

Griz Hoop Report

9-2 Grizzlies Host Seattle Pacific Falcons

The University of Montana Grizzly basketball team continues to come out of the blocks like Carl Lewis, but the problem is they are still fading at the finish line every now and then during their pre-conference schedule.

Never-the-less coach Mike Montgomery's 1984-85 team boasts a 9-2 record, with the losses both one-point setbacks. It's been a hair-pulling preseason for Montgomery, as five of

his teams' 11 games have been decided by two points or less, and four of those games have been one-pointers.

"We're definitely satisfied with a 9-2 record," said Montgomery, who is 120-59 in his seventh season. "We've beaten what I would call some good teams, maybe not great teams, but teams that will finish in the top half of their conferences.

"I think probably four teams from our conference might be better than the people we

Congratulations to these players and a SPECIAL THANKS to McDonald's for their support..... have already played, as least most of them," he said. "We've had some close ones, and both losses were one-pointers to Pac-10 schools."

Seattle Pacific is 4-4 overall with a recent road victory over St. Martin's. The Falcons are coached by former Stanford great Claude Terry.

The Falcons are led by 6-3 guard/forward Glenn Stump, who is averaging 24 points a game. He is one of two starters off a 17-13 team of last season. SPU is a member of the Great Northwest Conference, which includes Eastern Montana, Alaska-Fairbanks, Alaska-Anchorage and Puget Sound.

Montana continues to be led by All-American candidate Larry Krystkowiak, who is averaging 20.5 points and 9.1 rebounds a game. He is shooting 60 percent from the field and 88 percent from the free throw line.

Also in double figures for the Grizzlies is Larry McBride who is averaging 10.1 points and five rebounds a game. He leads the Big Sky Conference in blocks with 23. "Mac" also leads UM in field goal percentage at a lofty 66.7 percent (48 of 72).

As a team Montana is shooting 53 percent (284 of 533) from the field, with only one starter shooting under 50 percent.

"We've got to use our next three games (UM hosts E. Washington and Loyola next week) to put into effect all of the things we've learned," said Montgomery. "We need to shore up some areas. And we need to use the clock better and play with intensity during the entire game.

"We are just a few little things away from being a good basketball team," he continued. "Our team recognition in certain situations needs improvement. We are learning to take advantage of our inside game, so that when teams double on Krysko we get the ball to Mac. Our players are doing a good job of making the pass inside and taking the shot when they need to."

Getting off to good starts has been nothing new for Montgomery and his staff of Stew Morrill and Bob Niehl. Montana jumped to a 8-0 start last year before bowing at Cal-Irvine. The previous season UM set a school record with nine consecutive wins, finally losing to Fresno State, which went on to win the NIT that year. Along with those fast starts came records of 21-8 and 23-7 (last year).

Next week the Grizzlies host Eastern

Washington, a team they beat 77-70 in Cheney last week, Thursday, Jan. 3. Saturday, Jan. 5, UM hosts Loyola-Marymount of California, a team the Grizzlies beat 82-70 on the road last season.

The following week UM begins its Big Sky Conference season on the road at Boise State and Idaho.

ing in all 11 of its games. . . . He remains 9th in career rebounding with 535 and 15th in scoring with 902 points.... The record holders in those categories are Ken McKenzie (859 rebounds) and M.R. Richardson (1,827 points). . . . There have been only two players at UM to average over 20 points a game in the last quarter of a century -Richardson's 24.2 in 1978 and Bob Cope's 22.6 in 1950. . . . McBride now has 87 career blocks. . . The Griz road sweep over E. Washington and Fullerton was the first since the 1981 season when UM won 69-62 at Weber State and 53-49 at Idaho State. . . . Washington now ranks 7th in career assists with 168. . . . UM's 53 percent shooting is record pace, UM shot 50.5 percent in 1975-76. . . Krysko has scored 20 or more points in 8 of 11 games. . . . Last week Krysko was 16 of 22 from the field and 5 of 6 from the line. . . . In case you're wondering the last sweep on the road in the preseason was 1976-77 over San Jose State (87-71) and Air Force (65-59). . . . That was M.R. Richardson's junior year. . . .






President Neil Bucklew

Neil S. Bucklew assumed his duties as the 14th president of the University of Montana in August 1981. Bucklew, 43, came from Ohio University in Athens, where he served as provost from 1976 until assuming his duties at Montana. He also served on the faculty in the Department of Economics at Ohio University. As provost he functioned as executive vice president and vice president for academic affairs, with respon-

sibility for the instructional program of the university

He was vice president for administration at Central Michigan from 1973-74; vice provost at Central Michigan from 1970-73; director of employment relations at the University of Wisconsin from 1966-70 and personnel director at Duke University Medical Center in Durham, North Carolina, from 1963-66.

Bucklew received a B.A. in history at the University of Missouri, an M.S. in political science at the University of North Carolina and a Ph.D. in industrial relations and economics from the University of Wisconsin. Bucklew and his wife, JoAnn, have three children.

Vice President for University Relations Mike Easton

W. Michael Easton became the Vice President for University Relations in August of 1982.

His responsibilities encompass student affairs, intercollegiate athletics, university relations, admissions, financial aid, alumni, development and auxiliary services.

Easton, 41, had nearly identical responsibilities at the University of South Dakota, where he was vice president for student services and public information since 1973.

Other positions he has held include dean of students, Eastern Montana College, 1971-73; assistant dean of students, EMC, 1969-71; administrative intern, Lane Community College in Eugene, Oregon, 1968-69; and assistant dean of students, University of Oregon, 1967-68.

He received his B.A. in biology and physical education at the University of Washington in 1964. He received his M.S. in education at the University of Oregon in 1965 and earned a Ph.D. in higher education administration at Oregon in 1969.

Easton and his wife, Patricia, have three children.

Athletic Director Harley Lewis

In his ninth year as athletic director, Harley W. Lewis was named AD at the University of Montana in April of 1976.

Lewis is involved in numerous organizations at the state and national level. He was the State Director for the Montana Special Olympics in 1980 and 1981. He served as National Director for the USABA Blind Olympics in 1983, when the national championships were hosted by UM.

He also is Chairman of a local school board, on the State Board of directors for the Special Olympics, and on the Board of Directors for the YMCA. He is on several Big Sky Conference committees and on the NCAA's Track & Field Rules Committee.

He served as cross country coach until 1976 and his teams won nine league titles. He served as track coach until 1978 and won the conference crown in 1972. Lewis was named the Big Sky's track and cross country coach of the year 10 times during his tenure as mentor. He coached several All-Americans while a coach and continues to work with the Montana Olympic Committee, on which he is on the State Board of Directors.

Lewis is a 1964 graduate of UM with an M.S. in Health, Physical Education and Recreation. He became track and cross country coach at Montana in 1966. Prior to that he coached for two seasons at the University of Portland. He is a 1959 graduate of Butte High School.

Lewis and his wife, Marilou, have two children.

Associate Athletic Director Barbara Hollmann

Barbara Hollmann began her duties as associate athletic director in August 1980. In addition to serving as the associate director of the department, her responsibilities involve coordinating, supervising and promoting the women's athletic program.

Prior to UM Hollmann spent five years as athletic events coordinator and assistant to the women's athletic director at the University of Arizona. From 1971 through 1974 she was an assistant director and later an associate director of intramural and recreational sports at the University of Washington.

Hollmann graduated from Ohio State University with a B.S. in physical education in 1964 and a M.A. in recreation administration in 1968. She received her Ph.D. in 1982 from the University of Arizona, emphasizing higher education administration and public management.

Hollmann currently serves on the NCAA Executive Committee and several other NCAA committees, the Executive Board of the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics and the Board of Directors of the Council of Collegiate Women Athletic Administrators. She was involved with the founding of the Mountain West Athletic Conference and served as the first president. Her husband, Robert, is an associate professor of management at UM.

Faculty Representative Evan Denney

Beginning his sixth year as UM's faculty representative to the National Collegiate Athletic Association, Evan has been a faculty member here since 1969. From 1979-81 he served as chairman of the Geography Department. His areas of academic specialty are economic geography and land planning and design. He earned his B.A. at the University of Washington in 1963, his M.A. at Washington in 1965, and his Ph.D. from Washington in 1970. Prior to his UM teaching career, he taught at the University of Washington (1966-69) and Northern Colorado University (1956-66). From Seattle, Washington, Denney is associated with several professional organizations. He determines eligibilities for UM athletes, makes NCAA rulings at the institution level, and is a University of Montana representative to the NCAA.

Denney and his wife, Terri, have two children.

Head Coach



Mike Montgomery

Now in his seventh year as head coach, Mike Montgomery boasts one of the most successful collegiate basketball programs in the Northwest. He has the best winning percentage in Montana history (65.7%) and averages almost 19 wins a season.

In his first five years he guided Montana to the four-team, postseason Big Sky Tournament, and would have last year with a second place regular season finish. However, last season all eight Conference teams participated in the tourney.

"Monty," 37, has 111 victories — ranking him second, only behind the Dahlberg Arena namesake, Jiggs Dahlberg, in total number of wins. Montana has won 20 or more games only six times in its 77-year basketball tradition and Montgomery has two of those.

Last year's 23 wins was the second most in Grizzly history, only behind Dahlberg's 27 (and 4) in 1950. UM's back-to-back 20-win seasons in 1983 and 1984 was the first time in school history a coach and his teams have accomplished that.

Montgomery has 14 years of major college coaching experience and is beginning his 12th year in the Big Sky Conference. He served as an assistant at Boise State for three seasons before coming to UM.

He has also had coaching stints at the U.S. Coast Guard Academy, Colorado State, the Citadel and the University of Florida.

Sound defense has been Montana's forte over the past decade and Montgomery has continued that tradition. Last year UM was 10th in the nation in field goal percentage and led the Big Sky in defense. UM has led the league in defense 11 of the last 13 seasons.

"We take a lot of pride in having tough, hard-nosed players who are willing to sacrifice themselves for team success," Montgomery said.

"Basketball to me is a percentage game where you take advantage of your personnel and allow them to do the things they can do within a team concept," he said. "Our goal is to reach our potential as a team. This requires a very thorough approach to the game. Discipline and dedication from everyone within the program helps us reach that potential."

Montgomery is a 1968 graduate of Long Beach State where he was a four-year letterman in basketball. He also participated in volleyball and rugby. He earned his master's degree in Physical Education at Colorado State.

Mike and his wife, Sarah, have a two-year-old son, John, and are expecting their second child in February.

Assistant Coaches

Stew, 32, is in his seventh season as the number one Grizzly assistant in charge of recruiting and scheduling. He was an assistant coach at former Big Sky Conerence member Gonzaga University for three years. During those three years he was the number one coaching assistant and was the school's recruiting coordinator for two seasons. He was a graduate assistant for the Bulldogs for one season.


He was an All-Big Sky center at Gonzaga his senior year in 1973-74, and was named team captain and Most Valuable Player for the Bulldogs that season.

Prior to playing at the four-year level he participated in basketball at Ricks College, where he averaged 23 points a game as a sophomore and was named a JC All-American.

He played pro basketball in Europe for a Division I team in Bordeaux, France, after his graduation from Gonzaga in 1974. After a few months with the team he was named player-coach.

From Provo, Utah, Morrill earned nine letters in basketball, football and track at Provo High School.

His wife's name is Vicki. They have three children.



Stew Morrill Assistant Coach

Bob Niehl is in his fifth season at UM. He assists in varsity coaching, along with scouting and recruiting, as well as supervising the Grizzly Cage Camps each summer.

Before coming to Montana he served as a part-time coach for George Raveling at Washington State University in Pullman. At WSU he was head coach of the JVs, and assisted in varsity scouting and recruiting in 1978-79-80. He has also had a lot of experience in WSU's basketball camps.

Bob also served as a graduate assistant at WSU for a season. From 1975-77 he was the head basketball and girl's and boy's track coach at Sprague High School in Sprague, Washington.

He was a standout athlete at WSU, where he was a three-year letterman in basketball and team captain his senior season. He was a seven-foot high jumper for the Cougars, and qualified for the NCAAs all four of his collegiate seasons. He is a 1970 graduate of Bethel High School in Spanaway, Washington, where he was also a basketball and track star.

Niehl, 33, is a 1975 graduate of WSU, receiving a B.S. in physical education.

His wife's name is Tricia.

Montana Gridders Set Numerous Offensive Records in 1984

The University of Montana Grizzly Football team finished the 1984 season tying or breaking 24 offensive records, including many by UM's all-time quarterback, Marty Mornhinweg.

UM was 2-8-1 in '84 and a disappointing 0-7 in Big Sky Conference games. The Grizzlies closed their season with a 45-31 loss to Army in the 8th Annual Mirage Bowl, played in Tokyo, Japan.

Fifteen of those records were set by Mornhinweg who finished his career as the No. 2 passer in the Big Sky Conference 23-year history.

The other individual record was established by Missoula senior wide receiver Bob McCauley, who had 933 yards receiving, breaking Brian Salonen's 1983 record of 832 yards. Junior Ted Ray tied the record for kickoff returns with 28. Greg Dunn also had 28 returns in 1979.

In all 59 players earned varsity letters, including 14 freshman, nine of whom played defense.

"We had a much different defensive unit than I thought we would because of injuries," Donovan said. "I'm not trying to make excuses, but that's a fact. We had a few kids who we thought could help us in a year or two, but we had to use them right away.

"But, one thing you have to say about our football team, is that when a lot of teams would have quit; we competed harder and harder," he continued. "We stayed in every game in the last half of the season and just couldn't pull any out."

"Offensively, our receivers were an excellent, exciting group, and of course what can I say about Marty; except that he is the best quarterback to ever play at the University of Montana," Donovan said. "I also was pleased with the way Paul Lamb came on at tight end and he and Brad Salonen will give us a good combination there next season."

Donovan also praised, "the late season running of (tailback) Leroy Foster, and the consistency of (fullback) Scott Murray."

Last season Foster, a junior, led UM in rushing with 385 yards on 80 carries for a 4.3 yard average. He rushed for three touchdowns. Murray, also a junior, was the second leading rusher with 291 yards on 67 carries for a 4.3 average and two scores.

McCauley led the receivers with 51 catches for 933 yards and seven TDs and also rushed for two scores. The next leading receivers were Curt McGinness (29 for 438), Kelly Richardson (27 for 390) and Scott Moe (16 for 248).

Lamb had 12 for 121 yards, including nine for 98 yards in the season finale with Army. Salonen had four receptions for 46 yards, before being injured and forced to redshirt.

"We'll miss a lot of those players, and especially Kelly Richardson," Donovan said. "He did a lot of things for us both at quarter-

back and wide receiver during his career. His versatility and competitive drive will be missed."

With the recruiting season now in full gear the sixth-year coach said quarterback is a number one priority, "along with developing our younger players."

On defense Donovan said the key positions were noseguard and the secondary, although he felt good about the return of defensive backs Terry Shillam, Ted Ray, Tim Monterossi and Ned Becker.

"We've got to rejuvenate the defensive toughness at Montana and player-coach intensity," Donovan said. "We need to reestablish our toughness and get back the winning edge."

Another big plus on defense will be the return of the Poole brothers, Scott and Shawn. The 6-7, 280-pound Scott was injured early in the '84 season. Shawn is a $6.4\frac{1}{2}$, 260-pound junior, while Scott will be a senior.

Donovan also talked about the kicking game, saying, "our emphasis paid off in the punting area and in punt cover; but we now need to correct and solidify our field goal and punt return teams.

"Overall our football team has one of the best, if not the best, post-season attitudes we've had to date as we gear up to the 1985 season," Donovan said. "This along with the outstanding freshman we recruited in 1984 should give us the impetus to go into the '85 season with vigor and renewed enthusiasm."


