Simulation of Live Birth



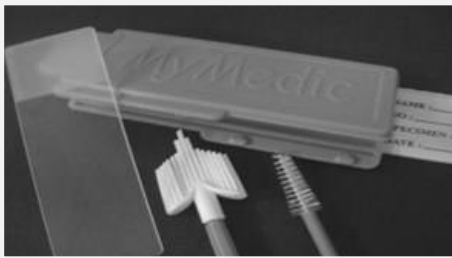

Communication: The Art of Dealing with Parents, Depression and Postpartum Depression



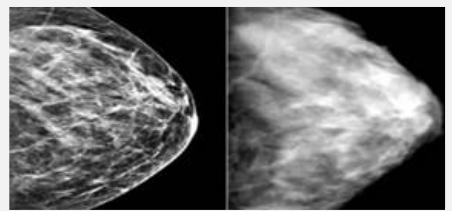
