

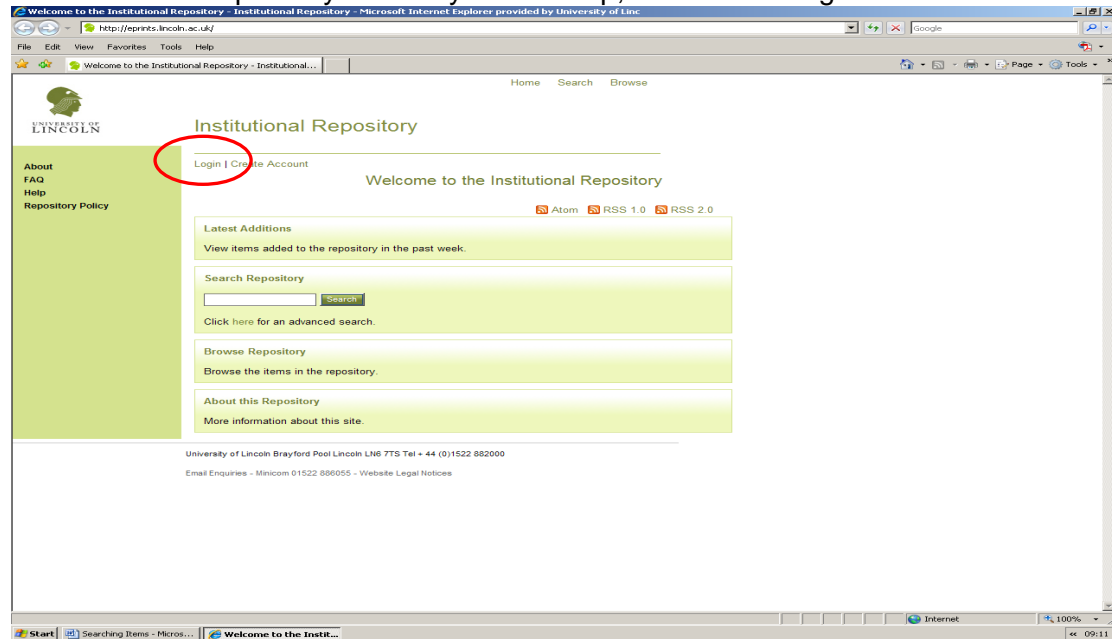

Guidelines for colleagues and students searching for deposited items via the author/or artist

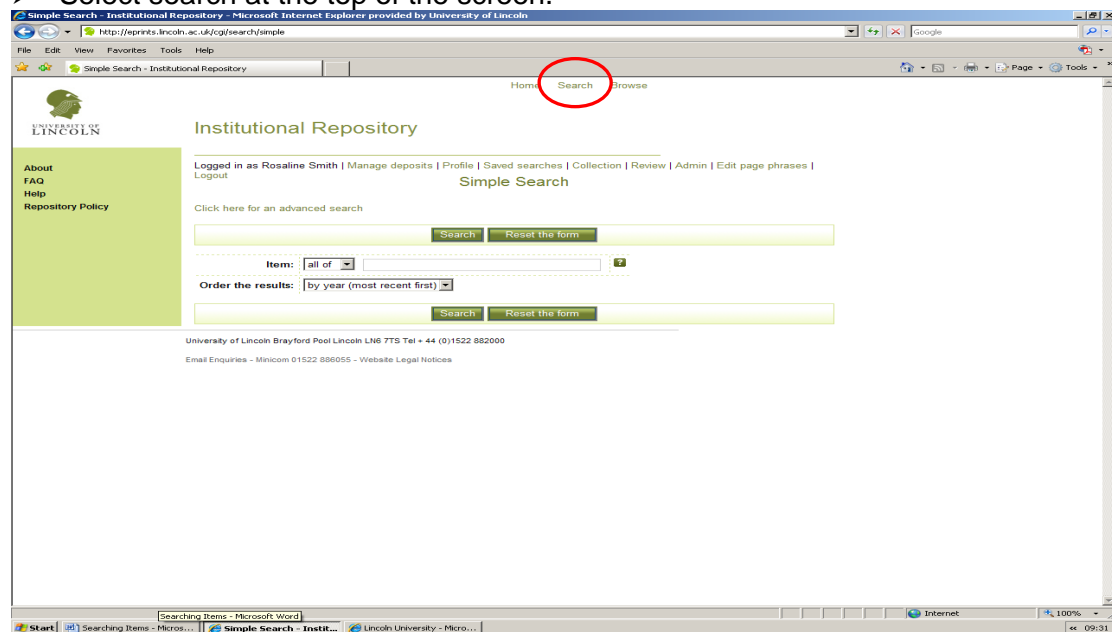
The Lincoln Repository is a digital archive where academic colleagues deposit their publications, or art-based outputs, making them permanently and publicly available. Staff and students are able to access each entry in the repository known as an E-Print.

- Select the Repository icon on your desktop, and click on login.



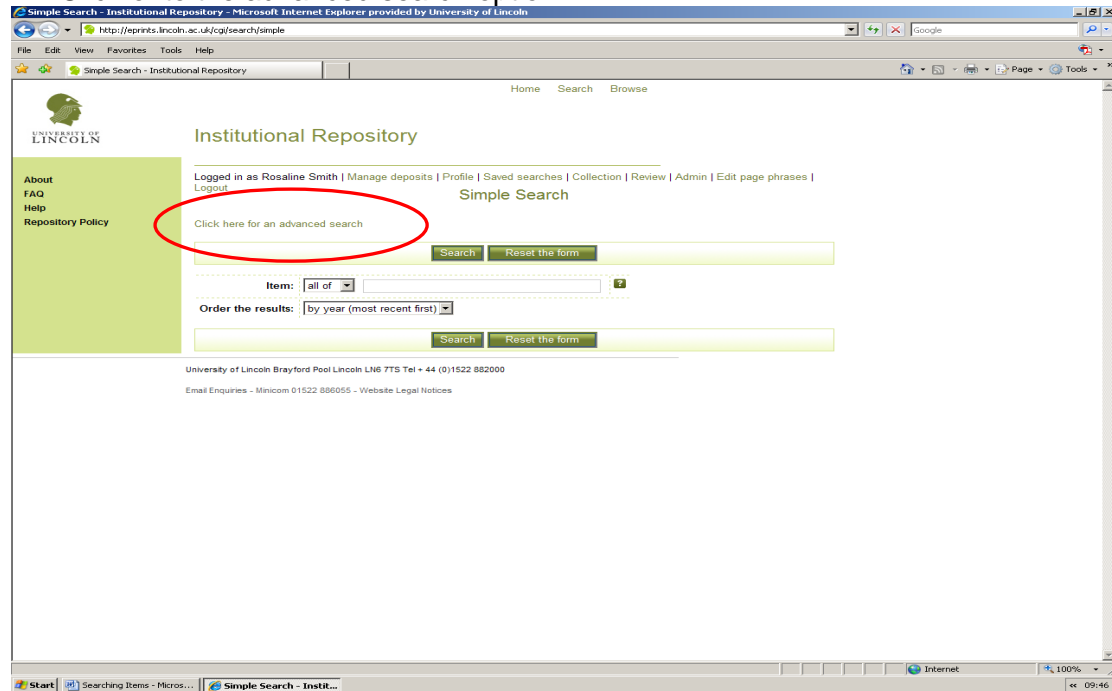
- Enter your network login and password in the appropriate fields, and click on login.

- Select search at the top of the screen.

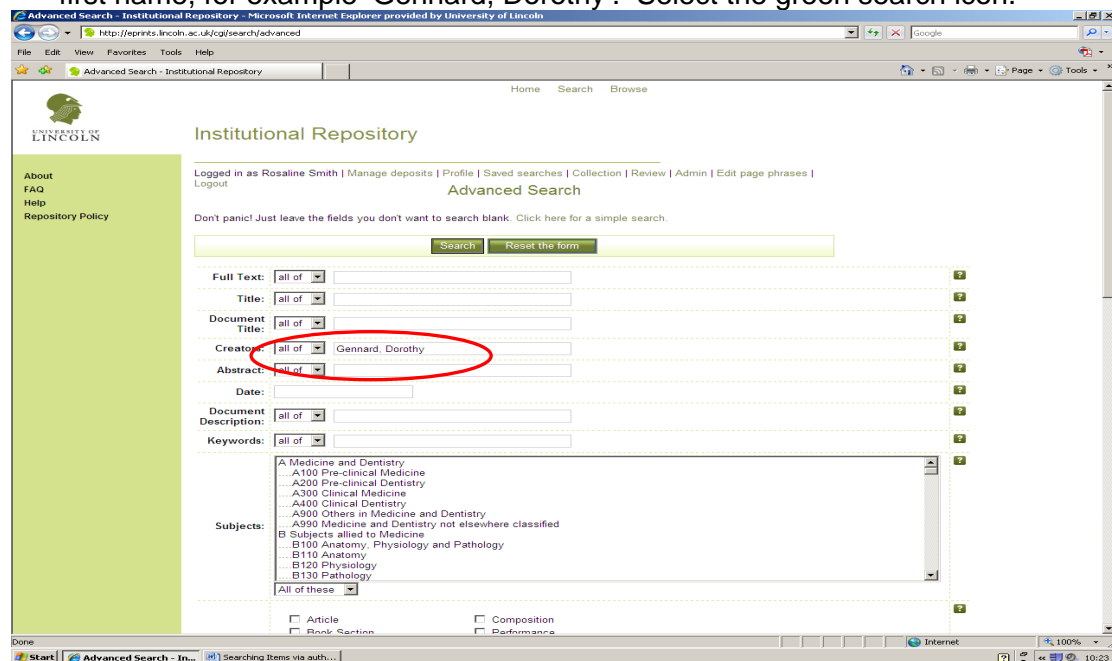

- Click onto the advanced search option



- Enter the surname of the author/or artist into the creators field, followed by the first name, for example 'Gennard, Dorothy'. Select the green search icon.



- All items relevant to that particular author/or artist will be listed.
