Shipwrecks, ascidians and *Modiolarca subpicta* (Bivalvia, Mytilidae, Musculinae)

Abstract

A large population of *Modiolarca subpicta* is reported upon from a shipwreck in the Dutch part of the Brown Ridge in the central North Sea, where it occurs within individuals of the solitary sea-squirt *Ascidiella aspersa*.
