1 **10** Regulations may make consequential amendments of Acts

- 3(1)The Governor-General may make regulations amending Acts (including4the Marriage Act 1961) being amendments that are consequential on, or5that otherwise relate to, the amendments made by this Schedule. The6amendments may be made by directly amending the text of an Act.
- 7 (2) The Governor-General may make regulations prescribing matters of a
 8 transitional nature (including prescribing any saving or application
 9 provisions) relating to any amendments made by regulations under
 10 subitem (1).
- (3) Despite subsection 12(2) of the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003* (as in force immediately before the commencement of Schedule 1 to the *Acts and Instruments (Framework Reform) Act 2015*), regulations made for the purposes of this item may be expressed to take effect from a date before the regulations are registered under that Act.
- 16(4)Subsection 12(2) (retrospective application of legislative instruments)17of the Legislation Act 2003, as in force on and after the commencement18of Schedule 1 to the Acts and Instruments (Framework Reform) Act192015, does not apply in relation to regulations made for the purposes of20this item.
- (5) To avoid doubt, amendments of an Act made by regulations for the
 purposes of subitem (1) can be incorporated into a reprint or
 compilation of the Act.
