

Livestock budgets – 157


 Beef background steers, beef (cow-calf), beef grazing steers, dairy, dairy replacement heifers




Budgets are primarily


- Economic costs and returns
- For planning
- Steady state
- Forecast (or current)
- Single season (or longer run, normalized)
- Per unit in scale

- Structure
- Size
- Costs
- Practices
- Input use
- Yields
- Machinery and equipment complement
- Hired labor costs
- Farm overhead (if applicable)

- Typical rent
 - Clemson, IL, KY, NE, VA, WSU, TX, OK
- Interest on investment
 - WI, KSU, OK, VA


