LIFETIME SURVEILLANCE OF ASTRONAUT HEALTH (LSAH) / LIFE SCIENCES DATA ARCHIVE (LSDA) DATA REQUEST HELPDESK

This session is intended to provide to HRP IWS attendees instant feedback on archived astronaut data, including such topics as content of archives, access, request processing, and data format. Members of the LSAH and LSDA teams will be available at a 'help desk' during the poster sessions to answer questions from researchers.

Researchers will be able to interact with members of the LSAH and LSDA teams to learn more about topics such as:

- How do you create a data request?
- How does the data request process work?
- What kind of data on astronauts is available?
- How long would it take to get this type of data?
- What are some of the complexities of working with clinical data as opposed to research data?
- Where can I go to find out what kind of data is stored in LSDA?
- Are there known limitations to the data I am requesting?
- Is there someone I can ask for help with planning my analysis or approach?
- Will my hypothesis work with available data?

There are many subtle nuances that can affect what kind of data researchers can receive and how long it will take to receive the data. Requests may need to go through an IRB process that may require informed consent before data can be released. Clinical data is not always collected with the same regularity as research data. Researchers can come to this helpdesk to take advantage of the best knowledge available on requesting and analyzing data. This session will be held in conjunction with the Statistics Helpdesk to meet many data needs in one convenient session.
