Prevent Truancy & Unexcused Absences

Utilize Independent Study On the rare occasion that you must take your child out of school for a vacation or travel outside of a regularly scheduled holiday or school break you must arrange for independent study. Successful completion of I/S prevents unexcused absences or truancy and ensures that your child doesn't fall behind academically.

- I/S must be for an absence of at least 5 days and no more than 15 days
- Parents/Guardians must notify the school at least 5 days in advance of the future absence/departure
- The school principal must approve the I/S contract
- Upon the student's return the teacher will evaluate the work and award attendance
- Failure to complete the assignment(s) during the absence will result in unexcused absences and/or truancy referral
- I/S is not for recapturing unexcused days or students who are ill
- No credit will be given for incomplete assignments or work that fails to demonstrate reasonable quality.

Homeschooling In Monterey? Register

with a public school, private school, public charter school, correspondence course, virtual academy, or file an R-4 affidavit with the State. Contact your SLO for assistance.
