DURATION - 36 MONTHS EXPIRES JUNE 18, 1988

General Merchandise, Floral, Bakery, Snack Shop, Fish, Bulk Food, Salad Bar, Cheese Clerks and Service Clerks, to be included in the Seniority Article.

The above classifications will have first opportunity to fill any available, "Regular Clerks" position.

The above classifications will have a 30 day trial period, when promoted to Regular Clerks position.

60 Day Probationary period for new hires in new, and remodeled stores.

HOLIDAYS - Part-time Employees hired after ratification, shall be eligible for all Holidays after 9 months of service.

WEEKLY DISABILITY - Present benefit up to \$200 per week. Effective 7/1/85 increased to \$225.00 Effective 7/1/86 increased to \$250.00

<u>DENTAL PROGRAM</u> - Effective 7/1/85, Dental Program will be improved to now include Anesthesia and Orthodontia coverage, and we have improved the full dental schedule.

<u>PRESCRIPTION DRUG BENEFIT</u> - Present coverage \$300 maximum per year. Effective 7/1/85 this will be increased to \$400 maximum per year.

<u>OPTICAL PROGRAM</u> - Effective 7/1/85, the entire optical schedule will be improved, and will include coverage for contact lenses.

OUT PATIENT PSYCHIATRIC THERAPY - Present coverage \$500 per year, effective 7/1/86 this benefit will be increased to \$750 maximum per year.

SURGICAL BENEFIT - Present \$1,200 per year. Effective 7/1/86, this will be increased to \$1,500 maximum.

<u>X-RAY AND LABORATORY EXPENSE</u> - Present coverage \$200 per year. Effective 7/1/85, this will be increased to \$300 per calender year.

<u>HEALTH & WELFARE - PART-TIME</u> The Company agrees to increase the present \$39.00 per month contribution to:

> Effective 1/1/86 - \$42.00 Effective 1/1/87 - \$44.00 Effective 1/1/88 - \$45.00

Hospital Daily Benefit - present coverage \$50.00 per day. Effective 7/1/85 this will be increased to \$100.00 per day for 70 days.

Surgical Benefits - present coverage \$500. Effective 7/1/85, this will be increased to \$1000.00--100% improvement.

<u>PRESCRIPTION DRUGS</u> - will be increased from \$150.00 per year maximum to \$200.00 per year maximum, effective 7/1/85.

<u>DENTAL AND OPTICAL</u> - Coverage will be improved same as full-time coverage 7/1/86.

<u>PENSION PART-TIME</u> - Effective $\frac{1/1/87}{1}$ the Pension Benefit will be improved from \$2.50 to \$3.50 per month per year of future service.

Effective 1/1/88 Part-time Pension Benefit will be improved to \$4.50 per month per year of future service. This improves the maximum benefit of \$87.50 per month to \$122.50 per month and effective 1/1/88 the maximum benefit pension to \$157.50 per month, exclusive of Social Security.

<u>PENSION FULL-TIME</u> - <u>Effective July 1, 1984</u> the benefit will be improved from \$12.42 per month, per year of service (maximum pension of \$434.00 per month) to \$27.00 per month per year of service, (future). This improves maximum pension to \$945.00 per month.

<u>Effective 1/1/87 - The pension contribution will be increased from \$99.80</u> to \$103.38 per month, which will improve the maximum future service benefit to \$980.00 per month.

<u>Effective 1/1/88</u> - The contribution will be increased to \$110.54 monthly, providing a maximum future service benefit to \$1,050.00 per month, exclusive of Social Security.

FISH AND BAKERY DEPARTMENT - All Head Bakery Clerks in the General Merchandise classification, and all Head Fish Clerks to receive a \$5.00 per week premium.

Meat Clerks to handle stuffing Department, and package pre-cut chickens.

The Company and the Union have agreed on language regarding "Free Time".

"FREE TIME"

Employees shall be paid for time recorded by the time clock. Employees who fail to punch the time clock shall have their time recorded by the Store Manager and initialed by the employee and Store Manager on the time card.

The Fair Labor Standards Act, as amended, required among other things, that all time worked by employees be accurately recorded and that employees receive compensation for all time worked in excess of forty (40) hours in any work week at one and one-half (1-1/2) times their regular hourly rate of pay. The parties recognize and agree that compliance with this Act is in the best interest of the Employer, the Union, and the employees.

Therefore, the Employer will not request, suffer or permit any employee to work off-the-clock, and the Union agrees to cooperate with and to assist the Employer in assuring compliance with the important Federal legislation. Any employee violating this provision, shall be subject to discipline.

HOURS

Sunday Premium Pay: Effective ratification of this contract, all new hires will recieve time and one half, for all hours worked on Sunday.
