop that many, and he was a 60 per cent floor shooter, besides. He could move as if his feet weren't nailed to the floor. He even dribbled the ball. He was the principal reason Dayton was 22-7 last year.

You could count on this sort of game. In a shifting and unstable world, things you can count on are rare.

You can't count on it any more. UD doesn't play that way this year. The reason is a sophomore named Donny May, and he works as well as a flashy guard. Finkel doesn't stand in the low post, swarmed by the defense. He stands three or four feet farther away, swarmed by the defense, and May runs in behind the crowd and throws the ball into the basket.





Sometimes he gets tired of running, and just throws the ball into the basket. Period.

He didn't do it so much the first six games. Finkel had to carry the club, and he did, with help from a fine brace of guards, Bobby Hooper and Gene Klaus. Glinder Torain and Bill Cassidy, co-captain with Finkel, alternated at the other forward. Bill had the experience the team needed—with Torain, the Flyers started three sophomores—but he was plagued by miserable shooting.

At any rate, UD took Villa Madonna 90-59, slipped past Eastern Kentucky 72-69, beat Miami 63-48, Middle Tennessee 90-63 and Louisville (a surprisingly easy game) 76-59, almost fell to Canisius, 72-69.

Then May caught on. When everybody is picking on the center, a smart forward can enjoy the game without too much trouble—especially if he's 6-4, 200 pounds, and quick. The next pair of outings May scored 31 and 27 points and the Flyers squelched Loyola of the South 88-57 and previously unbeaten Auburn 85-71 in the first round of the Sugar Bowl tournament.

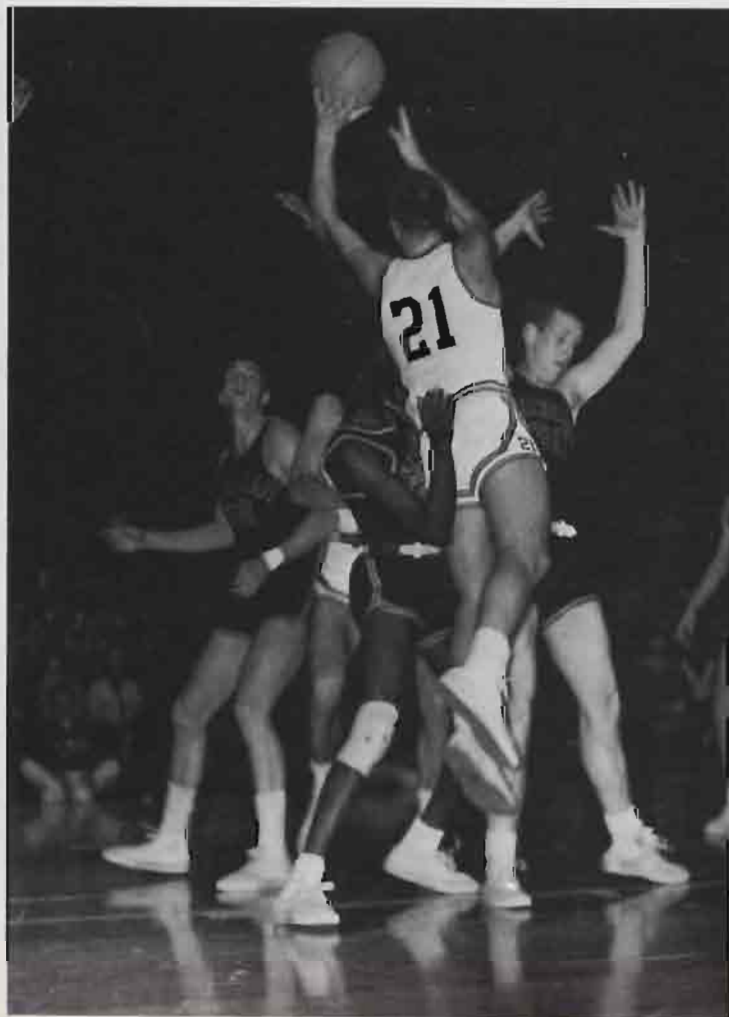
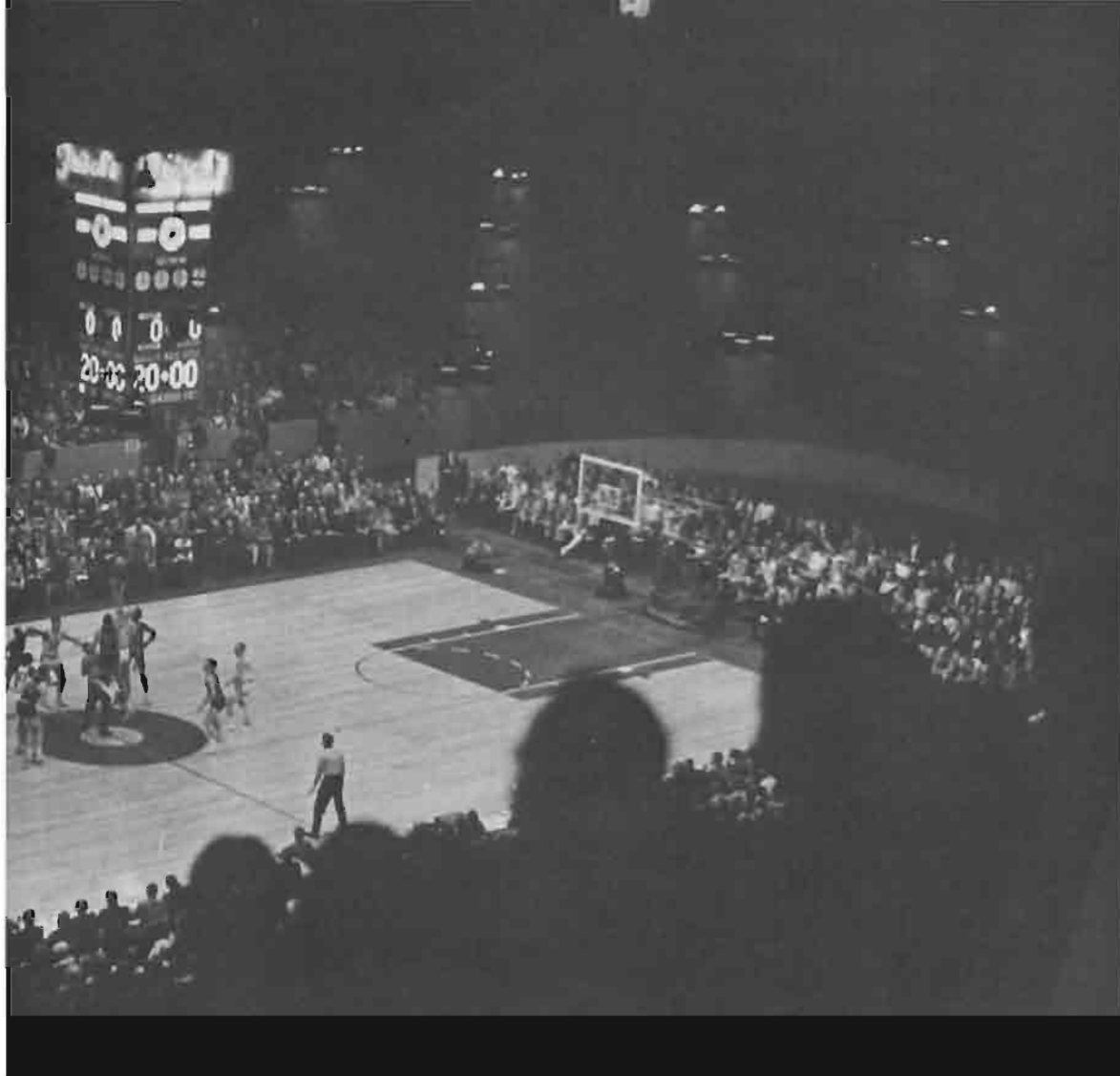
The following night was bad. No Flyer seemed to play defense and Maryland took the first half by 14 points. Donoher must have said something, 'cause the Flyers won the second half—but only by 12.

So Dayton was runner-up in the tournament. Hank Finkel scored 44 points against Maryland and cinched the tourney MVP cup. Then, against Xavier in the Fieldhouse, he turned feeder and self-portable 7-foot screen, and May produced 45 points as the Flyers embarrassed the Muskies, 105-79.

The usual excitement haloing the DePaul-away game (Trip to Chicago! Big City! Wheel!) was overshadowed by the last eight minutes of the game. Up 58-51 with 12 minutes to go, DePaul coach Ray Meyer ordered a stall. It worked. After 4 minutes of that nonsense, Donoher countered with Bill Cassidy and a zone press. For the last 8 minutes Cassidy played St. Dismas-on-skates, Hooper and Klaus played pressure the ball, Finkel played roving screen, and May played shoot-'em-up. Final score: 81-70. Reason enough to develop a happy hangover.

Cincinnati has beaten Dayton in b-ball for 8 years. They might even have been able to do it again this year all by themselves (they shot 59 per cent), but they didn't have to. 87-79, bad guys. The Flyers mobilized their frustrations against Seattle and Pennsylvania's St. Francis, 81-65 and 98-66. But Louisville had frustrations of their own, and Dayton suffered, 94-77. The defense was terrible.





The offense was swell. For the first time in his Flyer career, Finkel wasn't top scorer: May was a point-per-game ahead; but the front line (including Torain and Cassidy) was averaging 19 points apiece, and the guards 10.

Still, the defense was terrible. There is something about playing defense that eludes coaches and players alike, a spirit, an elan that isn't easily come by. It helps if you enjoy the contact in what the rulebook calls a non-contact sport. It helps if you prefer spiking a basketball into someone's face to putting the thing through the hoop. If you file your elbows to sharp points, study karate, and tape razor blades on your leg pads, you have it. If you're 6-8 and a hatchet murderer, some coach is looking for you.

Without all that physical equipment, you need pride and hustle. That's Cassidy. He came off the bench against Western Kentucky and did well enough to help Dayton win by 20.

To this point, though, there was no bench but the Cassidy-Torain combo. Jim Wannemacher, a starting forward the year before, was hobbled by back trouble and couldn't play. Denny Papp, who'd figured to start during the season, injured his knee in practice and never walked on the court. Once Cassidy and Torain were committed, there was no one for Donohar to look to, except the promise that was Rudy Waterman.

Playing St. Joseph in the Palestra is an experience enjoyed most by those who are endowed with a broad streak of masochism. It's like a two hour session with a screaming psychiatrist in a steam bath. Therapeutic. Somehow the Flyers kept pace with the Hawks—Hooper and Klaus controlled the tempo through most of the game—, even won the first half by 5, and opened the spread another 4 right at the start of the second. But Cassidy fouled out with 15 minutes to go and Don May with 8, and the Palestrans went up 70-66. Torain and Waterman took over in front, the Flyers switched to zone defense, and the score evened with three minutes left. Then the game started. When it ended, 6 time outs later, the Flyers had all the marbles.



The Daytonians coasted past Murray State. They must have still been thinking about St. Joe's, though, 'cause Xavier caught 'em in an embarrassing position: 7 points down in the last five minutes. It took another flurry of time outs for the Flyers to catch up. Then they idled past Memphis State.

All this idleness told: the third-ranked Loyola Ramblers trimmed the Flyers 77-72 in the Fieldhouse. Dayton woke up enough to set back Miami—again by 15. But against Houston in Madison Square Garden they set back basketball by about twenty years, in Donohue's opinion, yet still managed to win. Waterman started this game in place of an ailing Hooper, and his 16 points were the only pleasant aspect of an otherwise sloppy display. He did well against DePaul (another squeaker), and brilliantly versus Detroit. But the Detroit game was dominated by Hank Finkel: he scored 32 points, snaffled 13 rebounds, set another career scoring record, led the team for the third year in scoring, rebounds, shooting percentage. Making his farewell address to Flyer followers, he claimed playing basketball at UD had been his pleasure.

Maybe so. But that's only half. There's something to be said for the type of game you expect from the University of Dayton team.



NCAA

The Flyers went off to the wars with a 22-4 record and the first team they had to meet was Miami, the MAC champ. The Redskins had fallen to UD twice in the season, and Dick Shrider's champs said the third time was to be the charm. They nearly did it. Little Phil Snow kept bombing from long range, Pierson shut off Don May, and only Rudy Waterman's 10 first-half points and Hank Finkel's game-high 25—with 17 rebounds—pulled the Flyers over the top: 58-51.

Iowa City was not so pleasant. After playing Kentucky even for 30 minutes, the Flyers suddenly found themselves unable to handle Baron Rupp's 1-3-1 trap. The Wildcats ran off 9 straight points and ended 7 up.

Western Kentucky had a reason to play Saturday night—they lost to Michigan by 1 point, and Dayton had beaten the Hilltoppers by 20 during the season. Western whipped the Flyers. It was a disappointing end to a fine season.

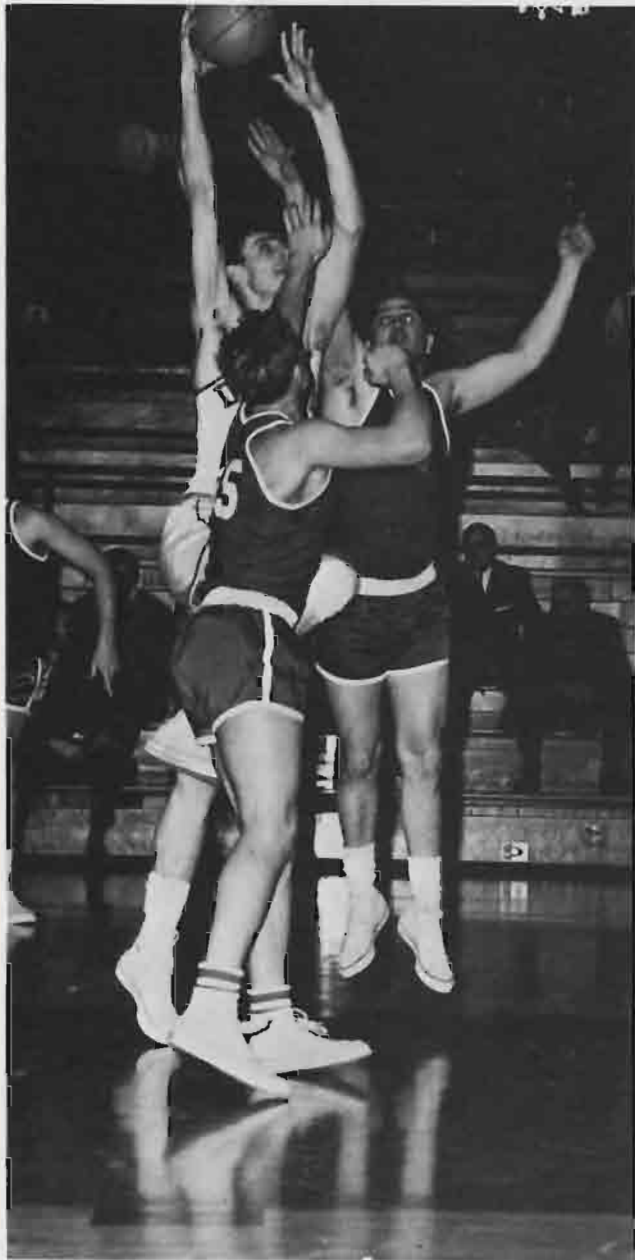
