The theme of this year's Summer School is Political Economy of the Environment. The School will take place from the 1st of September to the 6th of September at the VIU campus on the Island of San Servolo, in Venice, located just in front of Piazza San Marco. The following professors, coordinated by Prof. Anthony Heyes, will give lectures throughout the Summer School week, focusing on the following topics: Prof. Per Fredriksson on Common Agency Approaches Prof. Jason Shogren on Contest Models and Experimental Approaches Prof. Toke Skovsgaard Aidt on Voting Models Prof. Günther G. Schulze on International Political Economy and Prof. John List on Empirical Applications. The Summer School is targeted at PhD students. Each student is required to give a presentation on their doctoral work, therefore applicants normally need to be advanced in their PhD, to have produced at least one substantial chapter, but not to have completely finished their theses.
