PRESS STATEMENTFROM: THE PREMIER (MR. DUNSTAN)

The South Australian Government has agreed to subsidise on a one for one basis up to a maximum of \$1,250 the cost of installing a water treatment plant at the Mannum learners swimming pool, the Premier, Mr. Dunstan, announced today.

Mr. Dunstan said that at present water for this pool is pumped from the River Murray and it is desirable that a treatment plant be installed to provide the necessary water quality.

Mr. Dunstan said that the plans and specifications for the proposed plant have been examined by the Engineering & Water Supply Department who have advised the Government that they meet all necessary requirements."
