An Adelaide firm, F.J. Wadham and Sons Pty Ltd, plans to establish a new plant at Murray Bfidge, the Premier, Mr Dunstan, announced today.

He said the company expects this expansion will provide jobs for ~~up~~ up to ten people ~~in the town.~~

F.J. Wadham manufacture a general range of domestic and commercial tapware, and laboratory and hospital fittings. The new service division at Murray Bridge will involve metal polishing and assembly work.

Mr Dunstan said the company, with assistance from the Industrial Development Division of the Premier's Department, had arranged to lease ~~existing~~ existing premises.

"The ~~the~~ company is expanding in Adelaide and the transfer of the service division is part of its overall expansion programme.

"This move to decentralise into a rapidly growing country area is a far-sighted one, and reflects the company's appreciation of Murray Bridge's potential," Mr Dunstan said.
