However, the editors reserve the right to hold approved manuscripts for a subsequent issue if their inclusion in the nearest issue would delay its printing or for other reasons approved by the Executive Committee of the SAEA. The current manuscript review process ranges from a low of three months to over 12 months, the length depending upon the condition of the manuscript as submitted, the reviews of Editorial Council members, author revision time, and decisions in the editorial office. All papers approved for publication by the editors subsequently are sent to the copy editor for markup and editing. Printer imposed deadlines for 1988 are May 1 and October 1 for the July and December issues, respectively.
