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## MEXICO

These statistics were first collected in 1909. In that year they were published in a separate volume which contained particulars not collected or not published later. For instance, aliens were classified not only according to their nationality, but also according to the country of their last permanent residence.

The statistics relate to both the continental and intercontinental migrations of citizens and aliens. However, after 1910 the distinction between these two forms of migration cannot be exactly drawn. The majority of aliens arrive from or proceed to overseas countries, while the contrary is the case for citizens.
